FOR 1866-7.

THIS COUNTY lies north of latitude 42, and is the most westerly as well as the most southerly in Canada. It is bounded as follows, namely: on the north by Lake St. Clair, on the west by the River Detroit, on the south by Lake Erie, and on the east by Lake Erie and the County of Kent, which two Counties, united with Lambton formed what was formerly called the Western District, comprising in all thirty townships, and containing 1,617,500 acres of land, of which quantity 1,389,560 acres have been granted or appropriated; 87,500 acres of these were Indian Lands.

At the sitting of the First Provincial Parliament, in the year 1792, this District was first called the Western District, and contained at that time only sixteen Townships. The settlers of the most remote Townships in the District, in consequence of the inconveniences to which they were subjected, by being such a distance from the District Town where they necessarily had to transact their business, began to be dissatisfied, and entered complaints from time to time. Finally, measures were taken to remedy this grievance by dividing the District into two, and erecting Chatham into the District Town of the new District, for which purpose an act was passed on the 9th of July, 1847. In 1849 an additional act was passed for abolishing the territorial divisions of Upper Canada Districts, and for providing for temporary unions of Counties for judicial and other purposes, shortly after which Essex became a County. The first Warden of the Western District was Jacob Dolson, of Chatham; The first Judges were Alex. Chewitt and Chas. Elliott, Esqs. Mr. Chewitt was Judge for the three Counties. Gordon W. Leggatt, Esq., is the present Judge of the County of Essex. The first Sheriff was W. Hands, Esq., E. Reynolds the next. In 1802 Mr. Hands filled the offices of Sheriff, Registrar, Collector of Customs, Registrar Surrogate Court, in fact, he held all the County offices at that time with the exception of Clerk of the Peace.

John McEwan, Esq., was appointed Sheriff in 1846 and still holds that position. The Registry Office for the Western District was at one time kept in Detroit, by a

man named Monforton—John A. Askin is the present Registrar. J. B. Baby, Esq., was first County Treasurer—Thos. Henry Wright holds the office at present.

Wm. Cowan was the first District Clerk. Thos. McKee, Esq., the present County Clerk, was appointed in 1865.

The first Court house was situated in rear of the present, built of log; it was replaced by a brick building, which has lately been used as barracks by the volunteers stationed at Sandwich. The present Court house, a very substantial stone structure, was erected in the year 1855, at a cost of \$32,000. In it are the offices of the Sheriff, Treasurer, County Clerk, Clerk of the Peace and County Attorney. The Division Court as also the County Courts are held here.

This section of the Province has long been settled. The Township of Sandwich, on the western border of the county, began to be settled as early as the year 1750, by disbanded soldiers from the French army. The land was laid out in arpents, instead of acres, according to the French mode of measuring, 180 arpents being equivalent to 200 acres.

SOIL.—In the southern portion of the County the soil is a sandy loam, with the exception of Malden and Anderdon, which is a heavy clay; although, for a short distance on the Lake Erie shore, in some parts it is quite sandy. In the northern range the soil is a heavy clay. Many sections in the County are admirably adapted for the growth of tobacco.

TIMBER.—The principal kinds of wood are white and red oak, hickory, beech, maple, white and black ash, basswood and elm.

The principal products are fall wheat, spring wheat, oats, barley, rye, corn, (the latter grows in great abundance), peas, tobacco, and fruits of every description.

PRINCIPAL ROADS.—Talbot road, gravelled from Windsor to Ouellett's corners, a distance of six miles, built by a joint stock Company in the year 1862, S. S. McDonald, president. There is about ten miles of it planked and gravelled. It enters the County of Kent, in the Township of Romney.

Middle road commences at Maidstone, passes through a small village and P. O. station, running parallel to the Railway station, entering the County of Kent at Trudell P. O., in West Tilbury, a distance of twenty-eight miles from the cross.

The Malden road, running obliquely in a north-easterly direction, following nearly the banks of the River Canard. The Board of Works road, built in 1842, runs from Maidstone to Amherstburg.

River road, running from Windsor to Amherstburg, a distance of eighteen miles, is gravelled from Windsor to Sandwich, a distance of two miles.

Lake shore road, running from Amherstburg to Leamington, in the Township of Mersea, intersecting the Talbot road at Leamington, passes through Malden Township, Colchester, Gosfield, and part of Mersea, a distance of thirty-three miles, terminating at Wigle's hotel.

Tecumseh road, running along Lake St. Clair into the County of Kent, at Baptiste Creek, a distance of thirty-one miles from Windsor.

STREAMS.—River Canard, rising partly in Sandwich Township and partly in Andedron, dividing the south-western portion of the County; it enters the River Detroit, opposite 22nd Lot, Con. 1st of Anderdon, a distance of ten miles from Sandwich.

Cedar Creek takes its source in the Townships of Colchester and Gosfield, entering Lake Erie at Lot 42, Con. 1st, Township of Gosfield.

Sturgeon Creek, in the Township of Mersea, entering Lake Erie at Lot 11, Con. B, said Township.

Turkey Creek, in the Township of Sandwich, empties into the Detroit River at Lot 35, Con. 1st.

Baptiste Creek, which forms the boundary line between Essex and the County of Kent, empties itself into the River Thames, in the north-eastern part of the Township of Tilbury West.

The Ruscom rises near the boundary line between Gosfield and Rochester, draining the eastern portion of the Township. Ruscom empties into Lake St. Clair at Lot A, 7th Concession, about four miles above Belle River.

Belle River, forming the boundary line between Maidstone and Rochester, takes its rise in Gosfield, empties between the 1st Concessions in each of the forementioned Townships into Lake Erie.

River Aux Puces has its rise in the Township of Maidstone, near the 5th and 6th Concessions; empties into Lake St. Clair, between Concessions 8 and 9.

River Aux Peches rises in the Township of Sandwich east, crosses between the 8th and 9th Concessions of Maidstone, empties into Lake St. Clair at the north-west corner of Maidstone.

Little River drains the eastern portion of Sandwich east, empties into Lake St. Clair about six miles from Windsor.

ISLANDS.—The principal islands belonging to Canada are Fighting, Turkey and Bois Blanc. The former, opposite Sandwich west, contains several fisheries. The fishing season commences about the 1st of October.

Bois Blanc Island, opposite Amherstburg, consists of about 200 acres. A lighthouse was erected on the southern point about the year 1836; Captain James Hackett is the attendant.

HISTORICAL, STATISTICAL AND GENERAL INFORMATION OF TOWNSHIPS.

ANDERDON.—This Township consists of a block of land formerly owned by the following Indian tribes, viz: Hurons and Wyandottes, and disposed of by them in 1837. It fronts on the Detroit River for a distance of seven miles. About one-third of the Township has been reserved by the Indians for their own use—a stone quarry, consisting of 160 acres; these quarries are leased to private individuals, and large quantities of lime are exported. The soil is clay, with heavy black loam, well adapted for pasturage, vegetables, and all kinds of grain and fruits. The River Canard runs through the Township, and enters the Detroit River about midway between its northern and southern boundaries. It is one of the most fertile sections in the County, and the only apparent draw-back, as in other sections of the Province where the red man of the forest still holds possession, is the lack of good roads and general improvements in that portion held by them. The population is mixed, consisting of English, Irish, Scotch and French. The Concessions number from the River east, eight in all. Lots number from south to north. Mr. Forbes was one of the first settlers, having come here in 1837. In 1846 it contained a population of 608, and the rateable property at that time amounted to \$15,000.

Total population in 1861, 1,505. Natives of England and Wales, 40; Scotland, 9; Ireland, 131; of Canada, not of French origin, 638; of French origin, 285; United States, 377; colored persons, 551; of different other countries, 25. Anderdon is bounded on the north by Sandwich, on the west by River Detroit, on the south by Malden, and on the east by the Township of Colchester.

COLCHESTER.—This Township is situated on Lake Erie, and is bounded on the north by the Townships of Maidstone and Sandwich, on the west by Anderdon and Malden, on the south by Lake Erie, and on the east by Gosfield. The first survey of it was made for the purpose of being granted to "Butler's Rangers," and to the U. E. Loyalists. Its settlement dates back as far as the year 1797. Many of the original grantees never effected a settlement, and others sold out soon after moving to their lands. John Cornwall, one of the U. E. Loyalists, was the first representative of the County in the Provincial Parliament. The greater portion of the front part of the Township was purchased and settled between the years 1797 and 1800. The soil on the lake shore is a sandy and clayey loam. The banks of the lake are in some parts from sixty to eighty feet above the level of the water. In the Township are three extensive marshes, which are covered with water in the spring but are dry during the summer, and yield large quantities of hay. The largest of these marshes (Roache's) lies between the 5th and 6th Concessions, and is drained on the west by the River Canard, and on the east by Cedar Creek. On its west is a large ditch, which renders it fit for cultivation; and the Township Council wisely purpose draining the eastern portion, by which it will also be reclaimed.

The Concessions, fourteen in all, are numbered from Lake Erie north. There are twenty-one Lots, numbering from west to east, with the exception of the first Concession, which numbers from east to west.

Part of the Township is well timbered with maple, beech, elm, oak, black walnut, &c. In 1844 it contained a population of 1,400, which in 1861 increased to 2,656. Of these there were 61 natives of England and Wales; natives of Scotland, 64; of Ireland, 50; of Canada, not of French origin, 1,459; of French origin, 103; natives of the United States, 894; colored persons, 728; of other countries, 24.

GOSFIELD.—This Township is bounded on the north by the Townships of Rochester and Maidstone, on the west by Colchester, on the south by Lake Erie, and on the east by Mersea. It borders on Lake Erie for about ten miles, and commenced to be settled towards the Lake about the same time as Colchester, the adjoining Township, which, in point of soil, it very much resembles: about half the land is wet and requires draining. The Lots number from Hughson's Creek, about the centre of the lake shore boundary, at what is called the Division Road, to the west side of the Township of Colchester—ninety-seven Lots in all; thirty-two of which are in Gosfield. The first settlers here were, also, "Butler's Rangers." The Township is watered by Hughson's Creek, Belle River, Ruscom River and Cedar Creek. It is wooded by white oak, ash, elm, beech, maple, walnut and basswood. There is a large marsh in the western section of the Township, in front of the Talbot road, which could be converted into productive soil by proper drainage.

There are eleven Concessions in the Township, which number northwards from the Lake. In 1844 it contained a population of 1,338. The population in 1861 numbered 2,355—natives of England and Wales, 155; of Scotland, 15; of Ireland,

28; natives of Canada, not of French origin, 1,930; of French origin, 18; United States, 187; colored people, 87.

MAIDSTONE.—This Township borders on Lake St. Clair for a distance of ten miles. It is bounded on the east by the Township of Sandwich, on the west by Belle River, and on the south by the Townships of Colchester and Gosfield. The River Aux Puces runs through its centre. The soil is a heavy clay, and the whole of the land in the Township is fit for cultivation. It is timbered by maple, elm, beech, oak, &c. Concessions run from east to west, nine in number. From twenty-four to twenty-nine Lots south of Middle road, eleven to nineteen north of Middle road, on the Middle road from one to twenty-one, on Belle River from Lots A & I to 20, on the River Aux Puces, from one to seven, on River Aux Peches, from I to 10. The Township, on the rivers and the lake was settled by French principally. The population in 1844 numbered 783, and had increased in 1861 to 1,652; of these 92 were natives of England and Wales; natives of Scotland, 82; of Ireland, 221; of Canada, not of French origin, 710; of French origin, 295; United States, 220; colored people, 375.

MALDEN.—This Township is situated partly on the Detroit River, that is the western part, and the southern part on Lake Erie. It was laid out in 1797 by Thomas Smith, P. L. S. The portion of the Township bordering on Lake Erie is rather marshy; the rest of the Township is dry, and consists of a clayey loam, drained by Caldwell's Creek, also Bondy's Creek, both of which are branches of the River Canard. It is timbered by white oak, walnut, hickory, beech, maple, ash, &c. The first settlers were Cols. Elliott and Caldwell. This Township is well settled, and contains some of the finest farming lands in the County. Population, in 1845, 1,934.

MERSEA.—Is bounded on the north by the Township of Tilbury West; on the west by Gosfield; on the South by Lake Erie, and on the east by Romney. An extensive triangular shaped point of land, embracing about one-third of the Township, called "Point au Pele, or South Foreland," runs out into the Lake for about eight miles. The Township is watered by Sturgeon Creek on the west side of the Point, and Muddy Creek on the east side, and north by a branch of Baptiste Creek. It was first settled in the year 1801 by Edward Hazle, Thomas Bell, Charles Usher, Theodore Malott, — Wilkinson and William Fleming. The soil in the south-west corner is sandy, the balance is a clayey loam. Concessions number from the Lake northwards. Lots number from west to east—numbering from one to twenty-four. Total population, in 1861, 2,143. Natives of England and Wales, 253; Scotland, 23; Ireland, 108; Canada, not of French origin, 1,638; of French origin, 18; United States, 87; France, 19; New Brunswick, 8.

SANDWICH EAST.—Is situated on Lake St. Clair and Detroit River, and was settled about the same time as Sandwich West (1750); and a new settlement made by Col. Talbot about the year 1827, on what is called Talbot street. The shrewdness of Col. Talbot is evident from the fact that the whole tract of his land was situated in the most elevated portion of the County, which appears to have been also the case in the other Counties in which he owned lands, viz: Kent, Elgin and Norfolk. The soil in this Township is a sandy loam, drained by Turkey Creek on the west, on the north and east by Little River. The eastern portion of the Township is principally settled by English, Irish and Scotch. In 1861 Sandwich East contained a

population of 3,133—natives of England and Wales, 72; Scotland, 57, Ireland, 287; of Canada, not of French origin, 761; of French origin, 1,400; United States, 507; France, 19; colored persons, 455.

SANDWICH WEST.—This Township is almost entirely settled and occupied, with the exception of a few hundred acres. The soil is principally a black sandy loam on the river side, which is well adapted for almost all kinds of produce. The eastern part is a clay loam, drained by the River Canard and Turkey Creek. A great quantity of the produce formerly went to the Detroit market. The Township has a gradual elevation from the river; it has a frontage of eleven miles on the Detroit River. It contained a population of 1,816 in 1861. Natives of England and Wales, 116; of Scotland, 24; Ireland, 43; of Canada, not of French origin, 1,425; of French origin, 45; United States, 138; colored persons, 50.

ROCHESTER.—This Township is situated on Lake St. Clair, and is watered by the River Ruscom on the east; Belle River and Duck Creek on the west. Soil, a heavy clayey loam. The land is flat towards the Lake, but rises gradually as you go back. This Township is timbered by white ash, elm, oak, hickory, beech, maple and basswood. Concessions run from west to east. Rochester was first settled by French. It is bounded on the north by Lake St. Clair; on the west by Belle River; on the south by Gosfield, and on the east by Tilbury West. In 1861 the population numbered 1,349. Natives of England and Wales, 52; Scotland, 6; Ireland, 143; Canada, not of French origin, 506; of French origin, 528; United States, 41.

TILBURY WEST—Extends along the Lake for nine miles. It runs gradually to the height of about forty feet above the level of the Lake, and is watered by Baptiste and Silver Creeks; soil, a heavy clayey loam, and is timbered by white oak, elm, ash, hickory, beech and maple. The first settlers were principally French. Concessions number from Lake St. Clair south: eleven in number. Lots number from west to east. Population, in 1844, 437; in 1861 the population numbered 1,190. Natives of England and Wales, 78; Scotland, 45; Ireland, 47; Canada, not of French origin, 580; of French origin, 390; United States, 34.

EDUCATIONAL.

In the very important matter of education, great progress has been effected in the County of Essex, and it has now the advantages of a liberal and permanent provision for the general and thorough education of its rising population, fully enjoying the privileges and benefits conferred by the excellent School Act for Upper Canada (13th and 14th Vic., cap. 48, 1850). The reports of the Local Superintendents of Schools for the County, in general indicate a growing interest in the subject of education, and a steady progress in the different Sections and Townships that is highly satisfactory. Each Township is divided into School Sections of a suitable extent for one School; and in each of these Sections three Trustees are elected to manage its School affairs. Each School and Municipal Corporation desirous of establishing Free Public Libraries, is aided by the Educational Department granting 100 per cent. on local appropriations, and supplying books from the Depository in connection with the Department.

There is a good grammar school in Windsor, managed by a Board of Trustees composed of the following gentlemen: James Dougall, Francis Caron, and Donald Cameron, Esquires.

The following are the number of common schools in the several municipalities: Sandwich East, 8; West, 7; Gosfield, 10; (one colored school) Mersea, 6; Maidstone, 6; Malden, 5; Anderdon, 5; Colchester, 14; Tilbury West, 5; Rochester, 4; Windsor, 5; Sandwich, 5; Amherstburg, 5; making a total of 94 schools in the County. In addition to which there are a number of private schools.

The Local Superintendents for the different municipalities are as follows: Colchester, James Bell; Gosfield, James King; Mersea, Jonathan Wigfield; Anderdon, Rev. F. Mack; Walden, Geo. Gott; Rochester, Joseph Mathers; Maidstone, Wm. Lindsay; Sandwich East, Dennis Downing; Sandwich West, Dr. F. Dupuis; Tilbury West, Alexander Craig.

Receipts and Expenditures of Common School Moneys for the year 1862.

RECEIPTS.—The amount paid and appropriated, by the Department of Public Instruction, from the Legislative grant, for salaries of Teachers, was, in the County, \$2,222.50; in the Town of Windsor, \$287; Amherstburg, \$295; Sandwich, \$113.

The amount apportioned and paid for the purchase of maps, apparatus, prizes and libraries, being in proportion and equal to the amount expended from local sources was, for the County, \$16; for the Town of Windsor, \$32; Amherstburg, \$20.

The law requires that each municipality shall provide a sum by assessment, at least equal to the Legislative grant, but each municipality can provide as large an additional sum as it may think proper for school purposes. The amount provided by municipal assessment was, for the County, \$2,234.31; for the Town of Windsor, \$2,500.00; Amherstburg, \$2,215.54; Sandwich, \$113.00.

As the council in the municipality, so the trustees in a school section, have authority to provide money for the support of their school or schools, by assessment, and also by fees on pupils, unless the rate-payers decide in favor of a free school. The amount of assessment levied by trustees, in addition to the levy by the municipal councils, was, for the County, \$11,565.10; for the Town of Amherstburg, \$400.00.

Rate-bills on pupils are only imposed where the schools are not free. The amount of rate-bills imposed was \$216.75 for the County, and \$75.00 for Amherstburg.

The amount received by trustees from the Clergy Reserve Fund and other sources, and appropriated for the County, was \$221.73; for the Town of Amherstburg, \$108.05.

The amount available from the balance of 1861 was, for the County, \$2,857.35; for the Town of Sandwich, \$126.75; Amherstburg, \$1,033.03.

The total receipts for common school purposes for the year 1861, in the County were \$19,333.73; Windsor, \$3,091.92; Sandwich, \$759.14; Amherstburg, \$640.47.

EXPENDITURE.—The amount paid for the salaries of teachers was, in the County, \$12,056.65; in Windsor, \$2,281.00; Sandwich, \$640.47; Amherstburg, \$1,452.21.

The amount expended in the purchase of maps, apparatus, prize books and libraries was, for the County, \$86.39; Town of Windsor, \$80; Amherstburg, \$104.79.

The amount expended for school books, stationery, fuel and other expenses was, for the County, \$1,100.58; Windsor, \$243.41; Amherstburg, \$211.62.

The amount expended for the purchase of school sites and the erection of school houses was, for the County, \$1,602.94; for Windsor, ———; for Amherstburg, \$2,064.57.

The amount paid for rents and repairs of school houses was, for the County, \$490.31; Windsor, \$339.72; Amherstburg, \$236.76.

Uninspected balances of the preceding year was, for the County, \$3,996.86; for Windsor, \$147.79; Amherstburg, \$79.67. These balances are rather apparent than real, arising from the fact that many of the municipal councils and trustees, do not, until after the close of the civil year, collect the sums necessary to pay the expenses of such year.

The total expenditure in behalf of the Common Schools was, in the County, \$15,338.87; in Windsor, \$2,944.13; Sandwich, \$712.23; Amherstburg, \$4,066.95.

WINDSOR,

The largest and most important town in the County of Essex, is pleasantly situated on the Detroit River, in the Township of Sandwich, opposite Detroit, and is distant from Chatham forty-six miles, and from London 110 miles. The town being built on high bank from thirty to forty feet above the river, renders the situation healthy and desirable as a place of residence, which is a very important consideration to business men and others, and which, no doubt, induced many of the present residents of Windsor to invest their capital there, and make it their home. It was first laid out in the year 1834, since which time it has been steadily increasing in population, wealth and importance, although some seventeen years ago a considerable portion of it was destroyed by fire, which was said to have originated from sparks from a steamboat.

In the early part of the town's history—before public schools were established—education was left to private enterprise entirely. This is the case in every new district of country during the first few years of their settlement, and upon the whole the want was generally tolerably well supplied.

Windsor will ever be associated with the rebellion of 1837, which commenced by an armed invasion of Toronto, headed by William Lyon McKenzie. As a community the residents sided warmly with Sir Francis Bond Head and his advisers, under whose mal-administration the unhappy crisis took place—prudently thinking it was better to defend the Government than incur the evils of a civil war. At that time a band of Americans and rebels, 400 in number, crossed over from Detroit, and burned the steamer Thames and two or three houses. They were charged by a party of militia, eighty in number, who, after firing two shots, completely routed them. Shortly after this the insurrection was suppressed, and the invaders from the opposite shore who sympathised with the Canadian rebels, and had been led to suppose that the people in this Province were waiting to rise *en masse*, fled in haste to their native soil. About that time barracks were erected, which were occupied by several companies of volunteers from different parts of the Province, during the winter and spring of this year.

In 1846 Windsor contained a population of only 300—increased in 1861 to 2,500. There are at present about 4,500 inhabitants in the place, principally composed of native-born Canadians, English, Irish, Scotch and Americans.

Windsor enjoys excellent facilities for manufactures and commerce, being the western terminus of the Great Western Railway, and also having the benefit of navigation during the summer, with excellent roads leading out of the town in every direction. Constant traffic was formerly carried on between here and Detroit, which gave an impetus to business generally, and did much towards the prosperity of the place.

The additional advantages gained by the construction of the Great Western Railway is felt here as well as in every other town and city in Canada through which it passes, and the enterprise of that company is displayed now in the construction of an iron boat, sufficiently large for the transportation of freight cars

across the river, the contractors of which are S. & H. Jenkins. Her dimensions are as follows:—Length over all, 245 feet; breadth of hull, 40 feet; breadth over all, 70 feet; depth of hold, 12 feet four inches. She is to be provided with two low pressure engines, of three hundred horse power each.

The Great Western Railway dock is situated opposite the foot of the first gravel road—it is 700 feet long, and extends into the river to a depth of twenty-eight feet. The basin for the boat is constructed in the shape of a basket, having a shipping table suited to the rise and fall of the boat, which can be raised or lowered eight feet.

The Messrs. Jenkins have also under construction a wooden screw steamer, to be named the Florence, intended for towing pleasure parties and general purposes, on the Detroit River and neighborhood.

There are at present three steam ferries, viz: Detroit, Capt. Chilver; Argo, Capt. Forbes; and the Essex, owned by the Messrs. Jenkins.

Windsor was incorporated as a village in January, 1854, and as a town in the year 1858. S. S. McDonald, Esq., was first reeve, and also first mayor. Mr. Bartlett has held the office of town clerk since 1858. The first store was opened out by James Dougall, about 1830, and Hiram Walker built the first mill in a place called Walkerville, about a mile above Windsor. In 1835, an agency of the Commercial Bank was established here, of which C. D. Grassett is present manager.
