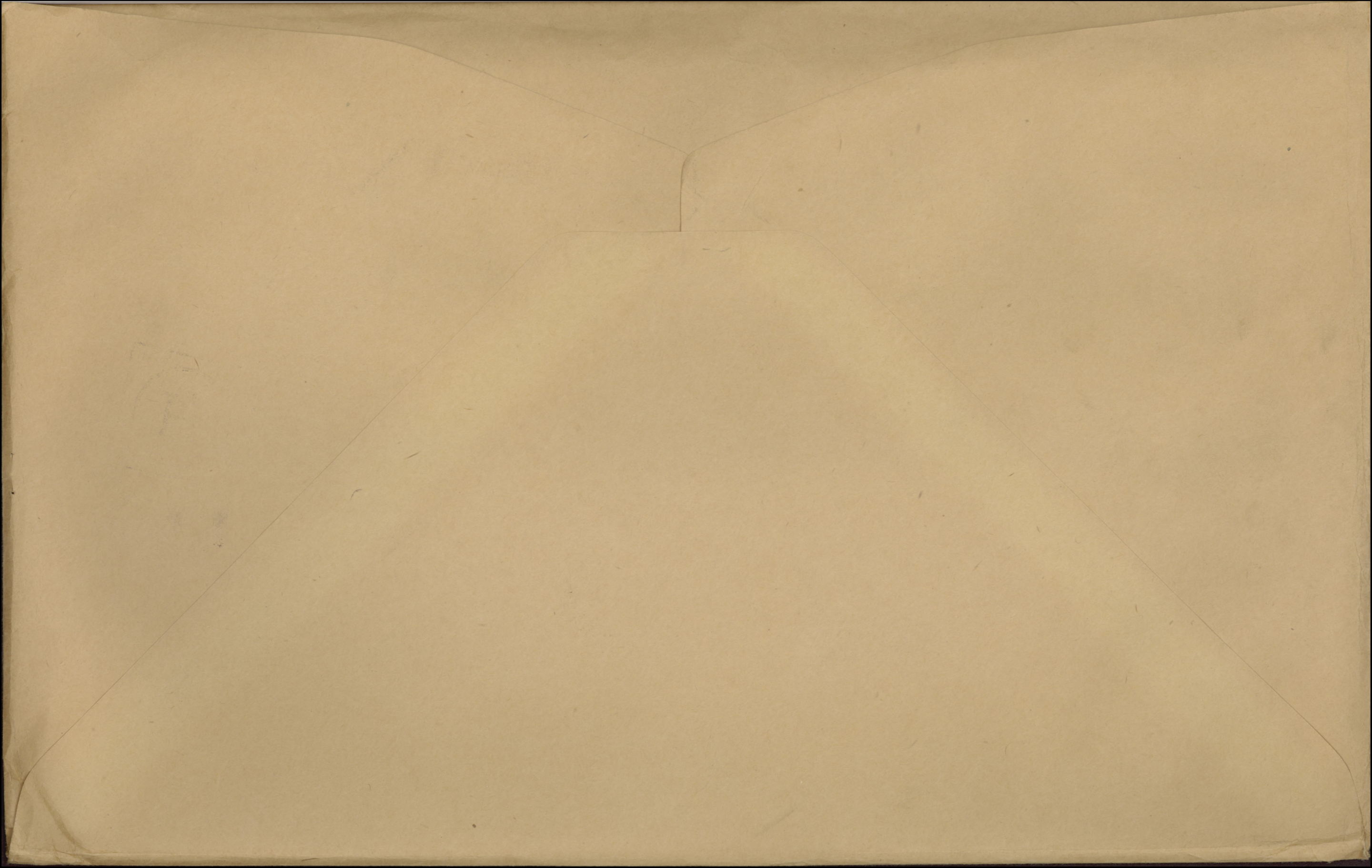

However, knee does not seem to be improving. It is still painful upon walking up hill. Also, a few days ago, knee was sprained while dismounting from horse.

At present, knee is very slightly tender, and there is a very slight puffiness.

The Board having assembled pursuant to order, and having read the instructions on the back of the form, proceed to examine the above-named officer and find that
this officer had knee injured 25-5-17 playing football, but in May 1914 he had a similar injury which left knee weak and necessitated constant use of an elastic knee bandage. At present he still complains of some pain and stiffness of knee and some pain in wet weather. Examination reveals some swelling of joint with slight amount of fluid present. The Board does not think he is fit for General Service especially during winter months and recommend as below.

The Board having assembled pursuant to order, and having read the instructions on the back of the form, proceed to examine the above-named Officer and find that he received an injury (or injuries) as stated above, and that This Officer states that in 1914 he injured the knee while playing baseball, and had much pain and swelling. Since that time it has troubled him on several occasions. On May 25th at Crowborough, while playing baseball he again injured the knee. He entered Crowborough Hosp. May 28, 1917, and was transferred to this Hospital 19-7-17. His present condition is as stated in A.F.A.45 of this date.

The opinion of the Board upon the questions herein is as follows:—

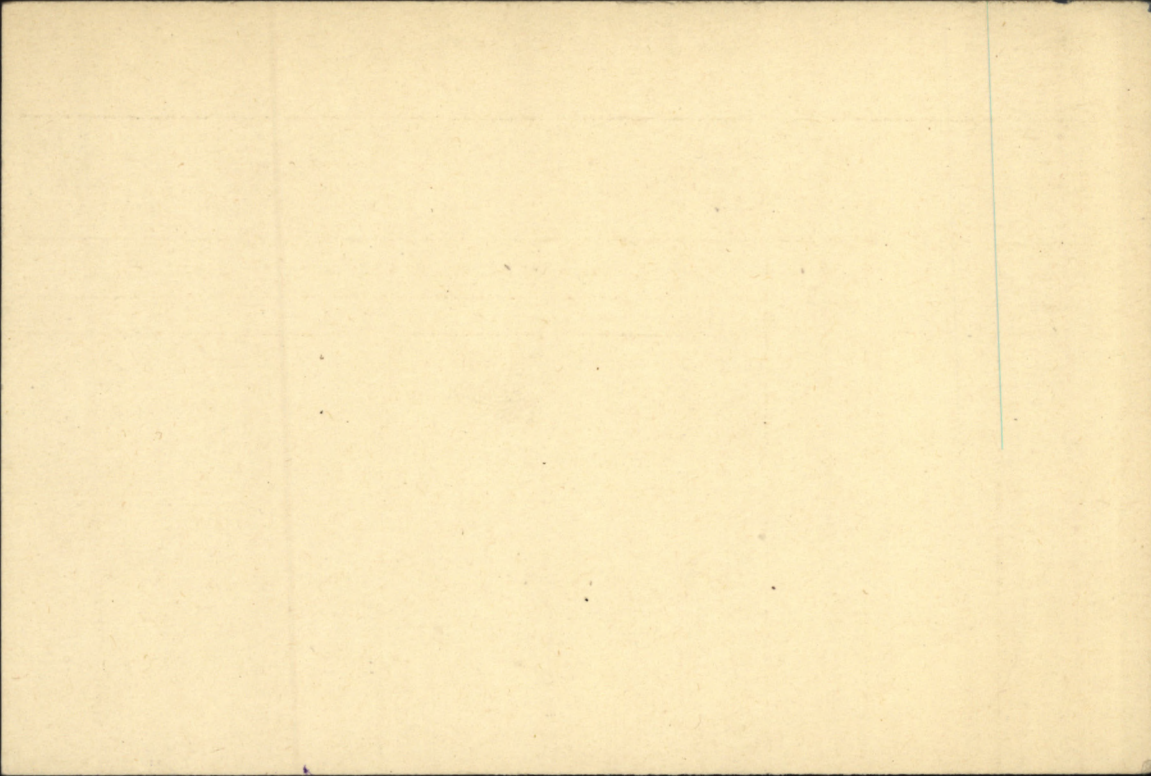

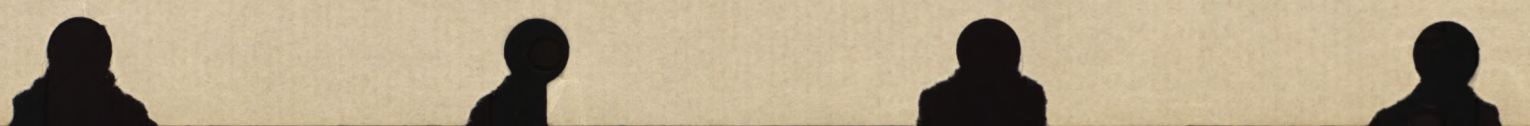

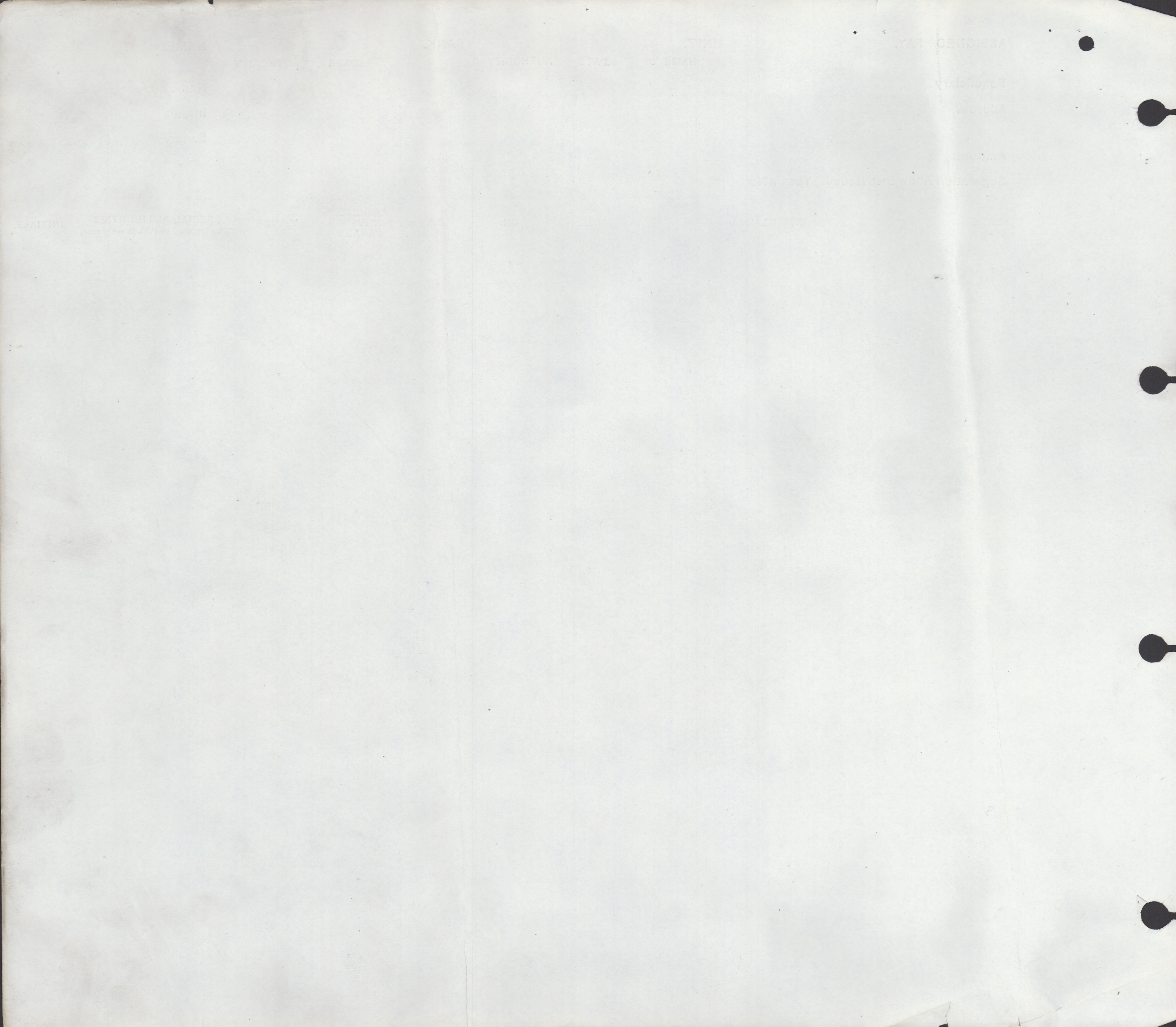
