HINTS

—FOR THE—

CARE AND PRESERVATION OF CARRIAGES.

Carrriages should be kept in an airy, dry, clean Coach House with a moderate amount of light. The windows should be curtained to avoid the sunlight direct upon the paint or trimmings of the carriage. There should be no communication between the stable and coach house; Ammonia fumes crack and destroy varnish, fade colors in trimmings or paint—so will dampness from a brick wall.

A carriage should be covered by a large cotton sheet to keep off the dust, cover should be kept DRY.

Never allow mud to remain on long enough to dry upon a carriage; or mud spots will result.

When washing a carriage keep it out of the sun; use plenty of water; use a large soft sponge first to loosen and flow off all dirt, then wipe off with a clean damp chamois leather, for the wheels use a spoke brush to remove dirt. Never use hot water or soap.

Inspect carriage occasionally, whenever a bolt or clip appears getting loose, tighten. Always have little repairs done at once. Oil axles with Sperm or Castor Oil.
