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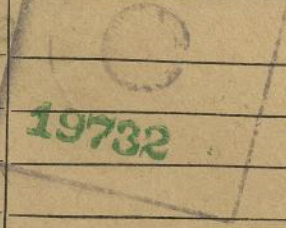

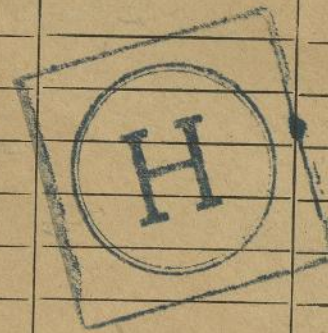

The Board having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to examine the

above-named officer and find that. He complains of pain radiating across the back from the base of skull to 8th dorsal vert. When tired his head drops forward. Complains headaches, & insomnia. No doubt he received concussion of spinal cord in his injury in 1914. Other spinal symptoms arise when his resistance is lowered.

He is at present in good physical condition, but the nervous symptoms persist.

The opinion of the Board upon the questions herein is as follows:—

(1) Is the officer fit for service? No

(2) If not so fit, how long is the disability likely to continue? Difficult to estimate. We would say disability 60% at present, aggravated by service 80% & that he be discharged as physically unfit for service.

(3) To what extent does it prevent his earning a livelihood? 60% for six months
