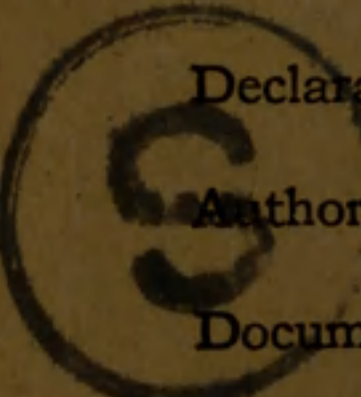


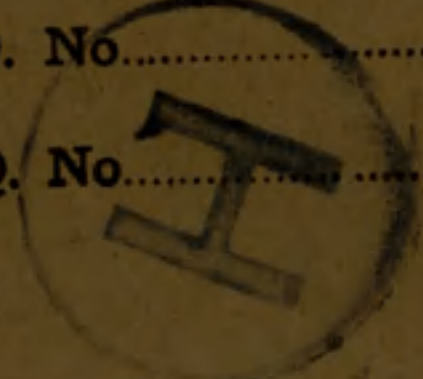

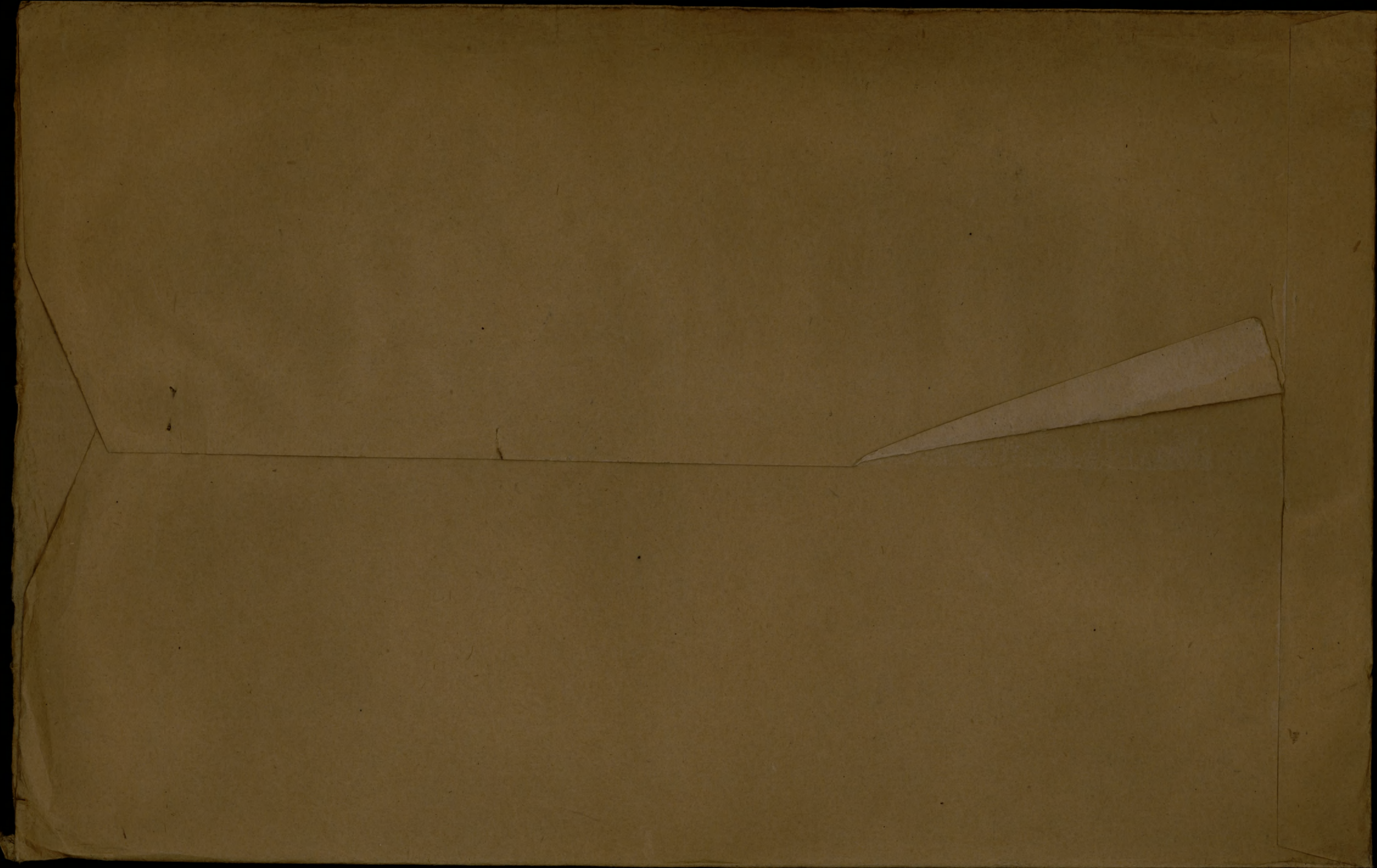

Short Form of Will

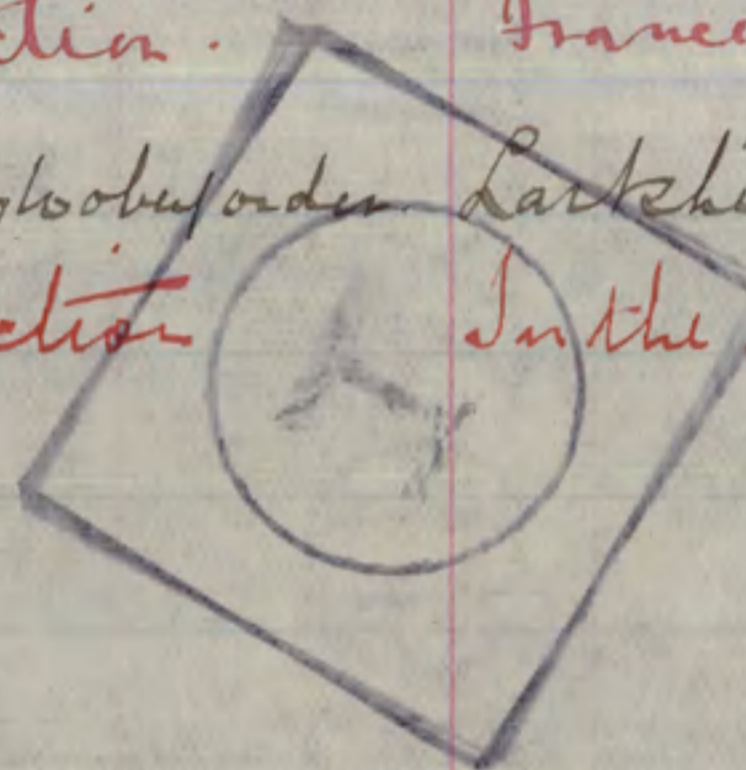

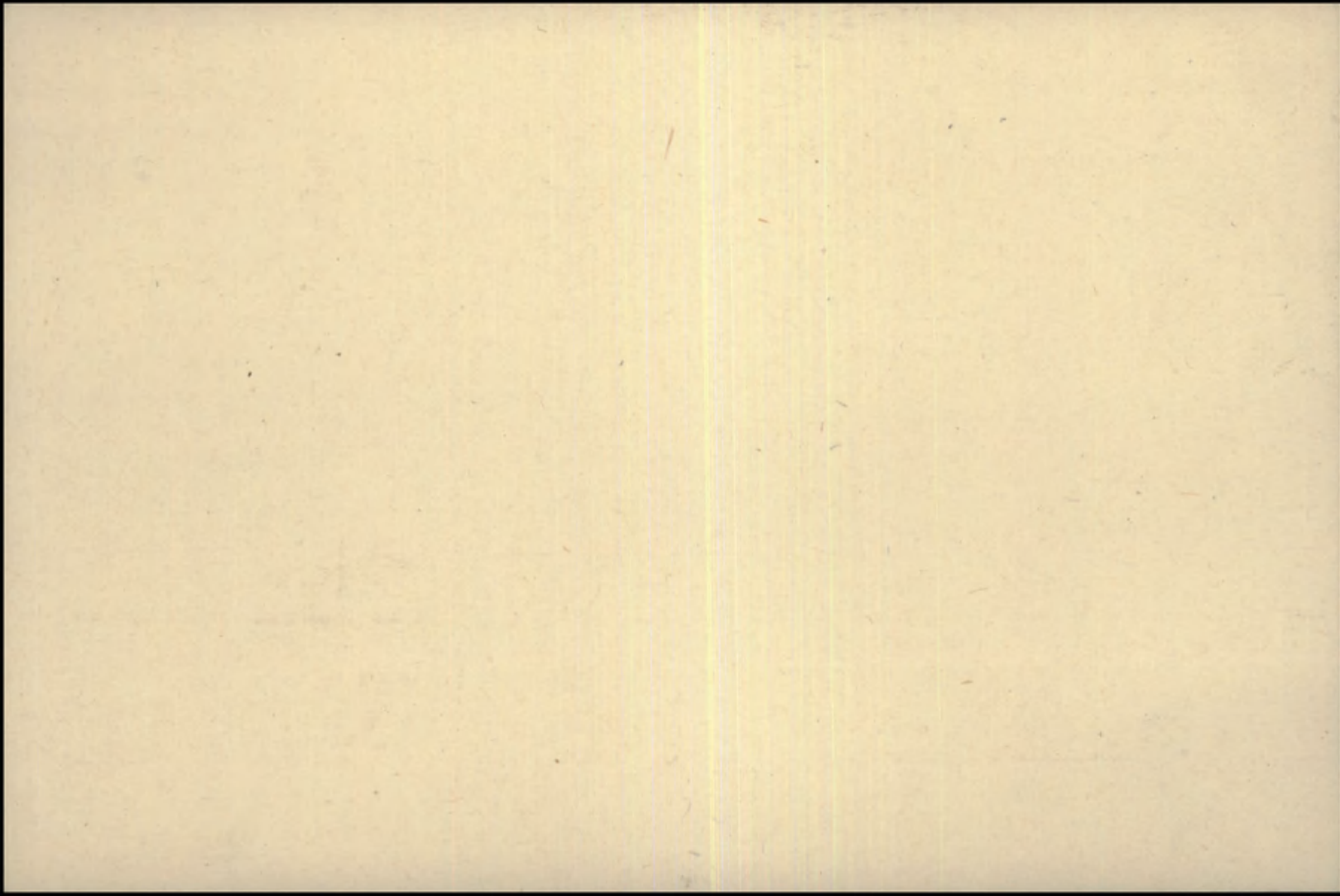

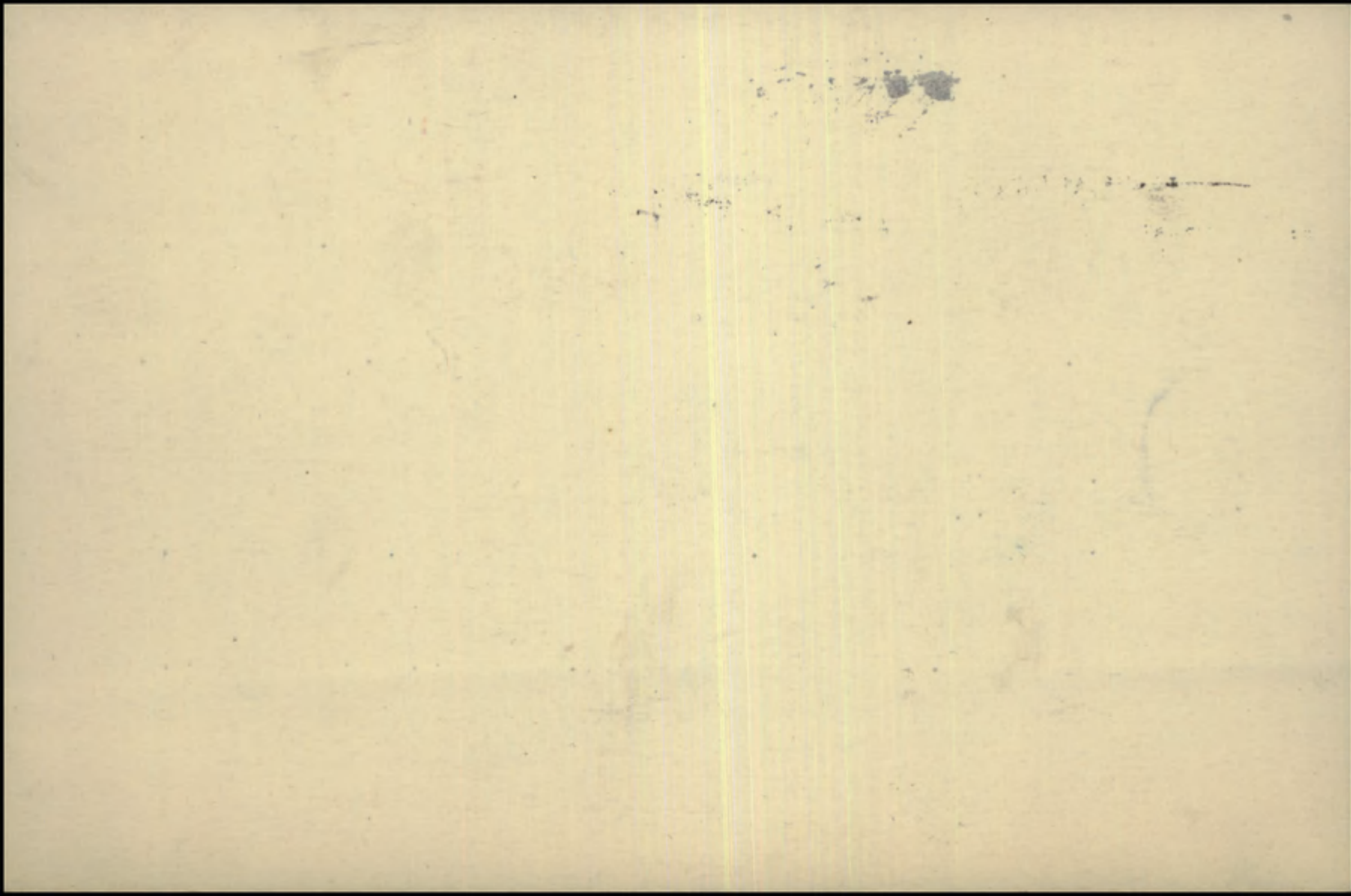
