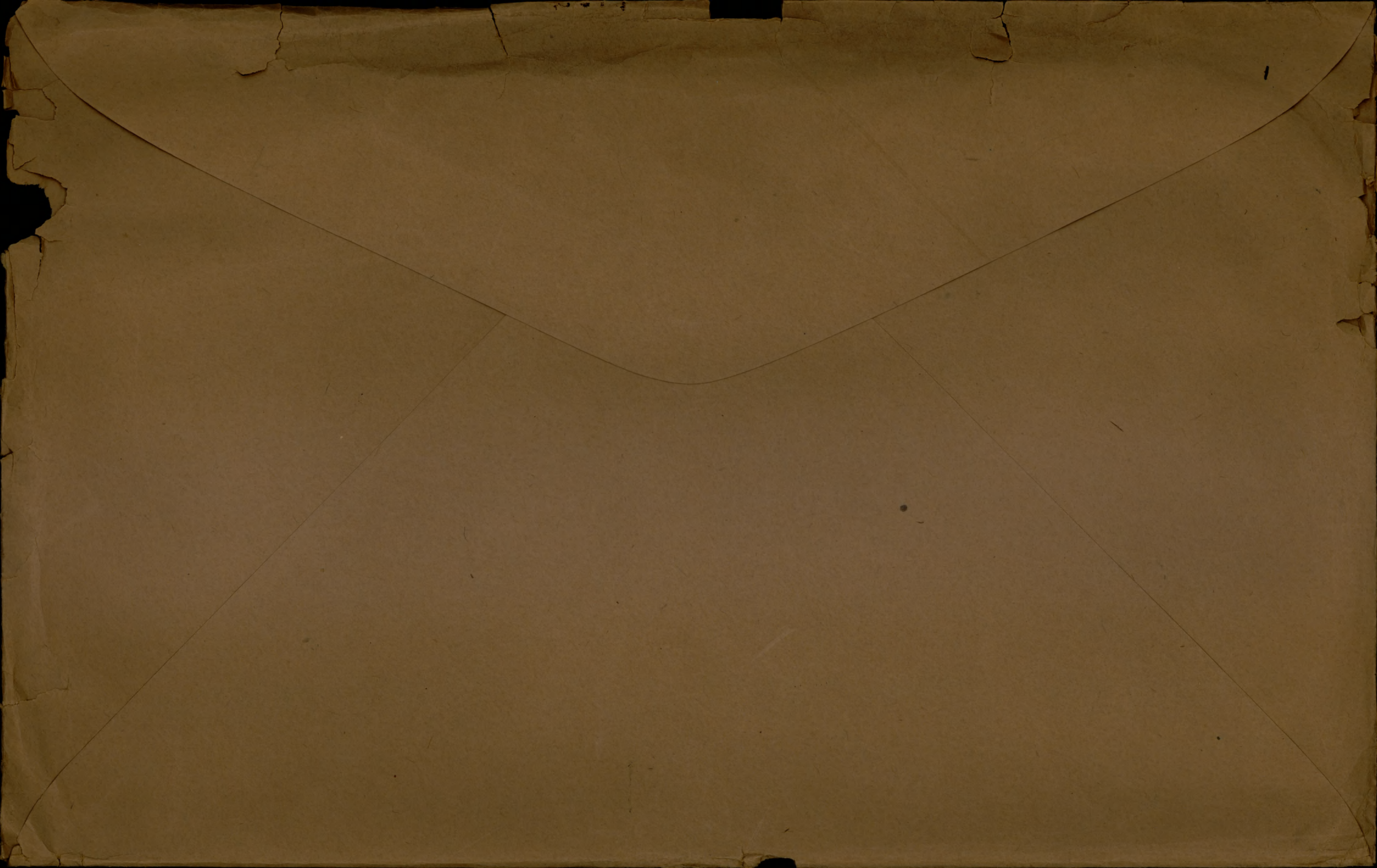

On admission has considerable stiffness in left elbow with some tenderness on movement. The Rt. has same condition but it is very much less. Also both knees are tender on movement & quite stiff. No swelling in any of the joints. Teeth are fairly good, a few need stopping.

Complaints - Shortness of breath on exertion, general weakness when he tries to move about. Considerable cough which causes pain in epigastric & below Rt nipple. Has pain below Rt nipple on deep inspiration. Occasional pain in precordial region, worse on exertion. Has headache (slight) at times.
