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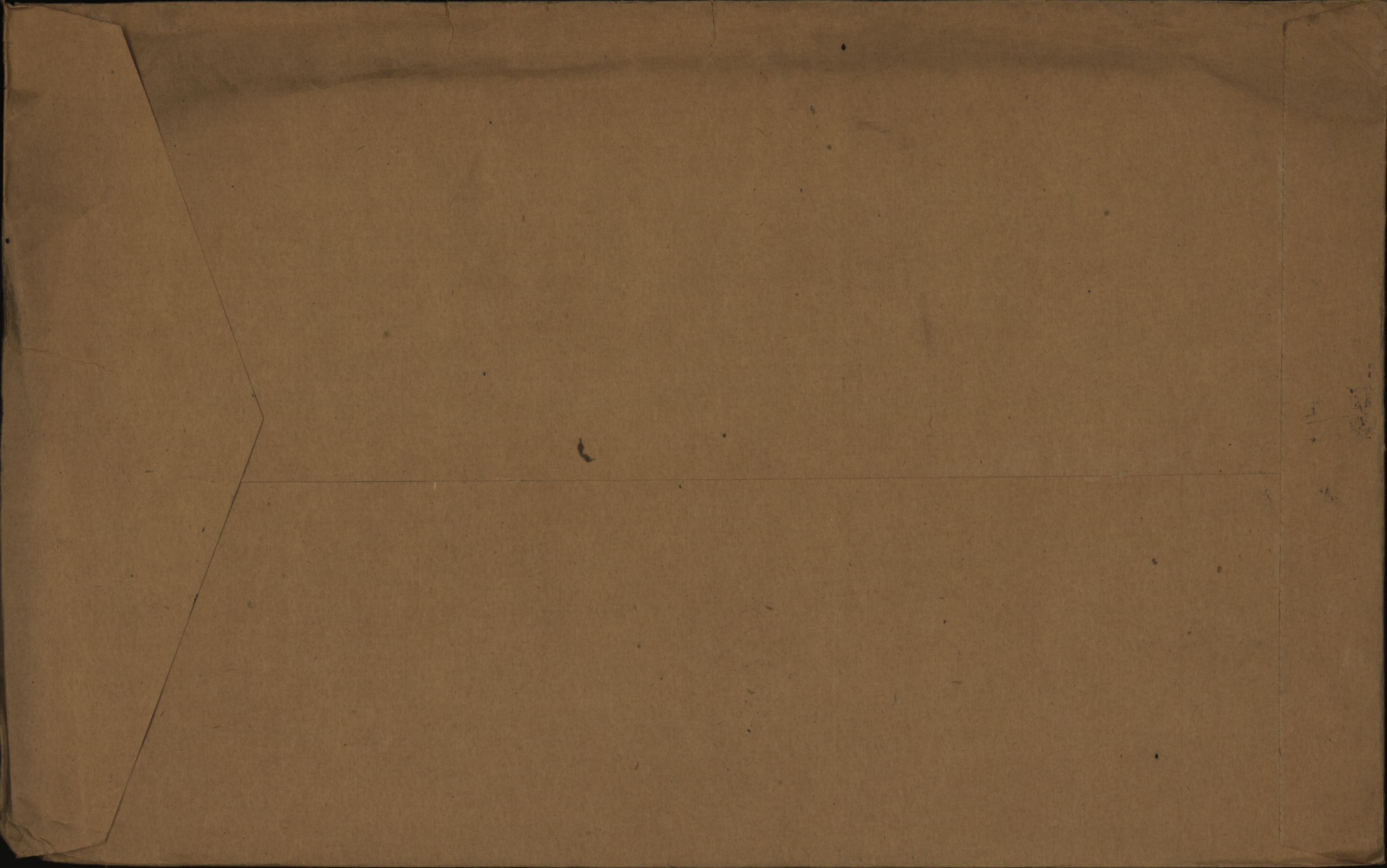

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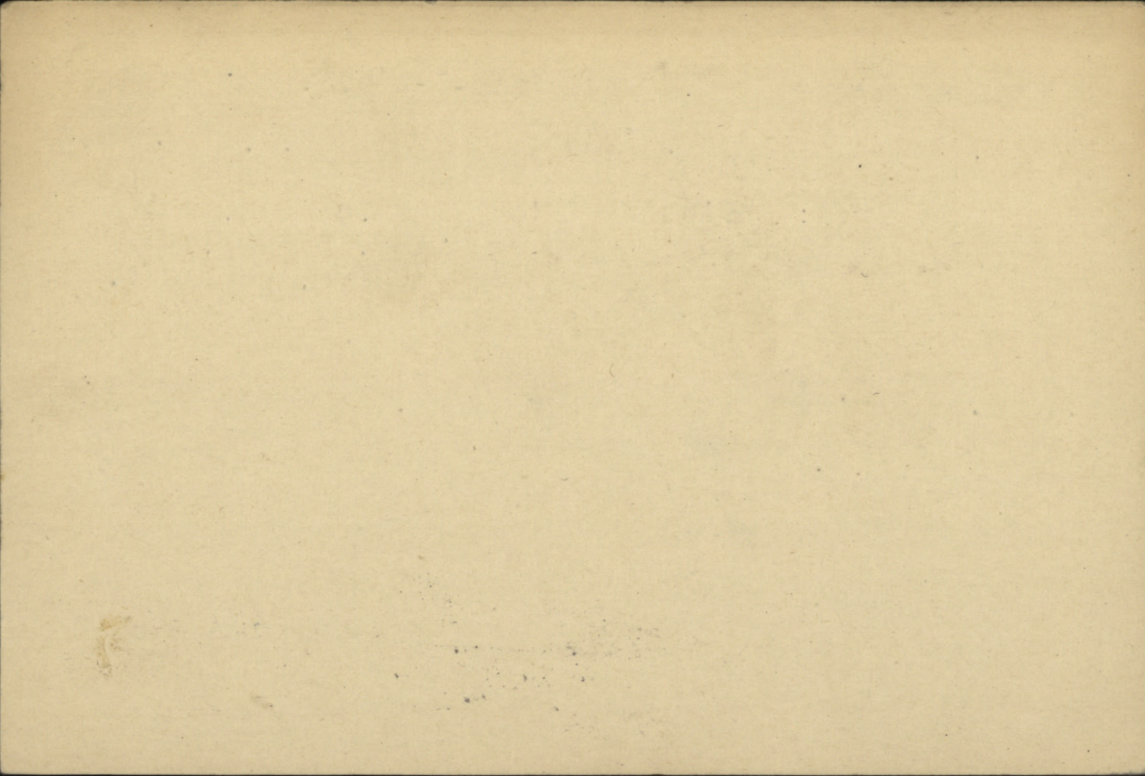



At the Engineer Training Depot, St. Johns, Que on Sept. 29th 1918, No 2005411 L/C. J. Sleigh was admitted to the Military Hospital suffering from a very severe attack of Influenza. On Sept, 29th 1918 he was transfer red to the Drummond Military Hospital Montreal, in a Military Hospital Car.

A telegram received from the O.C., Drummond Military Hospital, Montreal, reporting his death at Montreal on 7th October 1918, No 2005411 L/C. J. Sleigh was struck off the strength in Daily Orders No 287.
