

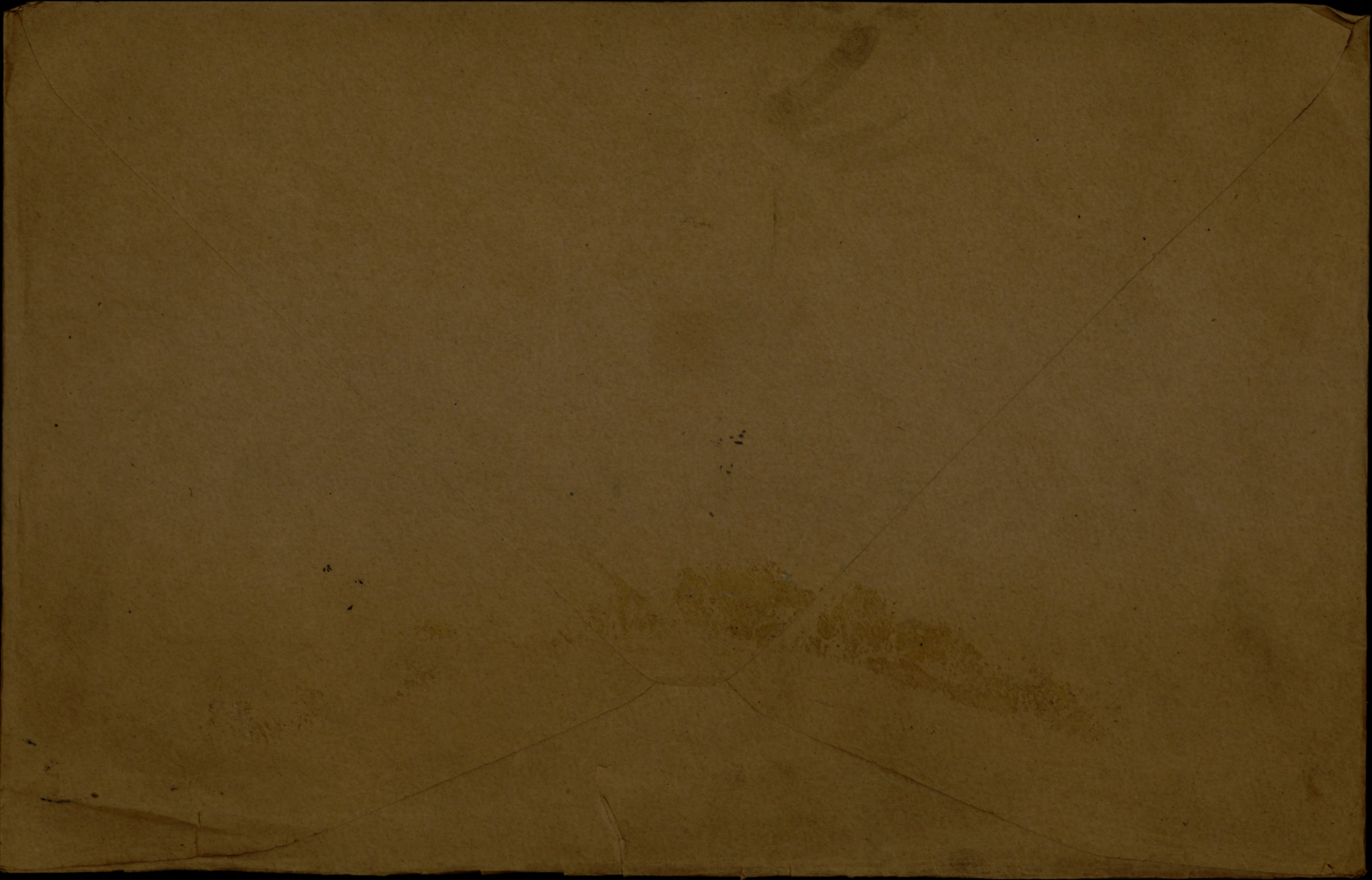

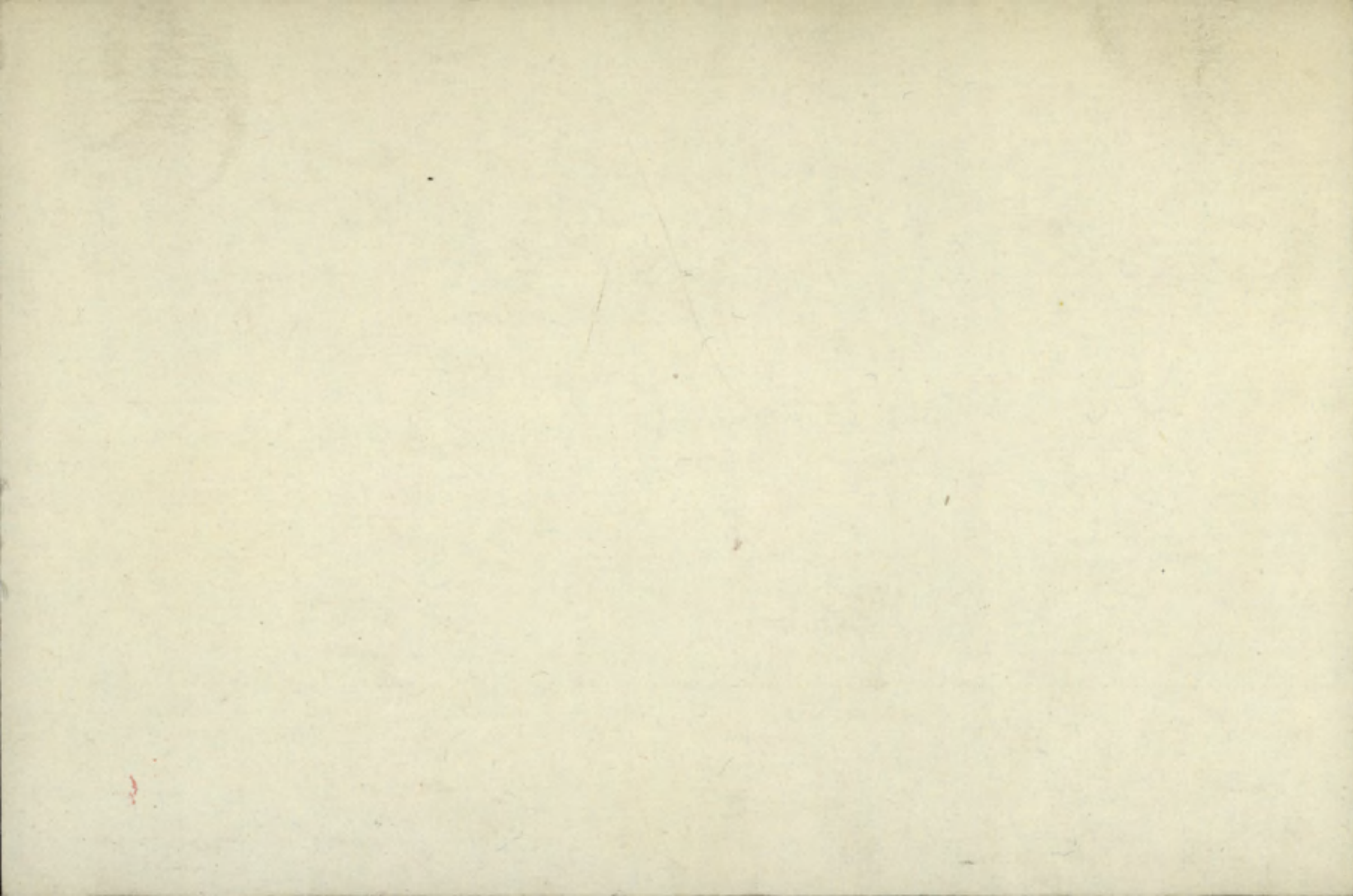

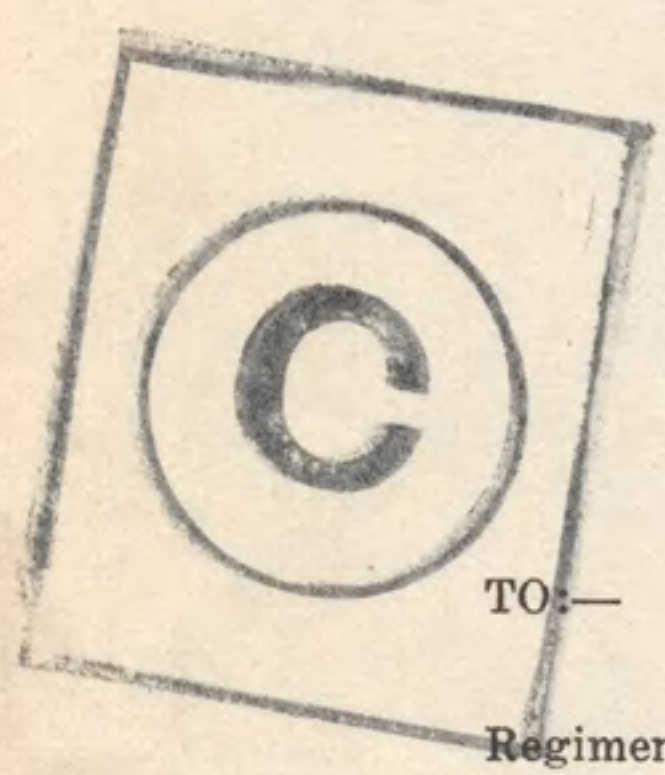

2. This will be carried out by your reporting in person to your Depot at ... LONDON, ONT. Transportation to the Depot is enclosed herewith, and return transportation will be furnished to you after your discharge.

OR, as an alternative, you may execute, before a Notary Public, Commissioner of Oaths or Justice of the Peace, the release hereunder and forward same, on or before the said date, in the envelope enclosed for that purpose, together with the unused Transportation Certificate. A receipt for the release will be returned to you and will be equivalent to a Certificate of Discharge.
4. Should you fail to report in person or forward the release mentioned, within the time aforesaid, you will be declared a deserter and be subject to Military Law.
