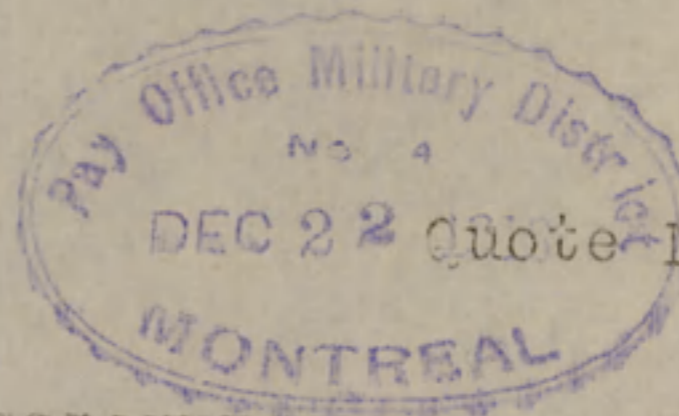

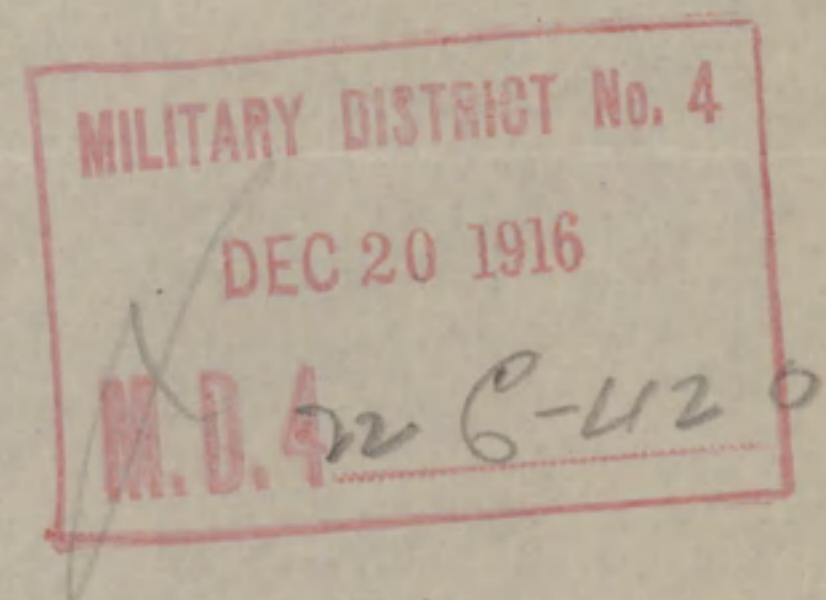

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PROCEEDINGS OF A MEETING OF THE ADVISORY BOARD TO THE BOARD OF PENSION COMMISSIONERS held at Ottawa, on the 6th December, 1916, for the purpose of reporting upon the case of MRS. MARIANNE COLLIN, who, as the widow of No. 61100, Private Adelard Collin, 22nd Overseas Battalion, Canadian Expeditionary Force, claims pension for herself and her son.

The Board proceed to examine B.P.C. Fyle No. 649-C-5435 which shows:

That the late Adelard Collin was a Private (No. 61100) in the 22nd Overseas battalion, Canadian Expeditionary Force; that he was killed in action on September 16th, 1916; and that he left surviving him his widow, the said MRS. MARIANNE COLLIN, aged 29 years, and one son, as follows:

OPINION.

The Board, having considered the foregoing, is of opinion:

1. That the claimant, the said MRS. MARIANNE COLLIN, is entitled, as provided for in approved Minute of Privy Council No. 1334 of June 3rd, 1916, to a Pension of Three Hundred and Eighty-four Dollars (\$384.00) per annum, for so long as she does not re-marry; and that there should be paid to her, monthly, for the benefit of her son, the sum of
