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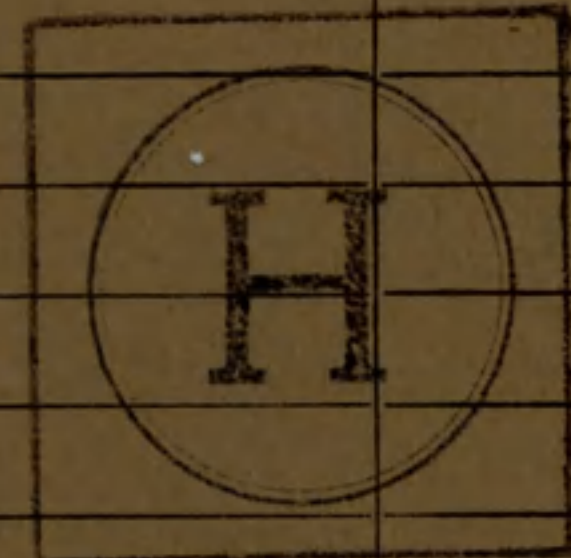
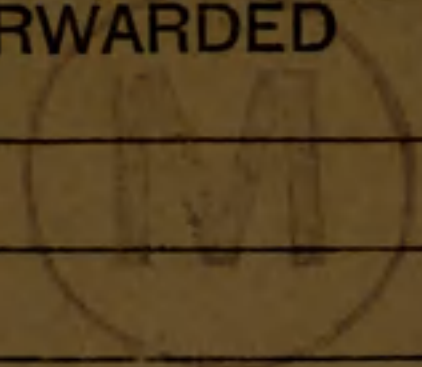

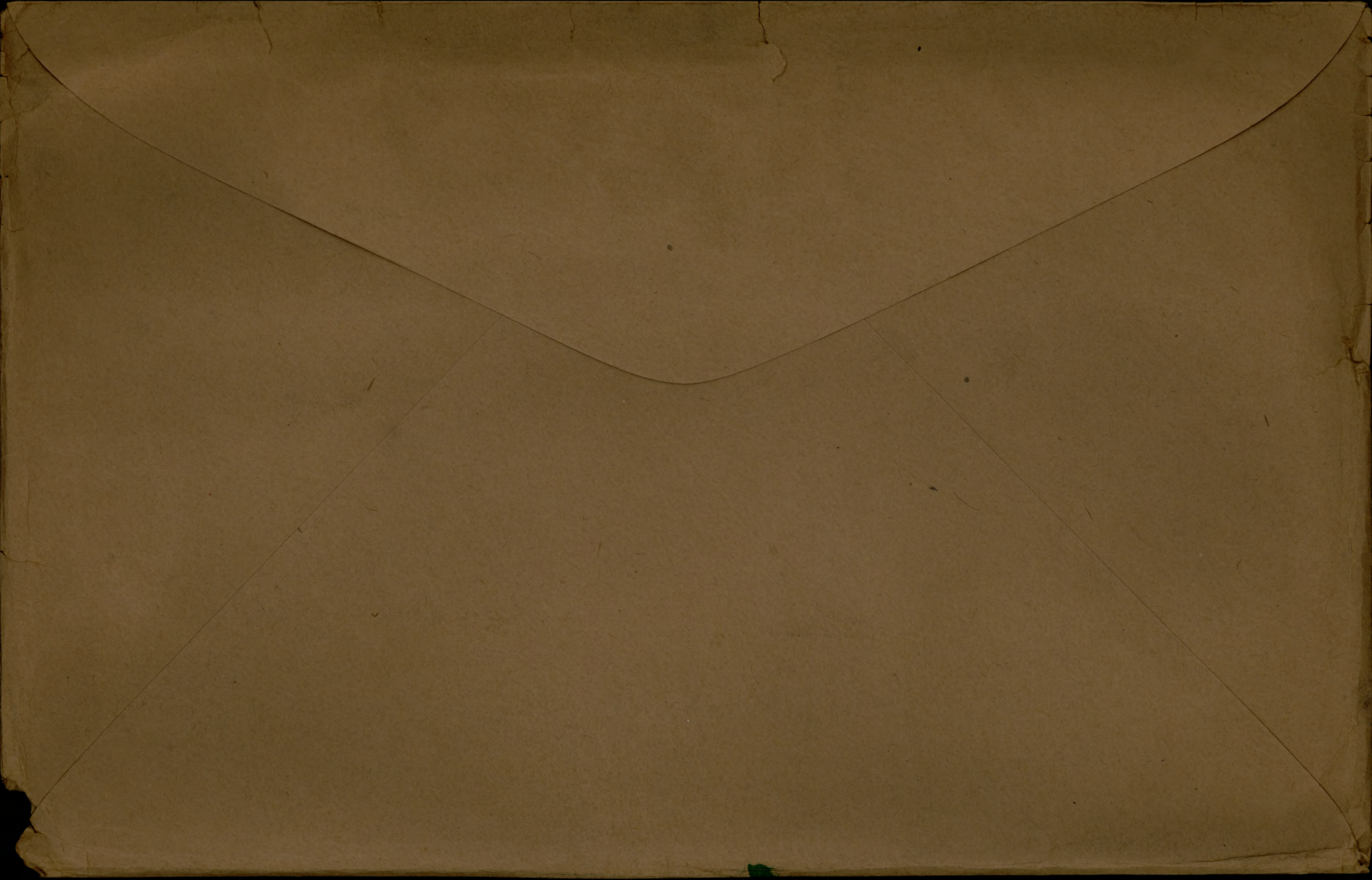

Dear Mr. Alley:

I have for acknowledgement your letter dated January 30th, concerning the Memorial Plaque issued to your mother in memory of your late father, Private Eric Elgin Alley, who was, for official purposes, presumed to have died in action 17th September, 1916.

In reply thereto, it may be stated it was decided by His Majesty's Government during World War I (1914-18), that a memorial be presented to the next of kin of all those members of His Majesty's Forces who lost their lives through the War. This memorial was in the form of a bronze plaque of emblematic design and a parchment scroll with appropriate wording. The plaque measuring 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter and $\frac{1}{4}$ inch in thickness bore the deceased's christian names and surname. The scroll, which measured 11 x 7 inches, bore his rank, christian names, surname and regiment. Both the memorials were accompanied by a letter from His Majesty.

The aforementioned memorial is commonly known as the "King's Memorial Plaque and Scroll", and approximately 60,000 Memorial Plaques and Scrolls were issued to the next of kin of deceased members of the Canadian Armed Forces, World War I (1914-18).
