In Dec. 1916 he sprained left great toe in a trench while carrying a load on his back. Since then the joint has been painful & has gradually become stiff; used to give much pain on route march. In Autumn of 1917 began to be troubled with pain in back following, he thinks, exposure & slight strain in lifting.

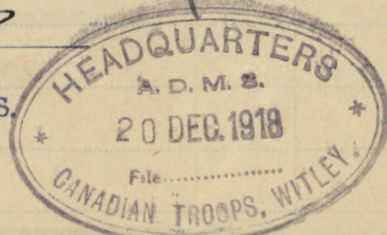

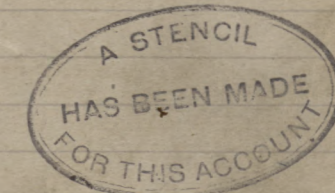
