Disease Neurasthenia.

Had Malaria in India during the hot weather from two to nine years of age.

He has had slight attacks periodically in England from 9-14 years of age.

Had Diphtheria when a child of 15 yrs.

He commenced to lose weight at end of 1914 or beginning of 1915 and became somewhat pallid and had attacks which have continued at intervals since that time particularly in wet weather.

In March 1916 he was blown up by a shell which burst about fifteen feet away. He went into one of the huts awaiting for his M.O. He was not unconscious but had difficulty in expressing himself and imagined he heard various kinds of noise.

He was sent into hospital and eventually back to England towards end of March. He was in hospital in London 7 to 10 days and then got three months sick leave & at the expiration of that leave was given another month.

In July 1916 was given home duty.

From the middle of June he has  
assisted Musketry Officer in Reserve Bn.  
He had no difficulty in latter job  
as the work was very light.

He states that he has had pain  
in lower part of spine ever since  
March 1916 when he was blown up.  
He describes the pain as being of a dull  
aching character when he has this  
he is troubled with twitching of  
muscles in his legs.

He is of a nervous temperament  
X Ray of back negative  
Heart, lungs and kidneys negative  
Smokes excessively of cigarettes.

He sleeps well some nights and then  
sleeps badly.

His nervousness is aggravated by domestic troubles.
