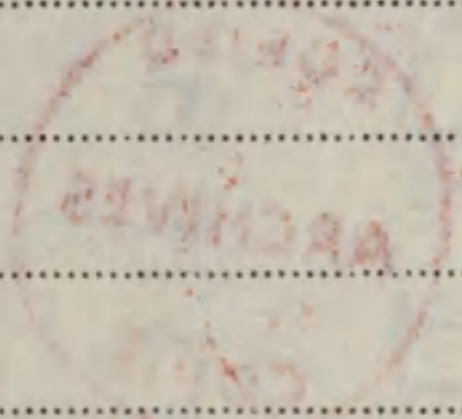
INSTRUCTIONS.

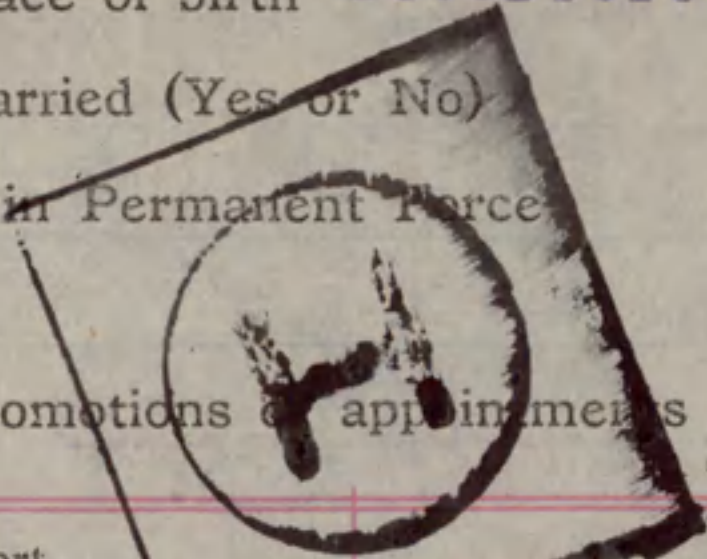

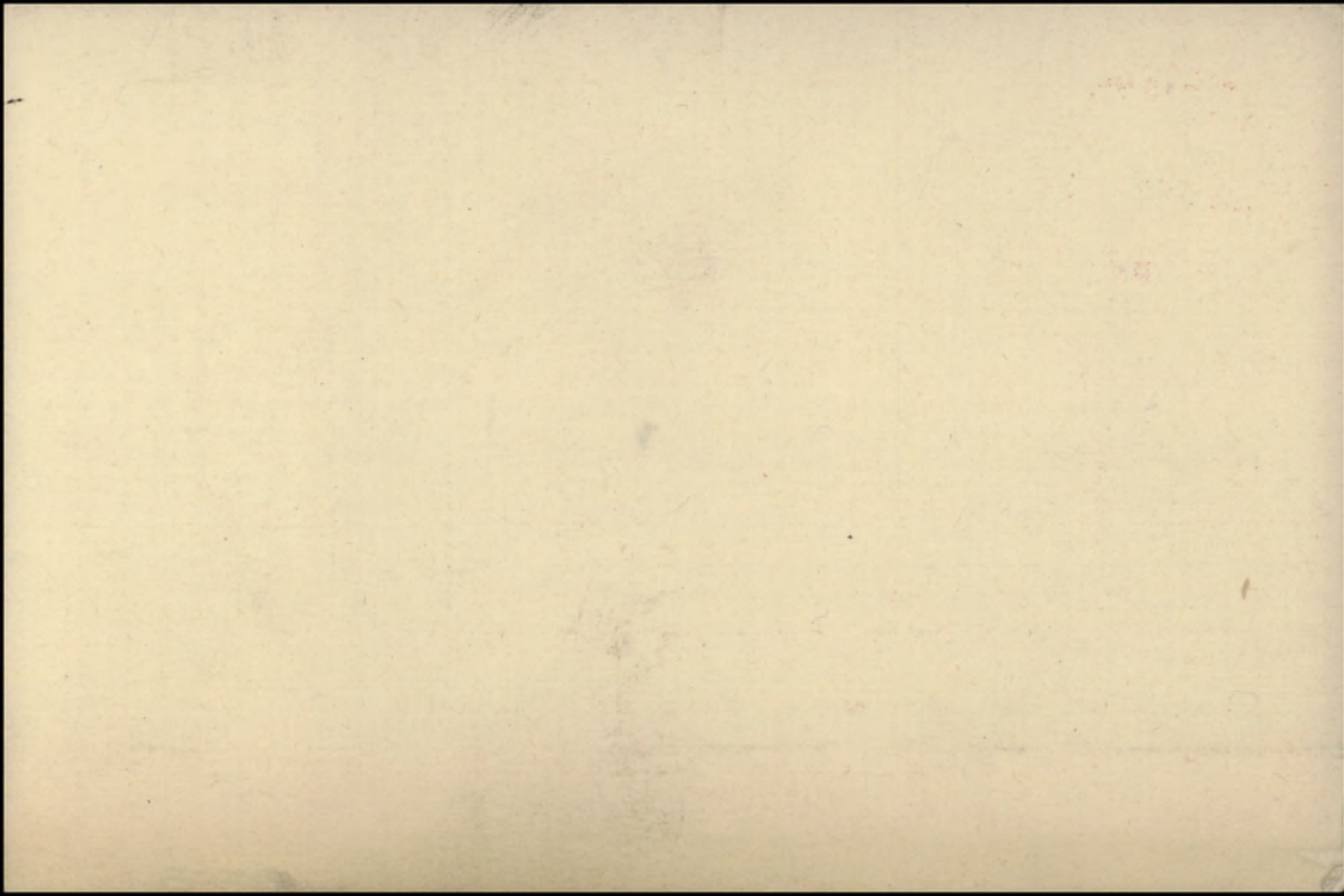
