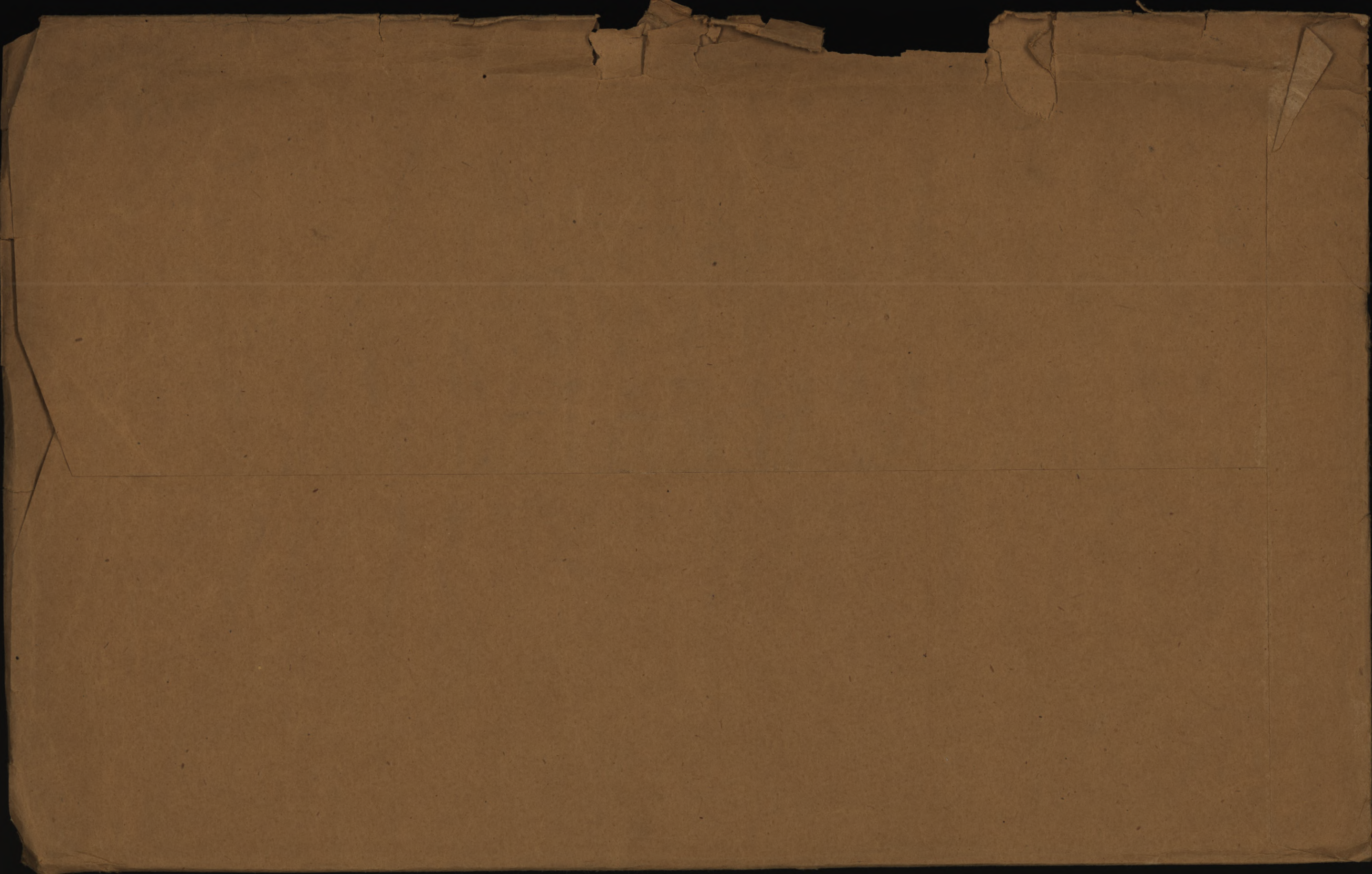

7. 2. 16. Condⁿ now much the same as before the haemorrhage. Red lotion for wound - weak granu^l.

11. 2. 16.

T. now high & P. increasing. patient losing ground. It was decided to give him an intravenous injection of Buscol .5% in Saline to combat the toxæmia. This was done & 50cc injected slowly (10cc a minute)

12. 2. 16.

Looking & feeling well. T. went up after the injectⁿ & the P increased to 140.

A few hours after the opⁿ continuous irrigation with Mag. Sulph 10% was begun the gauze being left in situ.

23. 1. 16. Same better a little - gauze packing removed with comp. ease - cavity v. foul.

25. 1. 16. Temp. still keeping v. high. progress not at all satisfactory.

27. 1. 16. This morning oedema was noticed over front of tibia & up outer side of thigh above the knee. In the early evening the T shot up to 104.2° & the oedema had increased greatly. The pat. was slightly delirious & the pulse got quite small & irreg. Amp. decided on & done at once.

Spinal anaesthesia given but in order to deal c mental condⁿ a small quantity of ether was also given. Morph. gr $\frac{1}{4}$ & Atropine gr $\frac{1}{100}$. Circular ampⁿ ^(c short flaps) done through the lower $\frac{1}{3}$ of the femur. An abscess cavity was found just above the knee on the outer side of the thigh. It did not seem to communicate with the knee joint. The purulent lining was dissected away & a tube left in through a skin puncture. The flaps were left open. During the opⁿ the pulse was very poor.

Rectal Saline given after 4 hrs containing starch & opium on account of the previous diarrhoea. also digitalin gr $\frac{1}{100}$ & Calci. Camphor in oil gr $\frac{1}{4}$ 6 hrs.
