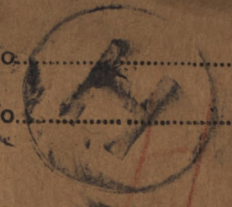
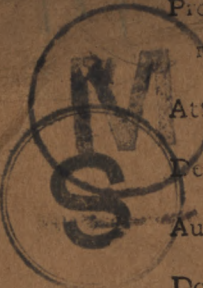

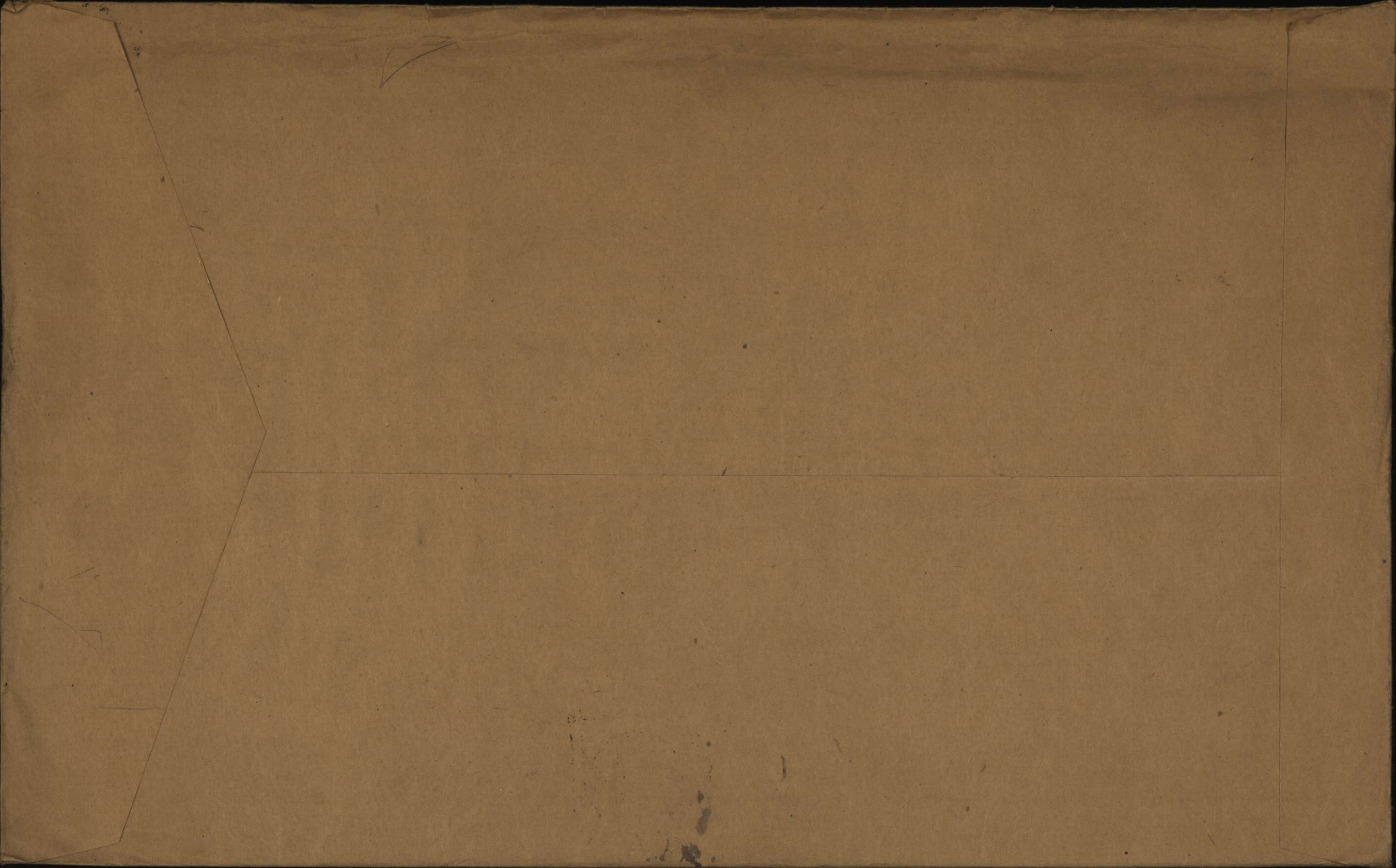

after Co Sgt Maj. Pratt had been missed. I remained
for half an hour and the body had not been found
up to that time. I saw his clothes lying on the Bank
of the Canal.

Third Witness # 9166 Pte W. B. Brailsford states: -

Sir, I saw Sgt Maj. Pratt at Bathing Point just
previous to his going in for a swim. I then left there
and returned an hour later when I found he was
missing and saw his clothes on the Bank. About
6⁰⁰ P.M. I proceeded with stretcher to ^{supposed} point of drowning
and found the body had been recovered, and we
carried it to transport field.

Fourth Witness # 9816 Pte W. R. Newport states: -

Sir, I was sitting on Bank when Sgt Maj. Pratt went
into the canal beside me. I saw him swim to
opposite Bank. I then started to swim to other
side and just before I reached the Bank he dove
in. My back was towards him and I did not
notice that he did not come up. That was the
last that I saw of him. He dove off the

- bank of the Canal where the Basin of the canal was very heavy mud. The water was very deep a few feet from the Bank of the Canal. I saw nothing further of him.
