Hit by Shrapnel about a week before admission to this Hospital. ^{Wounded 8/16/16} Lay some time on field before picked up. Received first aid dressing by Reg. M. O. & then sent to field ambulance from there to P.C.S. Then went to G. H. #

On arrival at Dist. Mil. Hosp. patient had temp, and swollen, feet swelling left thigh. Also had slight wound on head, and rt. foot. Injury to Lt. leg consisted of a Shrapnel wound in calf with entry & exit wounds of the piece of Shrapnel. Torn, dirty wound on inner side of thigh above knee - infected & oozing ^{foul, black} blood. Upper leg greatly swollen & oedematous, and very foul odor from wound. Pulse rate increased & weak.

Operated on June 15th at 12 noon - wounds of left leg exposed and drained. X-ray showed piece of Shrapnel in ^{upper} Psoas space to inner side of femur. Great amount of int. hemorrhage found to be present. No crepitation. No femoral pulsation.

Patient did not improve after operation, leg became more swollen, pulse weak. Leg gangrenous.

Patient died at 11 pm. Friday June 16/16.

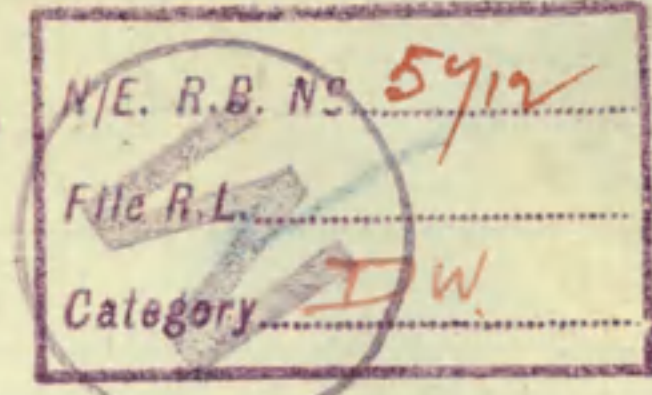

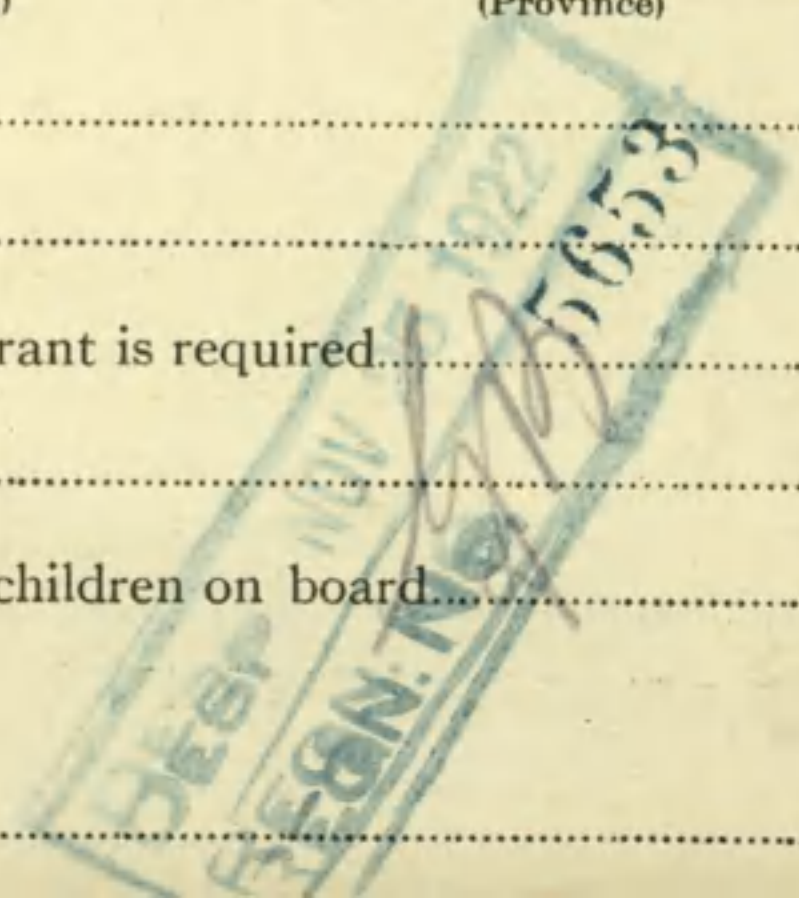
