
Sir,

This man appeared before this Board this afternoon and I beg to enclose copy of his Medical Board Report dated Aug. 18th. His disability is Scoliosis right dorsal dating from 1910. He does not appear to have been in France and after questioning him, we cannot understand why the Medical Board put his earning capacity down as having been lessened to the extent of half, as he appears to be in exactly the same condition as he was when he joined, and there is no indication of aggravation of his disability, either in the Medical Report on the Invalid or in the Medical Board Report. We do not consider that the public should pay him a pension for a disability which occurred in 1910. We therefore decided to recommend that he should not receive a pension. This man is for discharge in England.

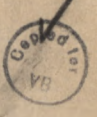

Opinion of the Medical Board.

NOTES.—(i.) 1. When a soldier is to be discharged, the documents retained with the duplicate attestation will be placed inside this form. Should any of the documents be missing, an explanation of the deficiency, signed by the commanding officer, must be substituted for the missing document. The Officer in charge of records will then extract from the original attestation, any documents required to complete the list of discharge documents enumerated in the margin, which will then be placed in this form in the sequence given.

2. When men are discharged from the colours at home as medically unfit, or with claims to pension, Army Form B. 268 will be sent confirmed, together with the duplicate attestation and documents retained therein to the officer in charge of records 10 days in advance of the date for discharge in the case of invalids, and 14 days in other cases. This officer will then extract from the original attestation any documents required to complete the list of discharge documents enumerated in the margin, place them in this form, and after carefully checking the duplicate attestation with the original forward the whole to the Secretary, Royal Hospital, Chelsea. When such men are discharged abroad, the same procedure will be adopted as above, with the exception that the discharge documents will be sent to the officer in charge of records immediately after discharge takes place (except in the case of men who are granted gratuities on discharge from local battalions or companies, Royal Artillery).

3. When soldiers are sent home from abroad for discharge, the documents retained with the duplicate attestation will be placed inside this form and sent home with the men for transmission to the officer who carries out the discharge together with the following additional forms:—

- (a) Discharge certificate (Army Form B. 2079 or Army Form B. 264).
- (b) Character certificate (Army Form B. 2067) if entitled.
- (c) Copy company conduct sheet (Army Form B. 121) when required under King's Regulations.
