Memorandum:

The following order has been approved and is promulgated for information and guidance and action, where necessary.

NAVAL GENERAL ORDER

1912. Alteration of Title in Connection With the Victualling Branch and Personnel Thereof

The Victualling Branch will henceforth be known as the Supply Branch and personnel heretofore known as Victualling personnel will be known as Supply personnel, i.e. Supply Chief Petty Officer, etc.

2. Where in Canadian Naval Regulations, Canadian Naval Reserve Regulations, and Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve Regulations, reference is made to the Victualling Branch or to any Officers or ratings thereof, the word "Victualling" is to be deleted and the word "Supply" substituted.
