

History:-
 Patient admitted to hospital on 12/10/1915 with a complaint of pain and swelling of the right hand and wrist. The pain was described as a dull ache and was worse at night. There was no history of trauma or injury to the hand. The patient had been working in a factory for 10 years and had noticed the symptoms gradually over the last few months. The pain was accompanied by a feeling of stiffness and a loss of power in the hand. The patient had consulted a general practitioner who had prescribed rest and aspirin, but the symptoms had not improved. The patient was referred to the orthopaedic department of the hospital. On admission, the patient was found to have a moderate swelling of the right hand and wrist. The skin was normal in color and temperature. There was tenderness over the wrist and the base of the 2nd and 3rd metacarpals. The range of motion of the wrist was limited by pain and swelling. The patient's occupation was that of a factory worker. The patient was operated on on 12/10/1915. The operation consisted of the excision of the inflamed synovial tissue and the removal of the 2nd and 3rd metacarpals. The patient made a good recovery and was discharged on 15/10/1915. The patient has remained well and free of symptoms since the operation.
