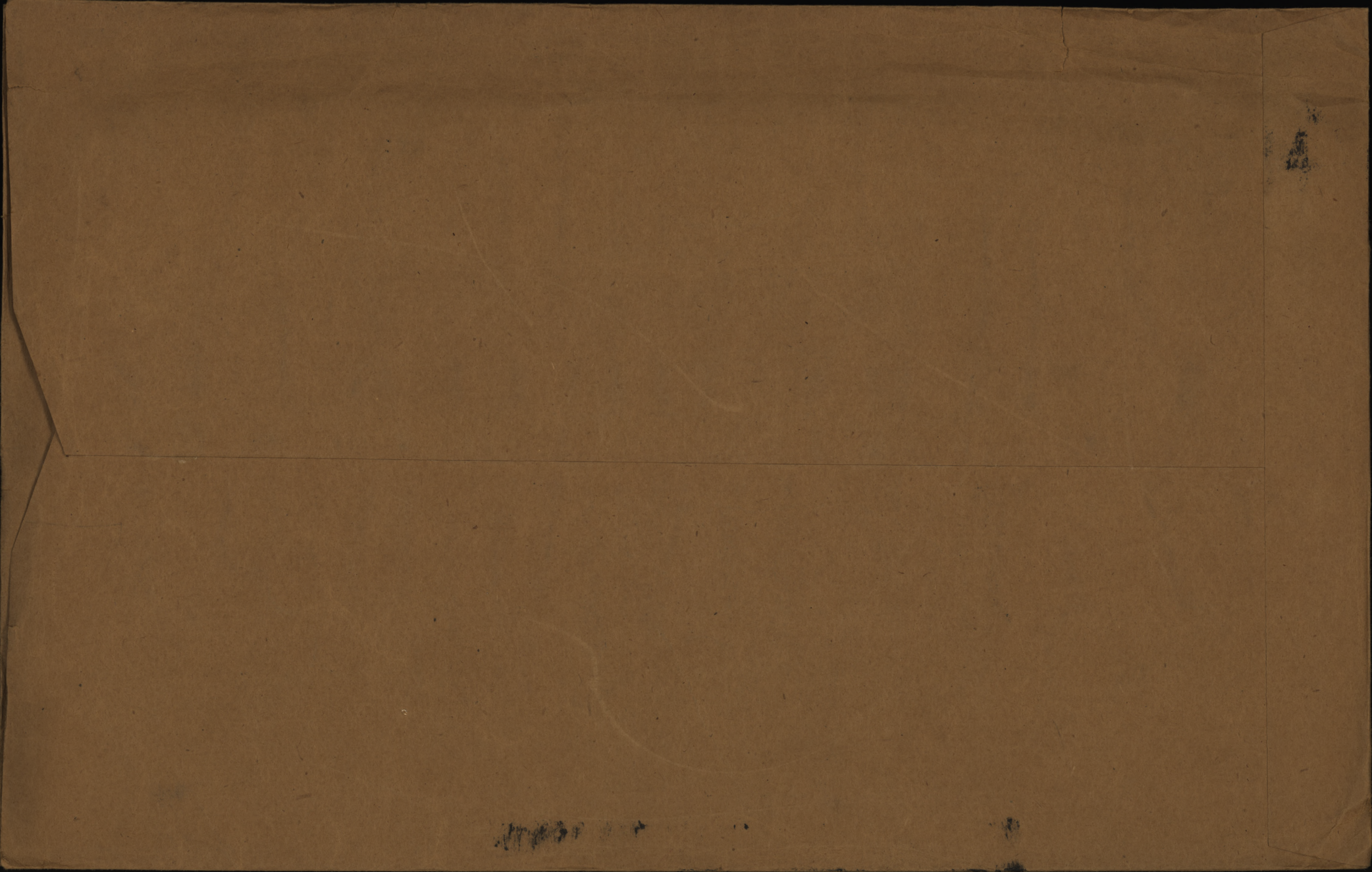

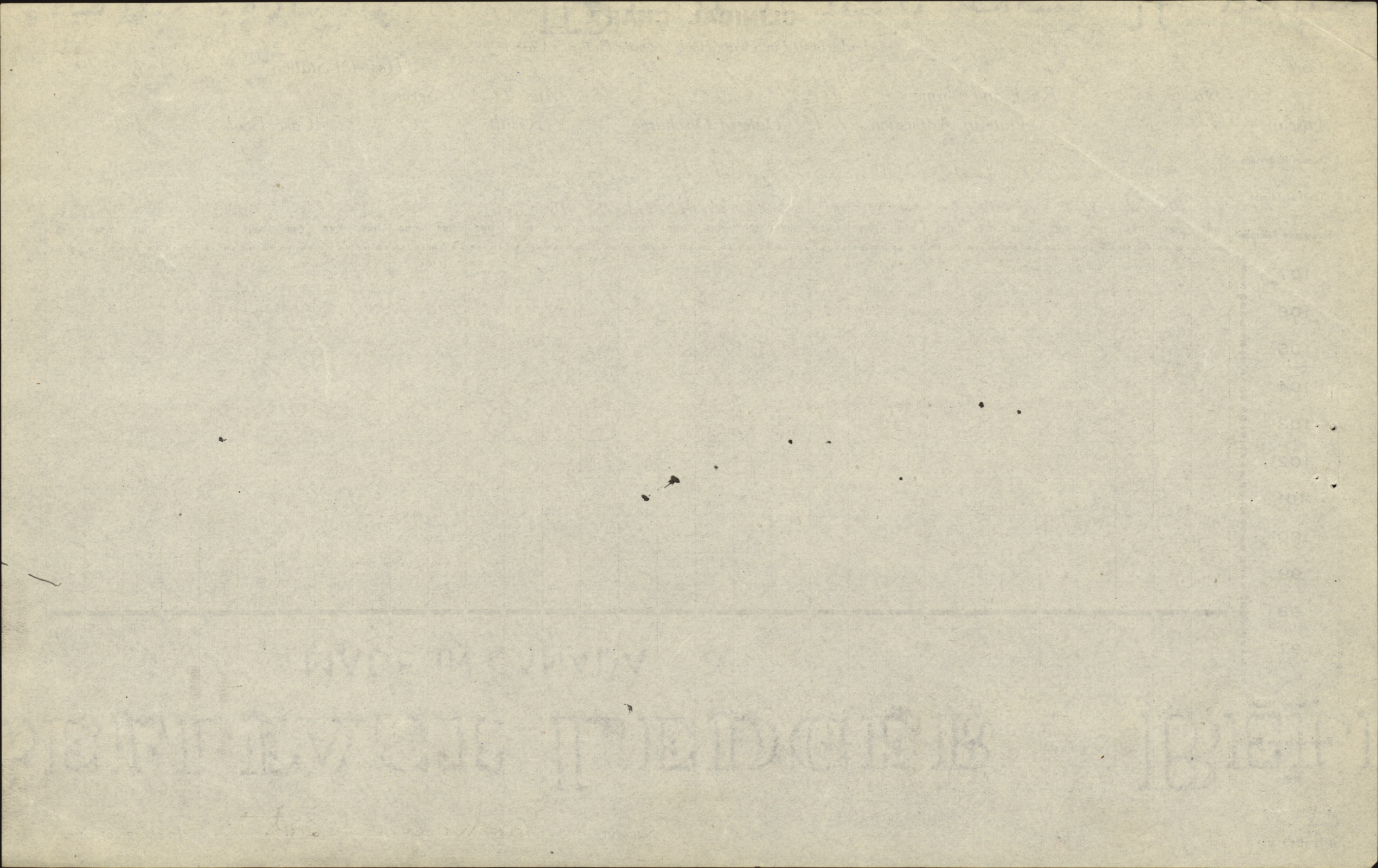

It was a severe case of measles with marked rash very severe cough and he looked somewhat anemic. Later in the disease he developed Otitis Media with a profuse discharge of the right ear. On the 11th. of April the patient developed pneumonia involving the left lung. His En. was notified that his condition was dangerous and his mother came and stopped with him. In my opinion the patient received every care and the best of treatment until the time of his death at 6.20 a.m. on the 16th. of April/18
