Lieut. A.A. McLean (Bombing Officer) makes the following statement:-

On 9th February 1917 While operating with live grenades in the 18th Canadian Battalion Bombing Camp the following accident occurred. I was instructing # 123642 Private H. Nichols on shooting Hales rifle, grenades # 20 Mark 1/2 (Banquet pattern) I examined rifle grenade and found it apparently in good shape

I then placed it in position in rifle and Private Nichols pulled safety pin and then I continued instructing him in aiming and firing of same. I then told him to fire which he did. The grenade left rifle and exploded in the air about 5 or 6 feet away from muzzle of rifle.

#802205 Pte R. Shiggs who had fired his grenade had returned to trench, where remainder of class was under cover, was struck in face and wounded.

#802174 Pte W. R. Devlin who was in trench receiving instructions in detonating of grenades was struck in face.

#775483 Pte J. S. Fry who was in trench received wound in hip.

I took all necessary precautions to protect those whom I was instructing.

Lieut R. S. Norton makes the following statement:-
On Friday Feb. 9, 1917 I had a party of C Company Grenadiers for instruction in hand a rifle grenades. by Lieut McLean. During the course of instruction a Grenade exploded about 6 feet from the muzzle of Private Nichols rifle when three men were wounded.

All men except Private Nichols, who was firing grenade and Lieut McLean who was instructing were back to cover. Previous to this Lieut McLean had given them instructions about the grenade and how to fire it.

I consider that Lieut McLean took every precaution against accidents.

R. S. Norton

226622 Pte J. H. Norton make the following statement:-

I was placing detonators in Hals rifle grenades #20 Mark 1/2 on Friday February 9, 1917, during class of instruction under Lieut McLean. Before placing detonators I examined the grenades and found that firing pins were held back by pellets and I am certain so far as I know ^{Grenades} were not defective.

Apart from hearing I do not know anything about the accident except that three men were wounded.

He had all men warned to keep in trench.

123642 Pte H Nichols makes the following statement:-

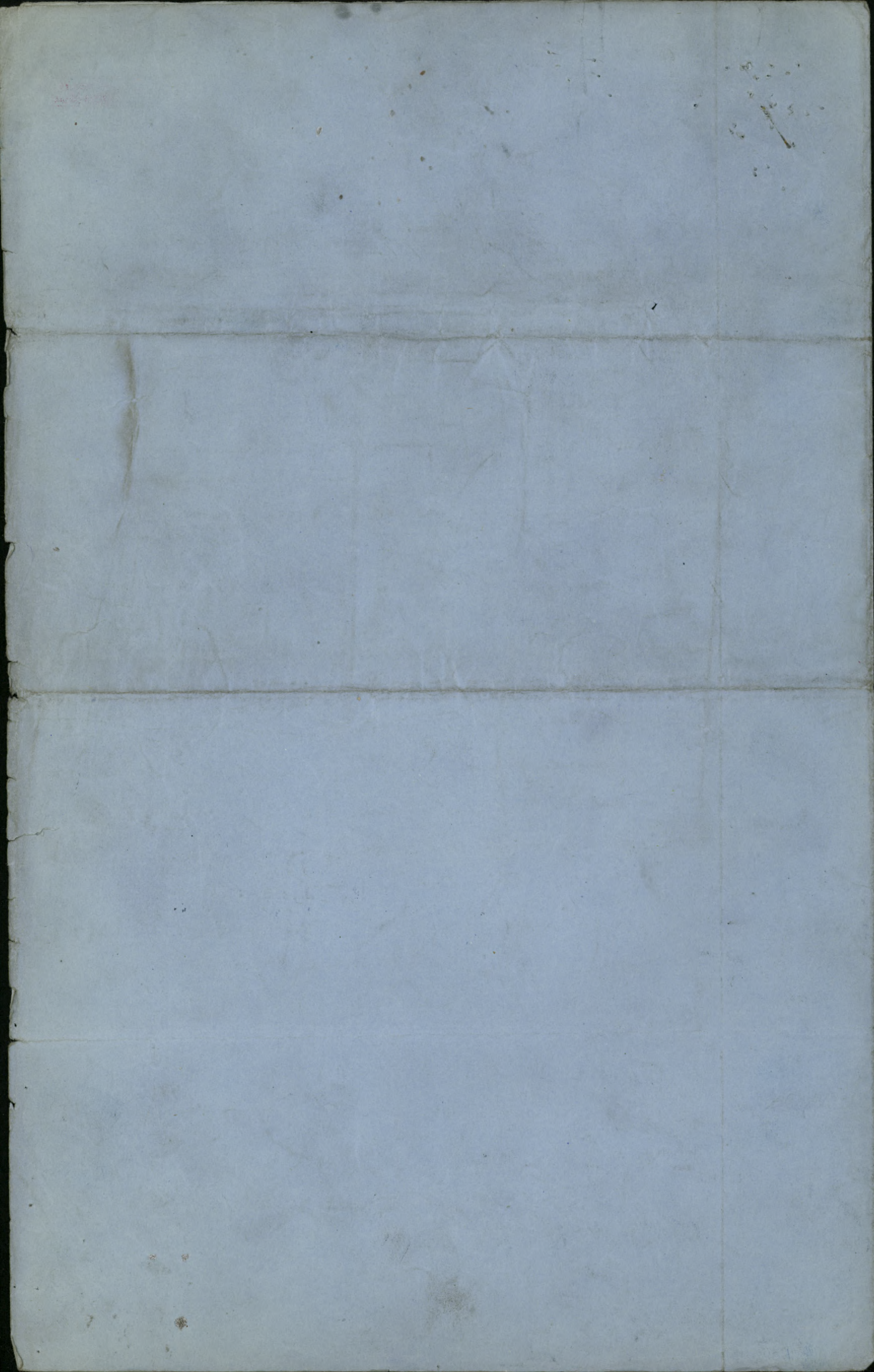
On February 9 1917 during class of instruction by Liut McLean. I was being instructed on firing rifle grenades. Liut McLean had placed rifle grenade in rifle, he told me to pull safety pin which I did. After pulling pin he instructed me in aiming he then told me to fire, and pressed the trigger. When an explosion occurred almost instantly overhead which knocked me over and deafened me. as far as I can make out grenade burst after leaving rifle. H. Nichols

#407038 Pte F.R. Green makes the following statement:-

On February 9, 1917 during a Class of Instruction on grenades I was in a trench behind the firing point with rest of class. I saw one rifle grenade fired by Pte Nichol which burst in air about 6 feet from rifle when three men were wounded. All men except one actually firing were instructed to keep in trench.

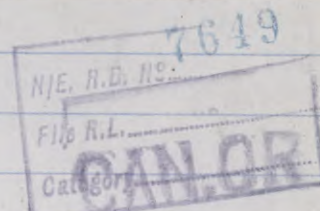

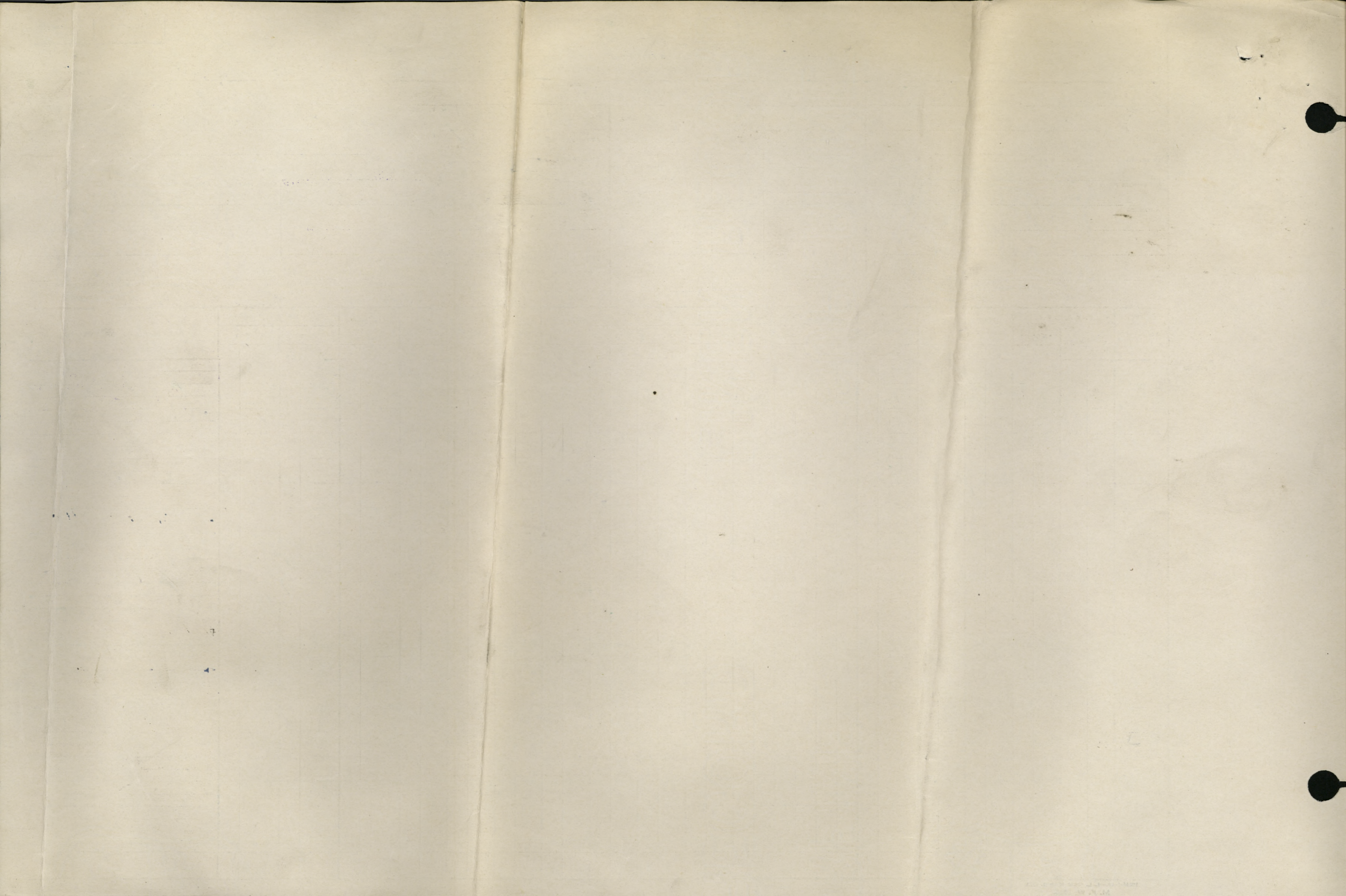
