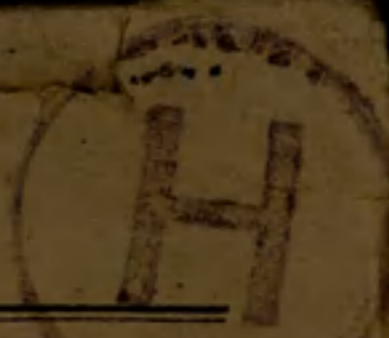
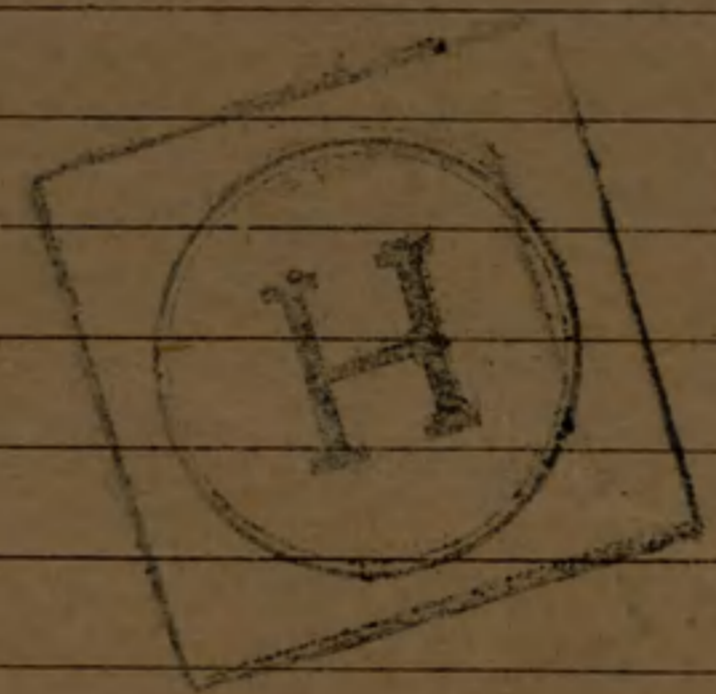

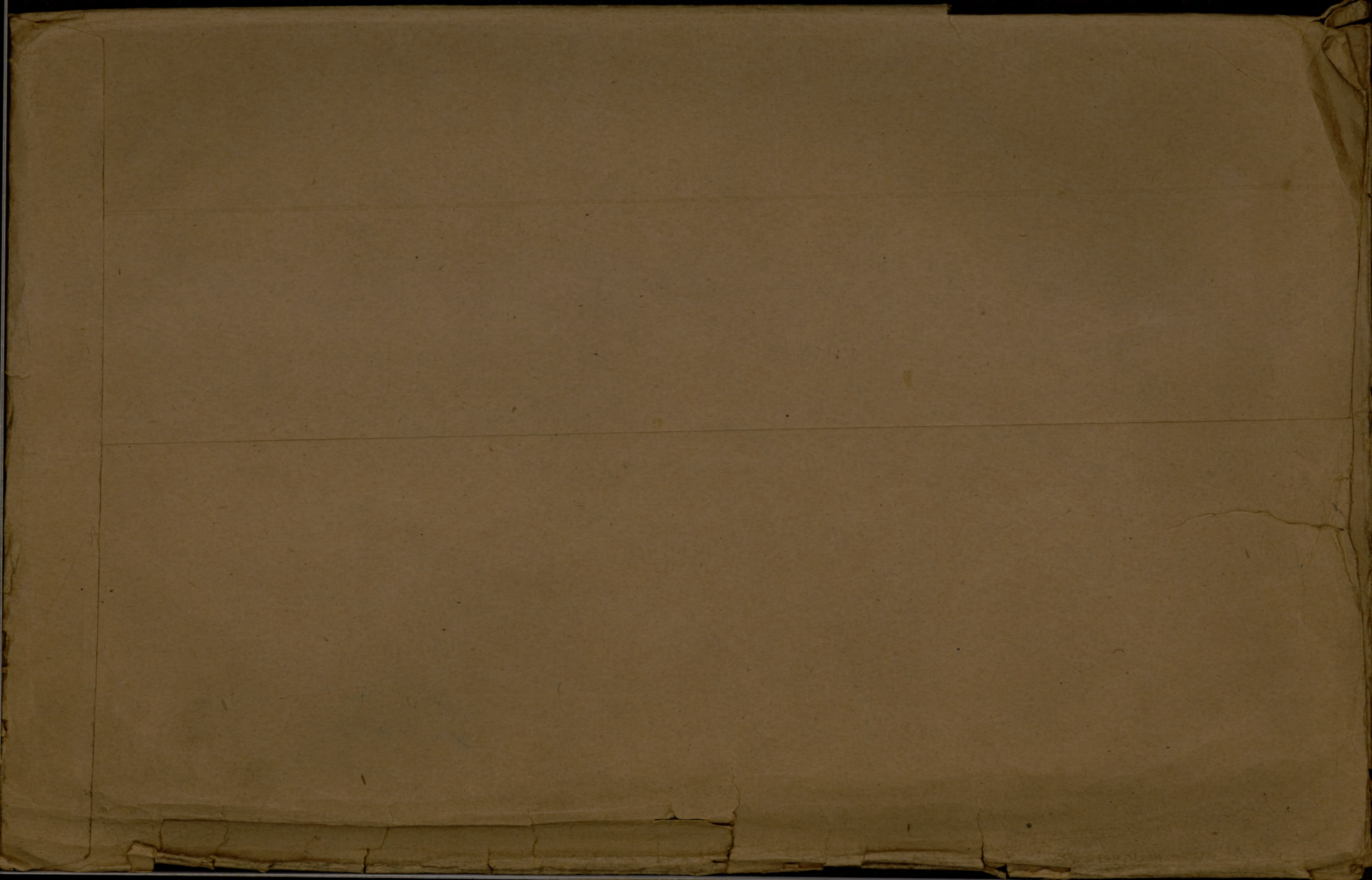

Patient states: that on April 8th 1918 was exposed to shell gas. wore masks for a considerable period - these masks were removed. About six hours later, eyes became sore & began to water, following morning he had developed a cough, sore throat and has lost voice. During the first day he vomited. During the first few days, it hurt his eyes considerably to have any light fall on them, but this has gradually passed off.
