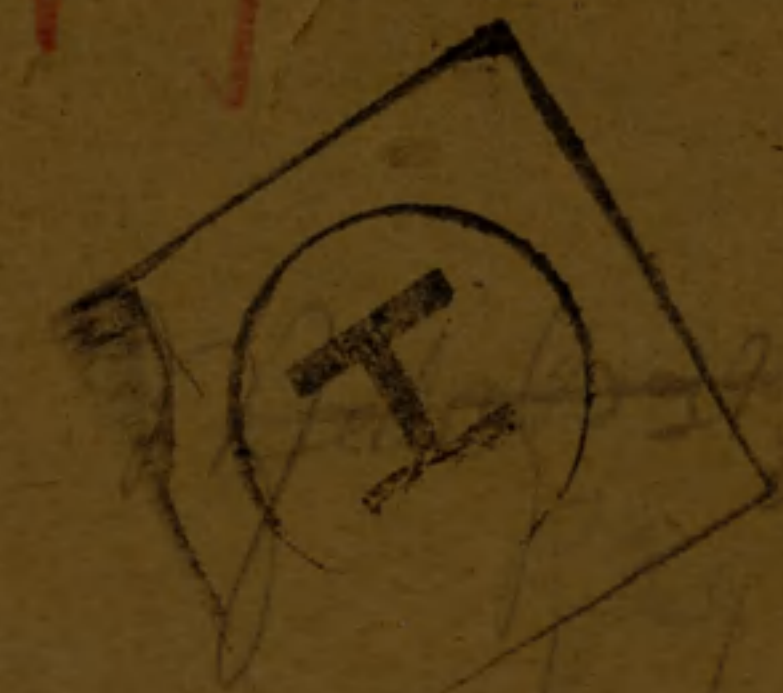
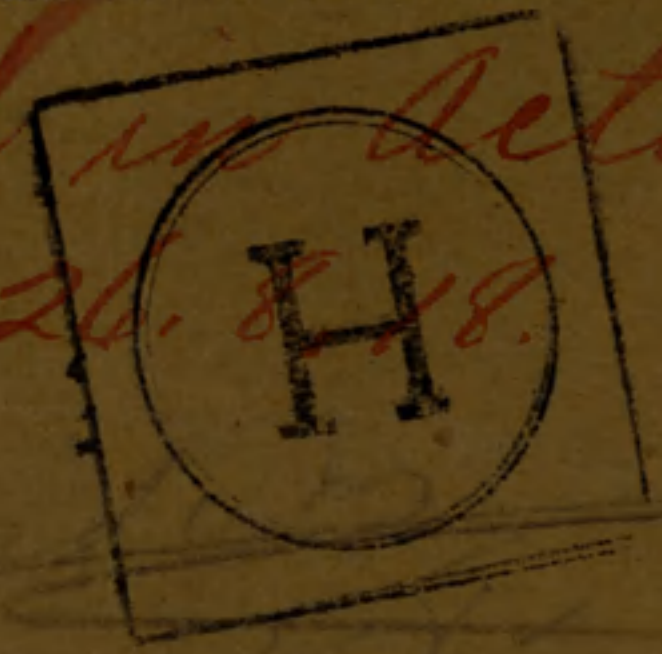

The Board having assembled pursuant to order, and having read the instructions on the back of the form, proceed to examine the above-named officer and find that

this Officer has been treated from 29-8-17 in Bramshott Military Hospital with above complaint. He has had some digestive disturbance and suffered from fatigue and excessive weariness on slight exertion. Has no definite disability but presents the appearance of one suffering from nerve strain. He needs a rest for a short time.

May be reboarded in any area.


INSTRUCTIONS.

Following a number of attacks of influenza & Quinsy he had his tonsils removed April 1916: otherwise strong & healthy. Relapsed Nov 1915 & went to France by 1916 & has been in dug-outs since - Had Shingles Feb Oct 1916. Came over on leave Aug 22 '17 & came in complaining of "stomach trouble". He got his commission in Dec 1916. Present illness ^{he says that "all his life" he has been "bilious" - is. he would bring up "} "bile" in the morning -

For the last 4-5 weeks he has, with little preceding nausea or effort, brought up a mouthful or two of "bile" (yellow greenish colored fluid) after getting out of bed but before breakfast. Appetite quite good: Wt. about normal: no indigestion, though occasionally during the day he vomits his food very soon after meals. Bowels usually slightly constipated. Sleeps usually well - No evening trouble. Smokes ~~rather~~ about 20 cigarettes a day. Has had no pain or headache.

Some 5 weeks ago, he was exposed to shell gas in the open & was quite nauseated after this & attributes his present troubles to this start.
