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Preface

◆ This bibliography was prepared for the Royal Commission on Aboriginal Peoples by the Centre for Policy and Program Assessment of the School of Public Administration at Carleton University. The bibliography consists of primary sources, such as reports and policy documents, rather than books and articles on Aboriginal issues.

The project was undertaken during 1992 and involved a review of documentation which was submitted to the Royal Commission by various Aboriginal organizations, the federal, and the provincial and territorial governments. Entries were also collected as part of on-site visits to these organizations by members of the project team.

Cette bibliographie est constituée de sources primaires comme des rapports et des énoncés de principes plutôt que de livres et d'articles traitant de questions autochtones.
