WAR DIARIES, CA

Instructions for Compilation and Despatch

1. A War Diary is SECRET.
2. The War Diary takes the place of the Historical Record when on active service. (KR (Can) Para 1530). Its objects are: to supply authentic material for the history of the unit, and of the force; to furnish a historical record of operations; and to provide data upon which to base improvements in training, equipment, organization and administration.
3. Unless otherwise ordered, the original and duplicate copies are sent on the first day of the succeeding month, through the usual channels, to the AG 2nd Echelon, wherever that office may be. The triplicate copy may be held by the unit for three months and then forwarded, also through the usual channels, to AG, 2nd Echelon. In Canada all copies as above are sent through the usual channels to NDHQ; in England to Canadian Military HQ.
 - (i) District Officers Commanding will arrange to forward War Diaries to National Defence Headquarters addressed Director Historical Section, GS (War Diaries) with covering roll, in duplicate, showing unit from which received and number of copies in each case; the duplicate roll will be returned as a receipt.
 - (ii) Formations and Units in the Ottawa Area Command will forward War Diaries direct to National Defence Headquarters (addressed Director Historical Section, GS (War Diaries)).
4. Post-war disposal will be as under:—
 - Original—retained at Ottawa for historical purposes.
 - Duplicate—to British Record Office for historical purposes.
 - TriPLICATE—to unit for custody with unit records.
5. The War Diary will be entered up daily on MF M11 and rendered monthly in triplicate (Mdn Instr for CM 1937. App "C"). Each entry will be initialled by the officer detailed to keep the War Diary, which will be signed at the end of each month by the commander. (FSR Vol II, Sec 35, para 3 iii).

6. The following should be recorded daily as events occur:—
 - (i) Important orders, instructions, reports, messages or despatches received and issued, and decisions taken. *Original documents* should be attached as appendices to the original copy of the War Diary; *copies* should, whenever available, be attached as appendices to the duplicate and triplicate copies of the War Diary.
 - (ii) Daily map location, employment, movements and dispositions of unit headquarters and of batteries, companies, etc. March tables should be attached as appendices.
 - (iii) Important movements of officers and matters relating to the duties of each branch of the staff. A complete set of the *routine orders and instructions*, *Part I Orders*, issued by the unit during the month should be attached as an appendix to the original copy.
 - (iv) Detailed account of operations—to include:— Exact hour, location and circumstances of important occurrences. Movements and names of neighbouring units. Commanders of batteries, companies, etc, names of Officers and number of OR (i) engaged and (ii) battle casualties. Dispositions, activities and identity of enemy forces. Prisoners and trophies captured. Ammunition expended. Factors affecting operations, topographical and climatic. *Maps and sketches* showing dispositions of batteries, companies, etc, at important phases. The record of *communications*, both written and verbal, received or despatched during active operations as an appendix. A complete set of the *operation orders and instructions* issued during the month. Notes on conferences and *reports* rendered to higher formations, or received from lower formations, as appendices to the original copy.
 - (v) Nature and description of trenches, field works or accommodation occupied or constructed. Meteorological notes.

(vi) Changes in establishment or strength. Names and ranks of officers and number of OR. Attachment of units and individuals. Reinforcements. *Weekly Field Returns of Officers and OR* should be attached as appendices to the original copy. *Copy of Part II Orders* should be attached to the triplicate copy only. Changes in organization, stores, transport, etc.

7. It is essential that all copies of both text and appendices are legible. Appendices will be numbered and referenced to the text in the last column of the form. Current issues of any regimental publication should be attached.

8. It will be found convenient at the end of each month, when the War Diary is being completed and the correspondence in unit files for the month is being reviewed and distributed (FSR Vol I, sec 171, para 3) if the material considered to be of historical value in the light of the above is attached as appendices to the original copy of the War Diary, the file title and reference number being entered in conformity with the filing system.

9. A good war diary makes possible the accurate and detailed reconstruction of circumstances, conditions and action.

NOTE: If monthly diary is more than one inch thick, use a second folder. If appendices are bulky, tie folder up with tape or string to make a firm package.

UNIT OFFICE FILING SYSTEM
AND RECORDS

"Every office will arrange for the filing and custody of its own correspondence." (FSR Vol I, Sec 171.3.)

1. *Titles and Numbering of Files*

A simple filing system adaptable for use in any military office at home or in the field is illustrated by the "List of File Titles" overleaf.

All documents handled by a unit fall into one or other of the nine categories enumerated, 1 to 9. The titles of the nine main divisions are based on British army operations, organization, administration and the regulations governing. Each title may be broken down into ten component parts or sub-titles, by adding a dash and subsidiary numbers 0 to 9. In turn each of these may be further broken down by adding a second dash and a third digit, and if necessary a third dash and a fourth digit. Thus 4-6-3 might be "Cooking Course at Kingston". According to circumstances, a fighting unit would expand the 1-3 prefix to accommodate all arms and services with which it may be concerned.

2. *Date reference*

The method outlined in FSR, Vol II, Appendix IV, will be used for all purposes, e.g., 2 Feb 40.

3. *Documents for Preservation*

The monthly review of correspondence (FSR Vol I, sec 171.3) is facilitated and future confusion avoided by jacketing the material in "Category ii" (i.e., "no longer required", etc) to conform with the system.

4. *Correspondence in the Field*

The functioning of the office of a formation or unit during active operations may be simplified by keeping a log or register of all orders and messages, written or verbal, received or sent during the action. This may conveniently be done by extending the use of the "Field Register of Communications Received or Despatched", (Army Form 2040, FSR Vol I, sec 171) to include verbal as well as written orders and messages in chronological order as received or sent.

Time of sending and of receipt are of importance second only to time of event, and should be entered both on the office copy of every field message or other document, and in the log or register. A carbon copy for contemporary reference of the commander or others concerned is desirable.

A brief precis of written orders, reports and messages, with the sender's number, is sufficient, for they will be kept on file. But particular care is necessary in making entries of times of moves and of verbal orders, reports or conversations, by telephone or otherwise, which in the stress of action, may not otherwise be recorded on paper. In battle, operations messages dealt with by one officer may number over twenty-five per hour for several hours on end.

The record should be kept convenient to the telephone. Entries may be made by a clerk, or by the officer on duty at the telephone.

Such a record is invaluable to the commander in making appreciations of the situation during the action, and in compiling his report on the action afterwards. It is contemporary evidence of the highest quality, and therefore is of the highest historical value, and should be attached as an appendix to the original copy of the War Diary, together with the original documents sent and received.

2. POLICY DISCIPLINECHARGES OF AWL & SPEEDING

1. The maintenance of a high standard of discipline in the CAOF, particularly in respect to the offences of absence without leave and exceeding the authorized speed limit, demands that all commanding offrs be fully aware of the gravity of these offences, and that such offences receive punishments which will effectively deter the commission of a second offence or the commission of a first offence by a new offender.

2. The punishment which is awarded to a soldier is entirely a matter for the discretion of the commanding offr concerned. While each individual case must be considered by commanding offrs on its merits, and it is not possible to lay down a firm standard scale of punishment, the scale set out below is not considered excessive and will indicate to commanding offrs the grave view that is taken of the offences named.

ABSENCE WITHOUT LEAVE

1st Offence: 14 day PP and 14 days, Forfeiture of Pay.

2nd Offence: 28 days PP and 28 days, Forfeiture of Pay.

3rd Offence: Remand for FGCN

SPEEDING

1st Offence: 4 days Forfeiture of Pay.

2nd Offence: 14 days PP and 14 days Forfeiture of pay.
Offender to be grounded for six months.

3. FRATERIALIZATION WITH GERMANS

1. Allied control council has decided that the time has come to abolish all separate zonal orders on the subject of non fraternization with the German people and to adopt a universal policy which will ensure uniform treatment of Germany.

2. All present orders about non fraternization now cancelled.

2. LEAVE POLICY

1. The leave policy for units of the Canadian Army Occupation Force is as follows:

- a) Each offr and OR is to receive one Privilege Leave for every four-month period. Privilege leave facilities for the CAOF are available in the UK, in paris Brussels and Amsterdam. As a result of a "gallup poll" the total leave requirements for the force have been divided as follows:
 - b) 30 days Rotation Leave to Canada for CAOF volunteers. The exact terms and conditions of this Rotation Leave and the date of commencement have not yet been finalized. It will be appreciated that Rotation Leave is dependent upon shipping availability. It is, however, hoped that Rotation Leave will start this Autumn or early Winter.
 - c) No further organized Short Leave for CAOF personnel on the Continent. Privilege Leave to Paris, Brussels or Amsterdam is for 9 days, exclusive of travelling time, and Privilege Leave to the UK is at present 12 days, exclusive of travelling time. It will be noted therefore, that the offr or soldier will receive a minimum of 27 days Privilege Leave per year (if all his leave is taken at Continental centres) or a maximum of 36 days Privilege Leave per year (if all his leave is taken in the UK). In either case, the total time spent on leave compares most favourably with the 14 day annual furlough granted to the regular soldier in peace time in Canada, or with the average civilian's annual vacation, which is generally of two weeks duration.

2. The decision to cease organized Short Leave on the Continent was taken as the travelling time involved was out of proportion to the duration of the leave, and units were finding it impossible to utilize all Privilege Leave and Short Leave vacancies without having too high a percentage of personnel away at any one time. Another factor was the necessity to take into account

2. LEAVE POLICY (Cont'd)

2. (contd) personnel who will be constantly away from the force when Rotation Leave commences.

3. Under the present Privilege Leave arrangements, taking into account time spent in travelling, approx 12% of the force is away at any one time. When Rotation Leave to Canada is in operation on the scale which it is desired to reach, the total personnel away from the force at any one time, including both Privilege and Rotation Leave, will be approx 17%. The addition to this total of personnel absent from units on organized Short Leave would bring the grand total of personnel absent from the force at any one time to an unacceptable high percentage in view of occupational and training commitments.

4. While the organized Short Leaves on the Continent have ceased, it is permissible for COs, within their discretion, to permit personnel to proceed on 48 or 72 hr leave (incl travelling time) to specific destinations, excl Amsterdam, in the Netherlands. Such leaves may be granted in compassionate cases or where, for any other reasons, the CO deems it advisable to grant a short leave. Such leaves must be kept to a minimum.

5. The allocation of Privilege Leave vacancies to firms/units is made in sufficient quantity to allow each unit to despatch all its personnel on Privilege Leave once in every four month period. In any case where a unit has received insufficient vacancies to permit this program to be carried out, applications should be made through the usual channels for further vacancies. Whenever a unit has received an allocation of vacancies which it cannot fill without despatching personnel on Privilege Leave at more frequent intervals than once every four months, an appropriate number of vacancies will be surrendered.

2. Stern disciplinary action will be taken against the driver of any veh exceeding the above speed limits.

3. The above speed limits are applicable to all MD/CM vehicles, including requisitioned and captured vehicles, proceeding individually, but do not apply to vehicles travelling in convoy for which speeds have been laid down in operational or other instructions. Compliance with the above maximum speed limits will not absolve any driver from his obligation to drive with due care and regard for safety, having regard to the prevailing conditions.

4. Occasions of operational necessity may justify speeds in excess of the above scale. Such occasions should whenever possible be covered by the written authority of a responsible officer.

5. This Order in no way restricts the authority of local comds to impose speed limits within built-up areas or upon other roads within the areas under their control which they consider require special restriction. Only under exceptional circumstances should such restriction impose a limit of less than 30 mph which will be the general limitation in all towns, villages and built-up areas. Local comds will ensure that notices of such speed limits are prominently displayed.

6. Officers, warrant officers, and NCOs travelling in vehicles as passengers will ensure that drivers comply with the provisions of this Order.

7. Where the provisions of this Order conflict with MT Drivers' Regulations and Overseas RO 3511 as amended, the provisions of this Order will prevail.

Bi-monthly Mil Security Report
for the period ended 3 Oct 45.

a) General Security:

1. The standard of General Security is rated as fair.
2. The mixing of Mil pers with civs has brought about a relaxation of security mindedness among the tps. On the whole, they fail to grasp the importance of withholding certain infm from the general public. They are however, periodically reminded of their duties in that connection.
3. Investigations of various types are carried out, as the necessity arises, by the USO. The team he controls is doing a very fine job and invaluable results have been obtained.

b) Security of Infm:

As described above, only fair.

c) Security of Material:

Presents no problem.

d) Security of Access:

This remains the same. Systematical check-ups are made in all veh entering or leaving the village in which the Bn is quartered.

e) Security of Personnel:

No acts of violence, no threats against our tps.

f) Miscellaneous:

Although the Polish DPs live outside of the area for which we are responsible, we have had to deal with emergency calls from German civs in the neighborhood, who were being attacked by them.

Very strict control is maintained over the civs, and all cases of suspicion are thoroughly investigated.
