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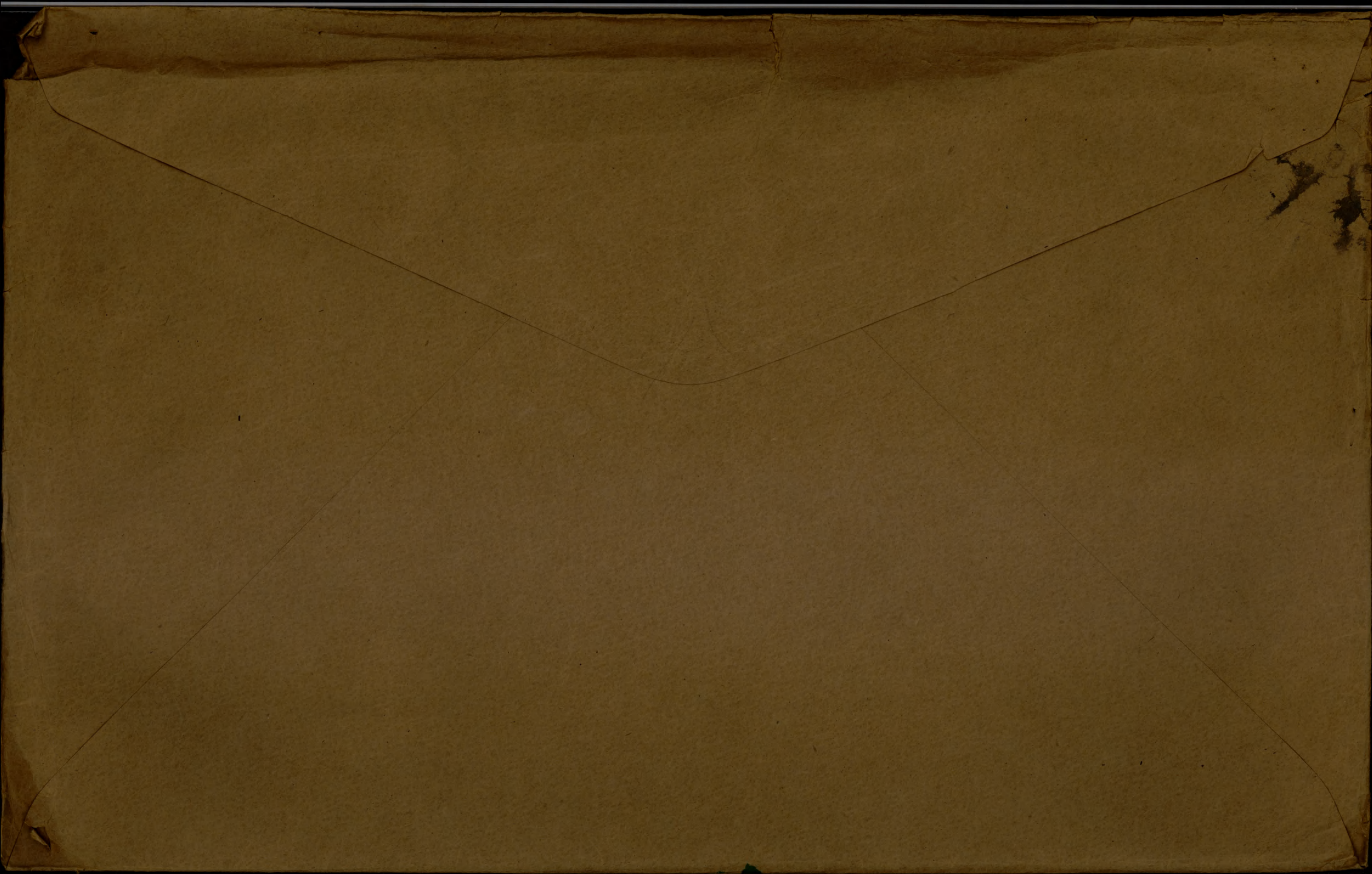

Bullet passed through. Sent to No. 7. Stationary., Boulogne. Transferred to Royal Free Hospital on June 15th, 1916. Wounds are now healed. There is slight stiffness of the neck muscles.
