The above Officer was in command of a Raiding party of 40 which included the above W.C.O. and men. The Party successfully entered the enemy trenches at about A.4.d.30.20. Lieutenant Shortt leading. After successfully bombing dugouts and inflicting casualties on the enemy, the whole party returned when it was found that the marginally noted Officer and Other Banks were missing. Pte. Nish was mortally wounded in the German trench near the point of entry. It was in a difficult part of the trench and efforts to remove him were unsuccessful. The Raid was to be made at two points on either side of the BATTLE communication trench. The left hand party got in but the right were held up by wire. Nothing definite can be ascertained regarding Lieutenant Shortt and Sergeant Brazier. They both entered the enemy trenches with the left party and we can trace them no further than that point. It is thought that possibly they went to the right, along the German front line on finding that the right party were held up and ran into some Germans in the unraided part of the trench. The ground outside the enemy wire has been thoroughly patrolled but no trace of them can be found. I enclose statement of 4 of the members of the party which is all the evidence bearing on the subject that can be obtained. I cannot find that any blame is attaching to any member of the Raiding Party for the disappearance of Lieutenant Shortt and the two Other Banks. The whole operation went as planned except for the right two parties were held up by wire.

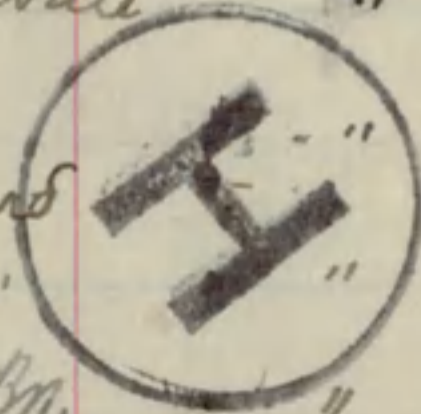
