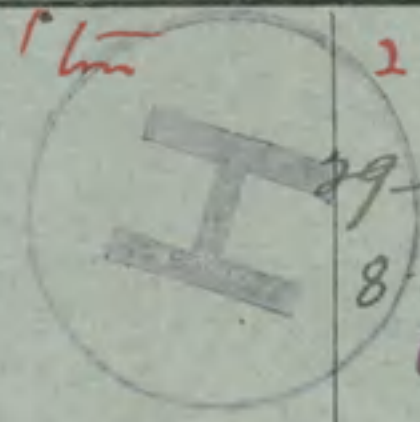
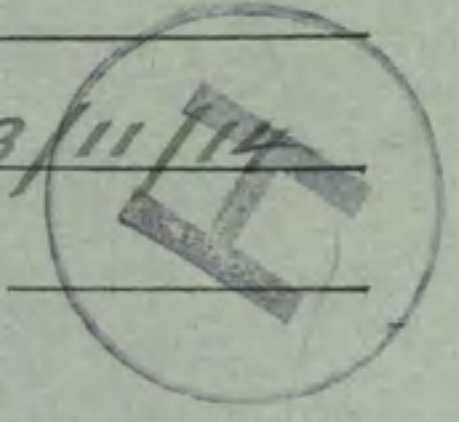

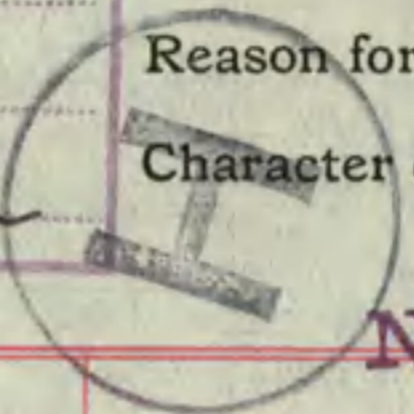

<p>On the 8<sup>th</sup> of May while he was doing duty with his Regiment in fire trenches at Bellewade Lake so-called beyond Ypres he was instantly killed by a fragment of high explosive shell. Owing to the number of casualties on that day it was not possible to bury him in a separate grave. He was laid in a common grave with a number of other fallen comrades. By reason of the locality passing into the enemy's hands the next day it was not possible to erect the usual memorials by way of identifications. 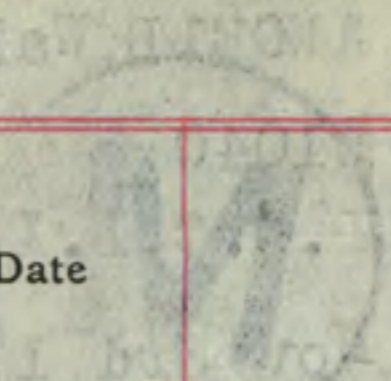

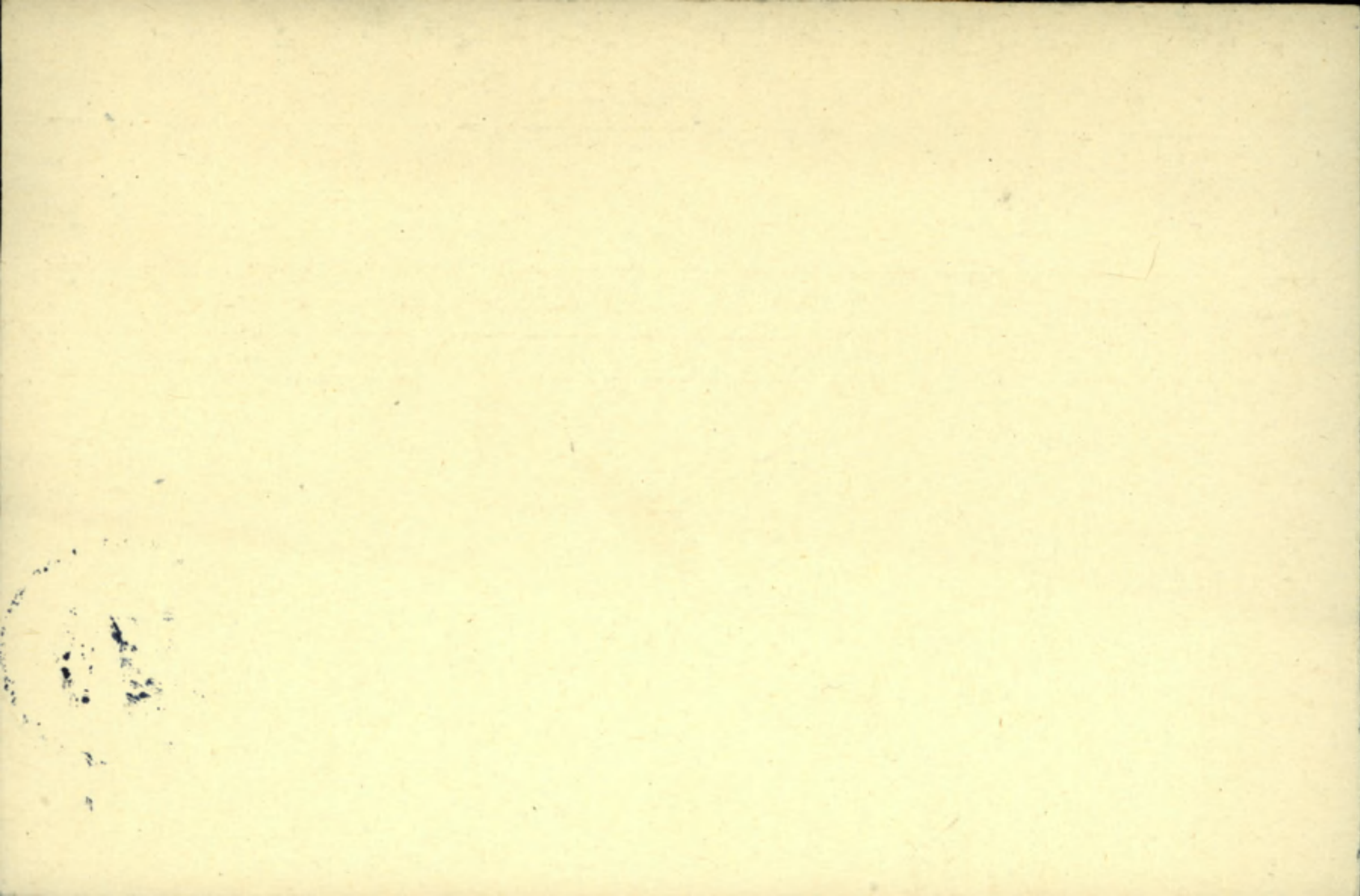
