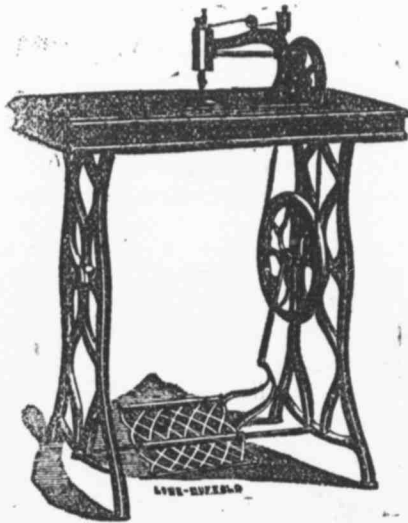

## GUELPH.

The county town of Wellington is beautifully situated on the river Speed, a confluent of the Grand River, it is an important station of the Wellington, Grey and Bruce, and Grand Trunk Railways; distant from Hamilton at the head of Lake Ontario only 30 miles; from Toronto the capital of the Province, 47 miles. Few inland towns possess better facilities than Guelph in a commercial view, and none better for manufacturing purposes. Its business men have every advantage for the shipment of agricultural and industrial products to any part of the Dominion.

IN MANUFACTURES Guelph will compare with any town in the Dominion. Among which, mention may be made of Raymond's Sewing Machine Factory, these extensive works were established in 1861 and are situated on Yarmouth Street, and Yarmouth corner of Woolwich Streets, one building being wood, 106 feet x 96, two stories high with an engine of 15 horse power, the other also of wood, 90 x 30 feet, two stories high with 8 horse power. The works have the capacity of turning out 500 machines a week, one hundred and sixty-five hands are constantly employed. The reputation of the Raymond Machine is well established both in the Dominion and European countries.

The Guelph Sewing Machine Company has been established since 1869. The works are situated on the corner of Nelson Crescent and Paisley Street and are erected of wood, steam power is used to propel the machinery, one hundred and ten hands find constant employment, and the Company turns out about 7,000 first class sewing machines per annum.

Organs and Melodeons.—Messrs. W. Bell & Co., established in 1865 on East Market Square employ about fifty hands in the manufacture of Organs and Melodeons. The factory is a *si*gone building 98 x 106 feet, and three stories high; steam power to the extent of 20 horse is employed and 23 instruments a week are turned out.

Messrs. McLeod, Wood & Co., in the same branch of industry, were established in 1868. The factory is a two story building 100 x 30 feet on Waterloo Street, the action, tuning and ware-rooms on Market Square being 24 x 100 feet three stories high. This firm employs over 30 hands, turning out 10 instruments weekly at an average price of \$125 each, with a constantly increasing business.

**FOUNDRIES AND MACHINE SHOPS**—Messrs. Inglis and Hunter established in 1858, employ fifty hands in the manufacture of steam engines, boilers, water wheels, flour and saw mill machinery, barrel and bag packers, smut, shingle, barrel head and sawing machines, head turners and planers, stave cutters, jointers, &c.; they manufacture the Watson's Patent Improved Ward's Turbine Water Wheel. The works are situated on Perth Street and embrace main building 120 feet long x 32 feet wide, two and three stories high; moulding shop, 60 x 40 feet; blacksmith's shop, 40 x 20 feet, built of stone; and boiler shop, 30 x 80 feet. Steam power is employed to propel the machinery.

Crowe's Foundry, Mr. John Crowe, proprietor, is situated on Norfolk Street and was established in 1867. The buildings are stone, 100 feet x 100. Thirty hands are here employed. Mr. Crowe manufactures every kind of machinery, plow and building castings, iron railings for door yards, and cemeteries in the most modern styles.

Messrs. Harley and Murchey established in 1870, employ twenty hands. The works are on Huskisson Street, built of wood 106 feet x 35. This firm turns out brass and iron castings of a superior description and devote their attention chiefly to fine light castings.

**MILLING AND DISTILLING.**—In this branch Guelph may boast of one of the largest in Canada established in 1827, by David Allan, Esq., on Market Street. The premises are stone, five and a half stories high. Water and steam power are used to the extent of about 40 horse and thirty hands are employed.

The Mills contain 7 run of stone with a capacity of sixty thousand barrels per annum, and the distillery about six thousand barrels of spirits per annum. Between two and three hundred head of cattle and about five hundred hogs are fed.

The People's Flour Mill, James Goldie, Esq., proprietor, contains six run of stone and machinery of the most modern improvements.

**BREWERS.**—The Guelph Brewery, Thomas Holliday, Esq., proprietor, was established in 1840 and is one of the largest in the Dominion. The new part of the brewery is built of stone three stories high, 110 by 45 feet: the old part 70 by 90 feet; capacity, fourteen thousand barrels per annum. Water power is used and 12 hands employed. There is excellent spring water in abundant supply.

Mr. E. Stovel has been engaged in the manufacture of pumps, cradles and the celebrated well or cistern pump "The Stovel." The works are on Arthur Street and were established in 1851.

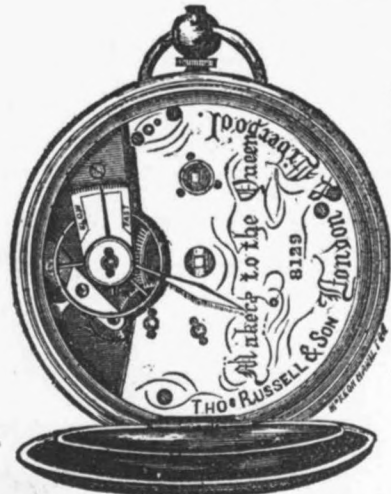

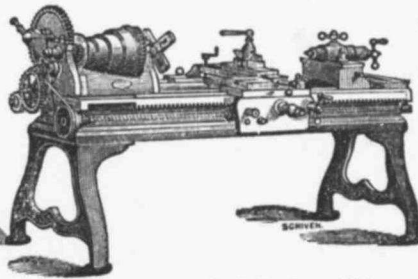
