## TOWNSHIP OF FLAMBORO' EAST.

The township of Flamboro' East is bounded on the north-east by the Townships of Nasagaweya and Nelson, county of Halton, on the south by Burlington Bay, on the south-west by the township of Flamboro' West, and on the north-west by the township of Puslinch, county Wellington. The township was first settled about the year 1799 by George Chisholm, David Henry, John Fonger, and William and John Applegarth. From Hamilton to Waterdown, the chief town of the township, there are three or four roads, which vary in distance from seven to nine miles. By any one of these it is necessary to cross the marsh, (the continuation or scrag end of Burlington Bay,) and also to ascend the table land on the opposite side. A narrow ridge of very high land divides the Bay from the marsh. One portion of the ridge, fronting the warsh has a very singular appearance; being clear of timber for some distance from the top, and covered with a short turf, and sloping down almost perpendicularly for at least a hundred and fifty feet, it resembles a "ha-ha," or sunken fence on a gigantic scale. The usual, or most travelled road to Waterdown is to keep the gravel road on the right hand or Burlington side of the ridge, and cross the marsh, over which there is a good bridge, then follow the Wellington Square road till you are about five miles from Hamilton when a good road turns off to the left at Aldershot or Waterdown station, which runs nearly straight to the village. Should the traveller make a mistake, and turn to the left a quarter of a mile too soon, he will get on a road which will lead him to Waterdown, but by a very circuitous and hilly path. There is another road, rather shorter, gained by following the road on the marsh side of the ridge previously spoken of, instead of the Burlington Bay side, and crossing the marsh over a different bridge. But although a most magnificent view may be obtained from one particular spot on the way, it is doubtful if the

pleasure of the prospect is not more than balanced by the hilly and rocky character of a portion of the road.

Waterdown\* which is situated on the mountain, and on Dundas street, is a pleasant looking village, containing about 768 inhabitants, and is situated by a bustling little mill stream called Grind Stone creek, a very significant name, and finds its source in the rear of the township.

The village of Carlisle, which is about five miles back from Waterdown, contains about one hundred and fifty inhabitants, and is watered by Twelve mile creek.

The south-eastern portion of the township is hilly, but the rear is level or rolling. The soil is generally good, and the timber a mixture of hardwood and pine. It is well settled and contains excellent farms. There are two other villages in the township, but want of space prevents us from giving any more than a passing notice of them—they are Progreston and Aldershott. ## TOWNSHIP OF FLAMBORO' WEST.

The township of Flamboro' West is bounded on the north-east by the township of Flamboro' East, on the south by the township of Ancaster, on the west by the township of Beverly. It is triangular in shape, and the surface of the country varies, being composed of hill and dale; the soil is chiefly loam and is well watered with numerous small streams. A beautiful and rapid stream flows or rather dashes through the valley called Mordens' Creek, and known at the village of West Flamboro' as "Flamboro' Stream," and at Dundas as "Dundas Stream." Soon after leaving the village of West Flamboro' you begin gradually to descend the mountain, getting occasionally a fine view over the surrounding country. The road is circuitous, but well

made. Before descending into the town of Dundas, you see towering above you on the left an enormous cutting and embankment, made by the Great Western Railway, and immediately in front of it the Flamboro' Stream, now become the Dundas stream, having supplied the Gore flour and paper mills. Some idea may be had of the value of this stream for manufacturing purposes when it is stated that at these mills water to the extent of one hundred horse power is obtained. At a short distance from this point it crosses the road and rushes down into the valley below, hurrying on to add to the prosperity of Dundas.

Dundas is three miles and a half from the village of West Flamboro' and five from Hamilton, and is situated on a rising ground at the foot of the mountain. It has long been noted as a manufacturing place, and has almost unlimited water power. In its vicinity there is a large supply of free-stone and limestone, and many of its principal buildings are constructed of the stone obtained at these quarries.

The first settlements in the township were made in 1794, when wild land might be bought for about one shilling per acre. In 1817 the township contained three hundred and sixty inhabitants, one grist, six saw mills, and one fulling mill. In 1841 the population had increased to two thousand four hundred and twenty-eight, and in 1850 to two thousand nine hundred and fifty-five. It produced from the crops of 1849, fifty-three thousand bushels of wheat, twenty-seven thousand bushels of oats, twenty-one thousand bushels of potatoes, twenty-two thousand bushels of turnips, seven thousand pounds of wool, and twelve thousand pounds of butter. Below will be found an abstract of the census for 1861.

## TOWNSHIP OF SALTFLEET.

The township of Saltfleet is bounded on the north-east by Lake Ontario, on the south-east by the township of Grimsby, County of Lincoln, on the south-west by the township of Grimsby and Binbrook, and on the north-west by the township of Barton. The first settlement was made in 1787, and in 1817 it contained seven hundred inhabitants. The township is thickly studded with fine farms under a high state of cultivation, and lies partly below and partly on the mountain. The soil is rich, and the timber a mixture of pine and hardwood. The following post offices are in the township: Ontario, Stoney Creek, Tapleystown, and Tweedside. The crop of 1849 produced fifty thousand bushels of wheat, thirty-seven thousand bushels of oats, twenty-six thousand bushels of Indian corn, sixteen thousand pounds of wool, and twenty-one thousand pounds of butter. 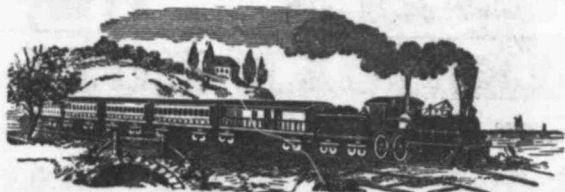

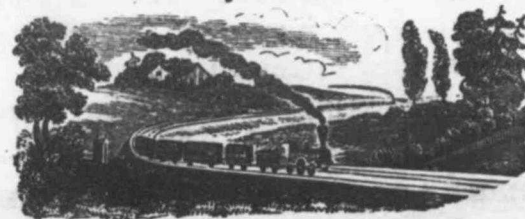
