
Patient profoundly shocked. Pulse rapid, thready,

SECOND WITNESS: No. 2768057 Rfm. Wilson, B.A. "A" Coy, 259th Bn. C.E.F. (S) being duly sworn, gives evidence:
 I was on duty on the passageway leading to the Men's quarters. About eleven thirty, I saw the refrigerator slide across the deck and knock down the deceased who was well known to me. It slid back again to the rail and returned pinning him to the steering rod and deck. -Question: by Lt. Hearst- "How long was he there?" -Answer: About ten or fifteen minutes.

 "I was standing in the passageway on the port aft deck when I saw the refrigerator coming across the deck. The deceased was standing with his back to it, was knocked down. The roll of the ship carried the box back and when it returned it pinned him against the steering gear"

FOURTH WITNESS: No. 5111210 Rfm. Pitt, P.H. "B" Coy, 259th Batt. C.E.F. (S) being duly sworn, gives evidence:
 "I was standing about three yards from where the deceased was standing. The roll of the ship took me off my feet and as I fell I saw the refrigerator slide across the deck and knock the deceased down. The refrigerator rolled back and he rolled with it. It returned and crushed him beneath it. Question by Capt Bennett- "Do you know what held the refrigerator in place?" Answer- "I saw a piece of wire cable which was broken which evidently held it" Question- "How thick was it?" Answer - "About three (3) inches"

FIFTH WITNESS: I was called to attend the deceased No. 2768760 Rfm. Harold Lee Butler, "A" Coy, 259th Batt. C.E.F. (Siberia) immediately after the accident and examined him. I found him jammed between an immense case or refrigerator containing meat and one of hatchways. The head and upper part of body were not severely injured. Both knee thighs, bones of both legs were broken in many places, being severely lacerated on left leg and side. Part of bones of both legs being driven upwards into the abdomen. He was removed to the Hospital, given every attention by myself, and three other Medical Officers and died at One O'Clock"

I was standing on port side aft near the refrigerator ator between 11:30 and 12:00 O'clock upon on the 30th instant day of December 1918. The cable securing the refrigerator to the ship gave way and the refrigerator slid along the deck towards the hatchway. The deceased was leaning against the hatch and the refrigerator knocked him over pinning him to the hatch. The roll of the ship carried it away from him. He fell to the deck. The refrigerator slid back again pinning him beneath the steering rod and remained there until removed by the Ship's crew.

Q- By Lieut Elliott, "Was the sea rough when the refrigerator gave way?"
ANSWER: "Yes, the ship was rolling heavily."
Q- How long did the refrigerator remain pinning the deceased to the steering gear?"
ANSWER- "About ten minutes". "There was no means at hand to pry it off."
