Christ Church Cathedral-The congregation of this church was organized about 1835, and a church was erected in 1837 on the site of the present edifice The very Rev J G Geddes, Dean of Niagara, was in charge of this parish for 44 years, leaving it at the close of 1879 for an appointmet to Tatsfield Rectory in England. After a vacancy of a few months, during which the Rev Canon Givins, of Toronto, (who has since died), took tem porary charge of the parish; the Rev Charles H Mockridge, B D, assistant minister of St George's church, Toronto, was a pointed Rector. The Cathedral is one of the chief ornaments of the city, and is looked upon as one of the most popular churches; the evening congregations, as a rule, being very large. It is noted for its excellent organ and choir, the latter consisting of boys and men in surplices. Divine service on Sundays at 11 a.m. and 7 p.m., and on Wednesday evenings at 7:30 p.m. Sunday School at 3 p.m. Baptism second Sunday in every month at 2:30 p.m. Holy communion every Sunday; first and third Sundays at the 11 o'clock service, and second, fourth and fifth, (when occurring), at 8 a.m.
