for the purpose of examining and reporting on the present state of a wound or injury sustained

by Lieut. C.G.P. Allkston, 49th Battn.

at (Place of injury) Ypres, on the (Date of injury) 25th March 1916.

The Board find ~~that this Officer was very severely wounded by a shrapnel bullet, which fractured left pubic bone, entered abdomen and perforated bladder. Wound of entrance close to left external ring. No wound of exit. Was sent to No. 10 C.C. Hospital and was operated on there. laparotomy and sewed up bladder. Then sent to No. 7 Stationary Boulogne when the sequestrum of bone was removed. Was admitted to Dorchester House, Park Lane, on April 28th, 1916. X rays show fracture incomplete of left ascending ramus of pubic. Shrapnel ball is still in front of rt side upper piece of coccyx, where it can be felt. Condition much improved. Can walk moderately. Has attacks of nausea, which prevent rapid convalescence.~~
