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MEDICAL HISTORY OF AN INVALID

They will distinctly state the authority for statements not resulting from their personal observation; it must be made clear whether such statements are obtained from the invalid concerned, from witnesses, or from documents, Regimental or otherwise.

4. Special care is required in answering question 9. Read the questions carefully. All questions must be answered.

5. If space provided under any section is insufficient add another sheet. Such sheets must be initialled by the Medical Board.

6. A note will be made of attached papers by the Medical Board under the section "Opinion of Medical Board."

7. Under no circumstances may information other than that in sections 7, 8, 9 and 10 be communicated to the invalid, directly or indirectly.

The heart is consideraby enlarged both to the right and the left of the ventricular mass. The arch of the certa is somewhat dilated. The mediastinum is clear. The rib interspaces are moderately wide. The diaphragm moves freely. The left lung is clear throughout excepts for some increased hilar thickening. The right lung shows well marked peribronchial thickening in the peravertebral area of the lower lobe, and likewise in the perivertebral area of the upper lobe, which extends upwards as high as the circle of the first rib. In my opinion this is largely a peribronchial fibronic lesion. There is only doubtful evidence of alveolar involvment in this surrounding lung.

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

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
