DRESDEN.

Situated on both sides of the Sydenham River, in the Gore of Camden Township, is a thriving incorporated village with a population of nearly 2,000. It was first settled in 1846, the postoffice was established in 1854, and for a town without railway facilities its growth has been something remarkable. Hardwood timber abounds in the vicinity and an immense business is done annually in the export of square and ship timber, cordwood, bent work, hubs, spokes and forest products generally. The soil is highly productive and when cleared off makes first-class farms. During the past few years a considerable quantity of grain has been shipped from here with prospects of a steady increase in this direction. Its manufacturing establishments are an extensive hub and spoke factory and bending works, a large saw-mill, a woolen-mill, two foundries and machine shops, three flouring mills, three planing-mills and sash factories, a tannery, several carriage and wagon shops, besides others of lesser importance. The village has a weekly newspaper, a bank, four hotels, churches of all the leading denominations, and good educational facilities. There is a spacious and handsome brick Town Hall in the Market Square. The business portion of the village is built largely of brick, which gives it quite a business-like appearance. The river, which is here spanned by a substantial swing bridge, is navigable for vessels of 300 tons. During the season of navigation a steamer makes tri-weekly trips to Detroit and another to Sarnia, leaving alternate days. The Erie & Huron Railway, now graded for a considerable distance will, when completed, open up railway communication with the rest of the world, and greatly facilitate trade. Dresden is 11 miles northwest of Thamesville on the G W Ry, and 16 north of Chatham, and has daily communication by stage with both places. The Dominion and Montreal Telegraph Companies have offices here.
