## DIRECTIONS

- 1.—The Testator is the person who makes the Will.
- 2.—Write shortly and concisely the manner in which you desire to dispose of your property. Use plain words and avoid legal phrases, or words you do not understand.
- 3.—Attend particularly to the legal formalities required in the execution of the Will.
- 4.—Do not attempt to make a Codicil to your Will, that is, an addition or alteration of its provisions. It is better to re-write a Will than to alter it. No stamp is required on a Will.
- 5.—Persons under the age of twenty-one years cannot make a Will. All property can be disposed of by Will.
- 6.—Every Will should be first signed at *the foot or end thereof*—(the signature of the Testator to be on the next line following the end of the writing)—by the person making it, or by some other person in his presence and by his direction; such signature must be in the presence of at least *two witnesses*, who must sign their *names* and *addresses* against the attestation clause before either leaves testator's presence. It is not necessary that the witnesses should know the contents of the Will—all they have to do is to witness the Testator's signature.
- 7.—Against every alteration or interlineation made before the Will is executed, the Testator and the Witnesses must sign their initials or names, and the fact of their having been made should be noted in the attestation clause. But when possible it is better to re-write a Will than have any alterations in it. Nothing should be scratched out or erased, or the Will might be invalidated.
- 8.—Persons who take anything under a Will should not be witnesses, as bequests made to them would be invalid. The wife, or husband, of a person who takes anything under a Will should not be a witness, as the gift would be altogether void. Executors should not witness a Will, as any bequest made to them would then be void.
- 9.—A legacy to a friend is made void by his death before the Testator's.
- 10.—A legacy to a Testator's child, or other issue, does not lapse by his death if he has any issue living at the time of the Testator's death, but the legacy takes effect as if he had died immediately after the Testator.
- 11.—A soldier in actual military service, and a mariner or seaman at sea can dispose of his personal property by any written paper signed by him, though not attested.
- 12.—A Will is revoked by the marriage of a person making it; except by marriage, it can only be revoked by another Will, or writing executed like a Will, or by destruction, that is by tearing or burning. Drawing a pen over a Will does not cancel it.
- 13.—After a Will has been duly executed, no addition to, nor alteration in it, may be made.
- 14.—A woman, married after the first of January, 1883, can, on attaining twenty-one, make a Will disposing of all real and personal property which she had at her marriage, or has since become possessed of. A woman married before the first of January, 1883, can make a Will disposing of any separate property vested in her before that date, and any property acquired by her afterwards.
- 15.—Before proving a Will the executors should purchase a small book, "How to prove a Will," price Sixpence, post free Sevenpence, to be had from ALFRED HINDE, WOLVERHAMPTON, or any Bookseller, by means of which they will be able to prove a Will without legal aid.
