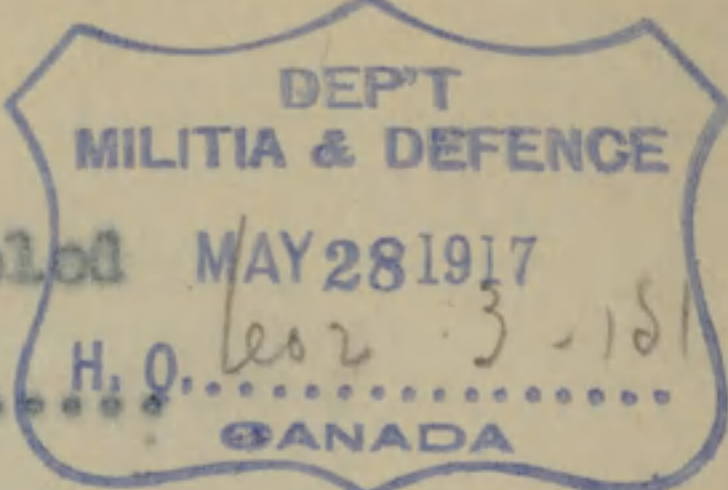

limited by 10°. There is marked grating and
pain on movement of the joint. Is painful on walking
Is unable to get left heel on ground unless he bends
other leg. Very little if any actual shortening of leg.
There is a bowing outward at knee joint.
There is a general swelling of the knee.
Can only walk slowly with aid of cane.

The opinion of the Board upon the questions herein is as follows:—

(1) Is the officer fit for service?* No.

(2) If not so fit, how long is the disability likely to continue? Three months.

While recognizing the advisability of an operation to unclose the knee joint we are of the opinion that the case should receive further observation before the operation was performed.
