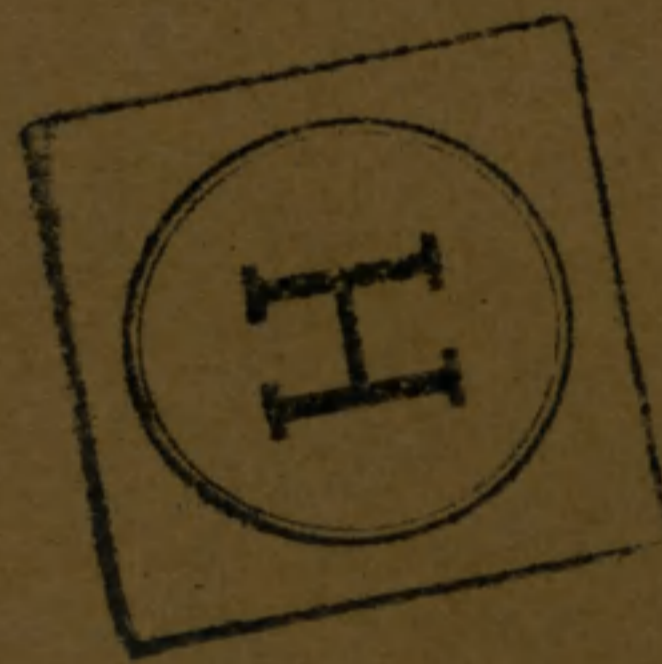
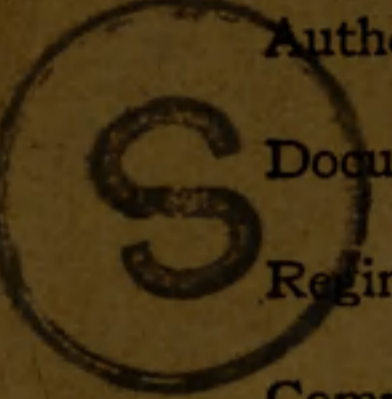

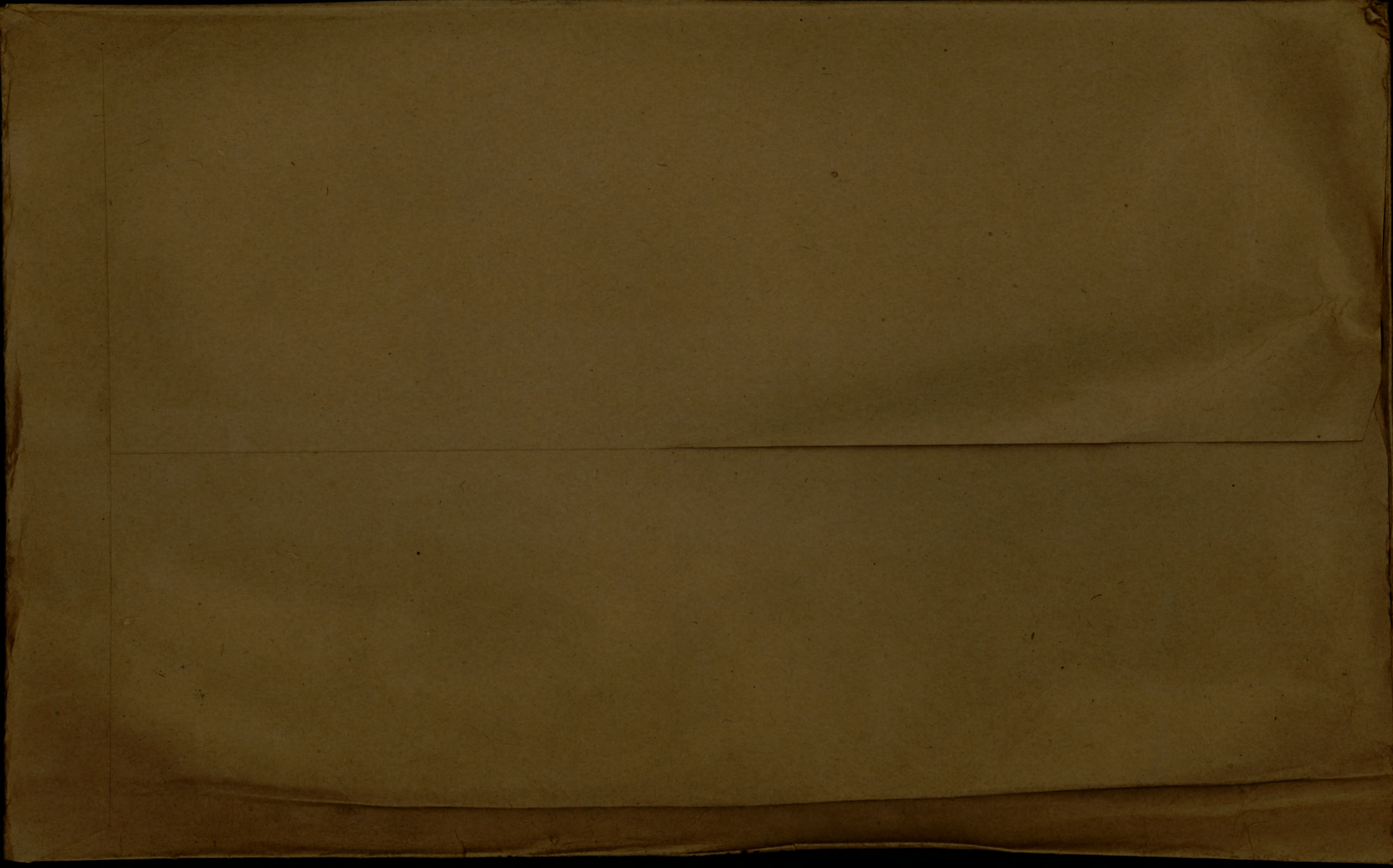

I nominate, constitute and appoint my said Executrix guardian of my infant child the said Alfred Thomas Cahill and hereby grant, devise and bequeath my said child to her.

I hereby direct that my said Executrix shall educate my said infant child in the Separate school and that he shall be educated and brought up in the Catholic Religion.

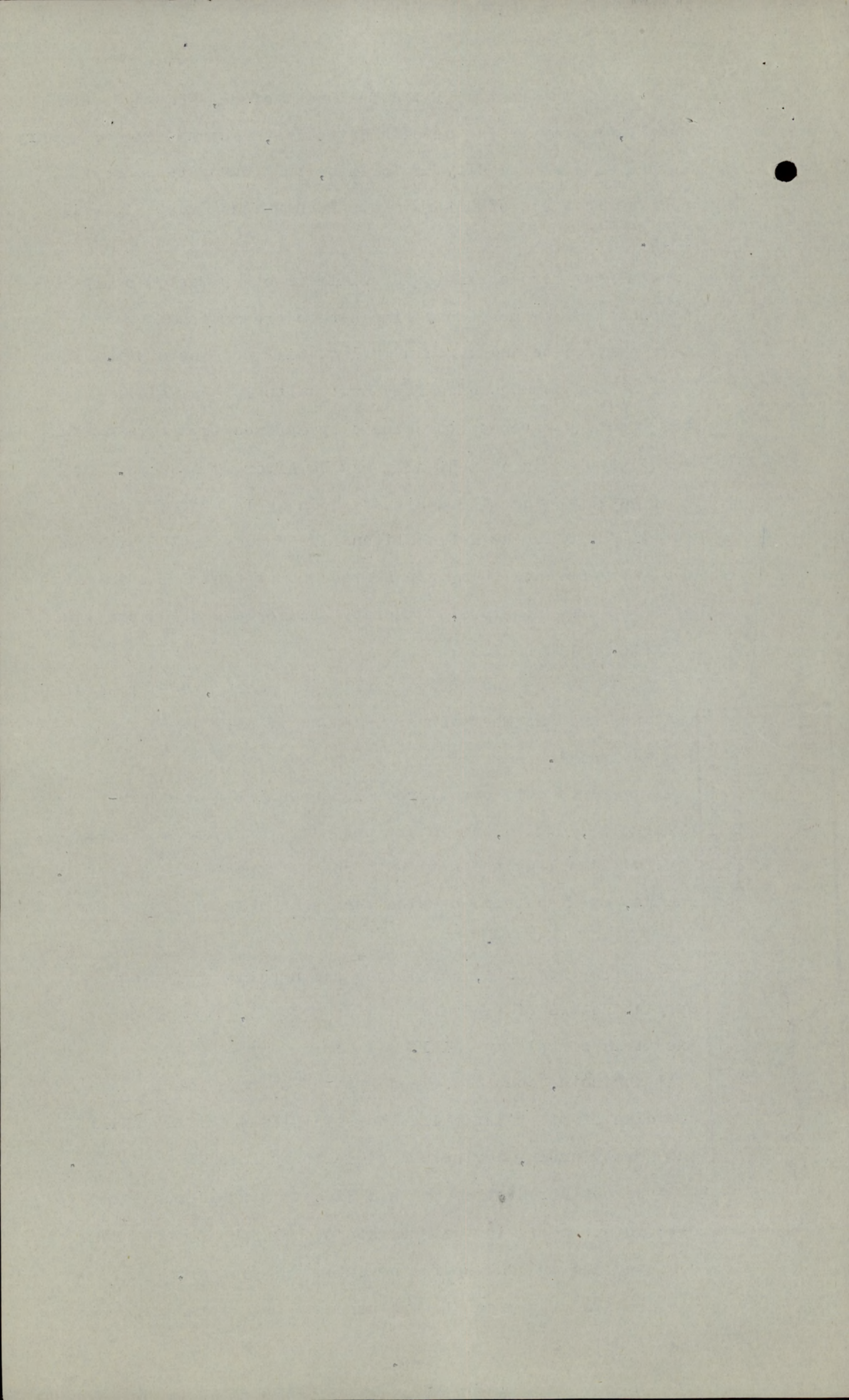
