Duration - First noticed three weeks ago. Two weeks ago it increased rapidly in size.

- Three weeks ago patient noticed a small beanlike lump in the left groin after about one week it began to increase rapidly in size and locality has become red and quite painful.

patient had glands removed from angle of jaw R.
Has since had no trouble of this nature

Left groin shows rather tender somewhat indurated ^{slightly} fluctuating tumor just in situation of inguinal glands. No signs or history of recent venereal condition. Local & regional lymph nodes also infl.

The inguinal adenitis may be due to a subacute infection from the local streptococcal wound or to the condition. The deep iliac glands are enlarged and a little tender.

Treat: hot compresses to groin. & have operation

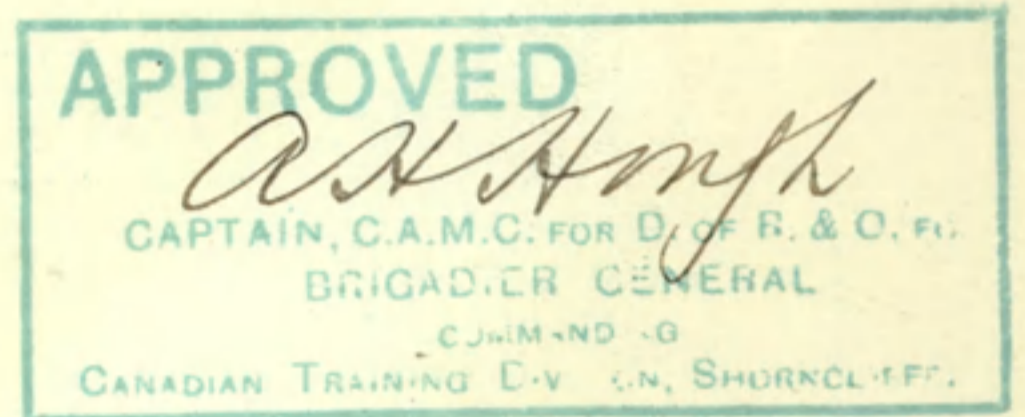

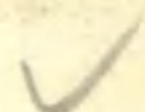

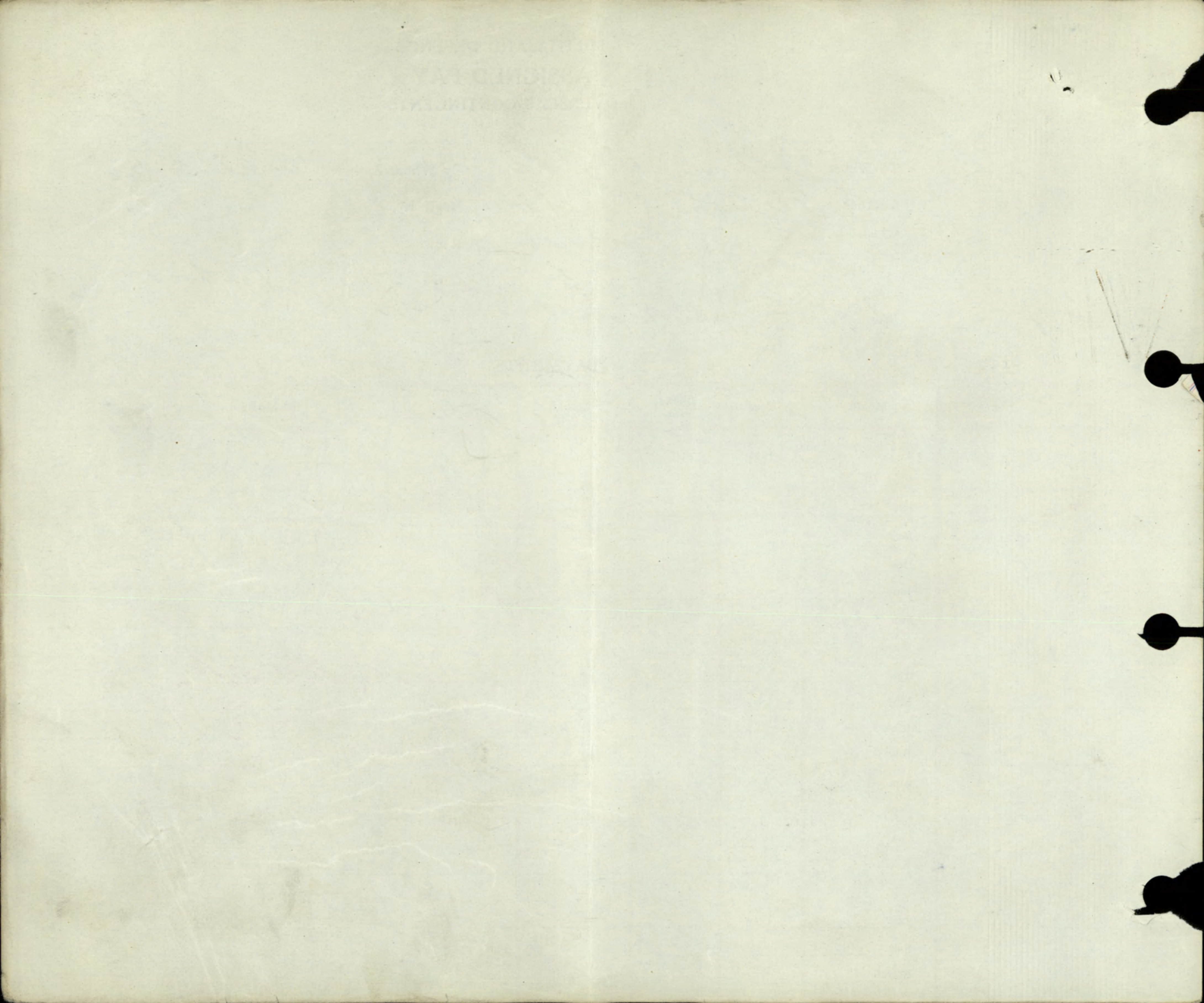
