COUNTY OF WENTWORTH.

### TOWN OF DUNDAS.

An Incorporated Town, in the Township of West Flamboro', and County of Wentworth, situated at the head of the Desjardins canal, and on the line of the Great Western Railway, five miles from Hamilton, 79 from London, 44 from Toronto, and 49 from Suspension Bridge. It has daily mails', with Money Order Office. Dundas is increasing annually in the importance and number of its manufacturing establishments. Many of these are propelled by water power exclusively, while some use water and steam power—especially the larger works. Situated as it is, Dundas must still grow in importance as a manufacturing town; every facility is here afforded for the ready shipment to any part of Canada of its products. One of the most important establishments is the

#### DUNDAS COTTON FACTORY.

These large Cotton Works were established by Joseph Wright, Esq., in 1859, but are now being incorporated as the "Dundas Cotton Manufacturing Company," with a capital of half a million dollars. These Cotton Works were the first established in Canada, and, steadily increasing since 1859, have now overcome the great difficulties which beset the introduction of a new industry. Mr. Wright has succeeded in educating and attaching to the works a large number of trained hands of the most efficient yet inexpensive kind; the wages account now comparing favourably with that of any similar works in Great Britain.

These works have at present 108 looms working and 7,000 spindles. The weekly productions are 25,000 yards grey cotton cloth, 6,000 fbs. cotton yarn, and a total weekly production of 12,000 fbs. The machinery and equipments are of the very best finish and character that could be obtained in England or the United States, combining every modern improvement.

The Real Estate consists of several acres on Main and Rosina streets, Dundas, on which are erected:—The factory of white brick, 240 feet in length, of handsome structure and design, from 2½ to 4½ stories high, slated roof, with iron window sills and heads, with isolated fire-proof engine and boiler houses attached. Complete Gas Works buildings and

apparatus adjoining the factory. Comfortable two-story red brick dwelling house and premises, with business office attached, fire-proof vaults, &c. Large white brick warehouses nearly fire-proof, stabling and premises. Town lots on Rosina Street, with dwellings for factory hands.

The works are driven by a water-wheel equal to 40 horse power, and two steam-engines of 80 horse power, specially constructed for Mr. Wright by Messrs. John Gartshore & Son, to save fuel, being high pressure (exhausting into condensing) engines, using the same steam over again. The premises and machinery are, in every respect, complete, and in perfect order and repair. About two hundred hands are constantly employed.

#### THE CANADA SCREW COMPANY.

Officers:—President, Hugh Moore; Vice-President, Peter Patterson; James McMahon, M.D., Secretary; J. P. Billington, Treasurer and Manager. This company was organized in February, 1866, for carrying on the manufacture of wood screws on an extensive scale. The works were originally commenced by J. P. Billington, Esq., the Treasurer and Manager of the Company, who deserves a great deal of credit for the introduction of an undertaking of so much magnitude in Canada, there being but a very few successful establishments of the kind in the world, and this the only one in British America. The company has a commodious brick building, four stories in height, with a rear building two stories, the whole being 50 feet front by 100 feet in depth. The machinery is of the most beautiful description, and has been made on the premises from original drawings. The works now have the capacity of turning out about two thousand gross per diem and give constant employment to fifty hands.

#### AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS.

A very large business, employing about thirty hands, is carried on in this branch by John Forsyth, Esq. The works were established in 1855. A large number of separating, threshing machines, mowing and reaping machines, ploughs, cultivators, iron pumps, &c., are turned out annually. 15 horse steam power is used.

In this line, also, Mr. James Scott employs twenty-five hands, and an engine of 16 horse power. The works were established in 1862.

Archibald McKeand, Fire, Life and Accident Insurance Agent, 2 King Street, Hamilton.

#### CARD CLOTHING.

This is a new branch of industry commenced in Dundas in 1866, by John Forsyth, Esq., who employs six hands; five horse steam power is used to propel twenty machines, using 60 sides of leather weekly. The card clothing made here is used as well for cotton as woollen machinery, and is considered equal in quality to the best imported.

#### DUNDAS EDGE TOOL FACTORY.

Mr. J. Hourigan commenced business in 1859, and employs 18 hands, 30 horse water power and 12 horse steam power. Axes, and reaping and mowing machine knives are the chief articles made here.

#### FLOURING MILLS.

The Wentworth Flouring Mills, established in 1844, owned and carried on by John Wilson, Esq., 50 horse steam and 50 horse water power is used to propel four run of stone. The mill has the capacity of turning out 600 barrels a week. Lately an Oatmeal Mill has been erected in connection with the Flouring Mill with a capacity of 450 barrels per week. Eight hands are here employed. The Dundas Mills, water power, established in 1833, are carried on by James Coleman, who employs ten hands in the mill, and is also engaged in the manufacture of staves, barrels, &c. The mill contains six run of stone, and has the capacity of manufacturing one thousand barrels per week.

#### IRON FOUNDRIES AND ENGINE WORKS.

One of the most extensive works in this line in Canada is conducted by Messrs. Gartshore & Co., who employ about one hundred and fifty hands and thirty horse steam power. The foundry was established in 1838. Here are manufactured marine, portable and stationary steam engines, French Burr mill stones; Swiss bolting cloths, grist and saw mill machinery, oil stills, tanks, locomotive castings, and a late improved iron water wheel; castings have been made by this firm of 17 tons weight. The engine for the new iron Car-Ferry Boat for the Great Western Railway Company at Windsor, and also that for the Hamilton Water Works were manufactured by Messrs. Gartshore & Co.

### MACHINISTS' TOOLS AND WOODWORKERS' MACHINERY.

Messrs. McKechnie & Bertram, established in 1861, manufacture every description of machinists' tools, and wood workers' machinery. The firm have received several first premiums for their machinery. They employ 20 hands, and 6 horse steam-rower.

## MOROCCO, GLOVE AND WOLLEN YARN MANUFACTORY.

The Dundas Morocco Factory, was established in 1860, by W. E. Parmenter, who employs 25 hands and an engine of 15 horse-power in the manufacture of Morocco leather, of which about \$25,000 worth is

turned out annually. The Dundas Tannery, formerly owned by Mr. Thomas Howe, is also in the possession of Mr. Parmenter, and used as a glove leather manufactory, to which is being added machinery for the manufacture of woollen yarns, a 15 horse-power engine is also used here, and about 15 hands employed. Mr. Parmenter has also a glove factory in Exchange buildings, opposite the Market, where he gives employment to 50 hands in the manufacture of gloves, mitts, gauntlets, &c., of a very superior quality; the business in this line amounts to about \$20,000 per year.

PAPER MILLS.

The Gore Paper Mills were established in 1834, now owned by Mr. John Fisher; the machinery is propelled by water power, and twenty hands are kept employed. Every description of book, news, and wrapping papers are made here.

#### WOOD WORKERS' MACHINERY.

Messrs. Littler & Maw have lately commenced business in the machinery line, and turn out wood workers' machinery of every description, also a new hub morticing machine and spoke lathe. Their premises are on King street; seven horse steam power is used by this firm.

#### WOOLLEN AND COTTON MACHINERY.

John Forsyth, Esq., is largely engaged in this branch of manufactures, employing in this line, and the manufacture of agricultural implements, thirty hands and twenty horse steam power. The premises occupy an area of one and a half acres, situated on Hatt street.

## WOOLLEN, COTTON AND FLAX MACHINERY.

Messrs. Aitkin & Post, in 1866, established machine works, where they manufacture woolen machinery, such as carding machines, jacks and twisters. In cotton machinery, spinning frames and looms. In flax machinery, looms that will weave seamless goods; they also manufacture shafting, pulleys and hangers. Steam power to the extent of 5 horse is used, and twelve hands are kept employed.

#### WOOLLEN GOODS.

The Dundas Woollen Mills were at first established in 1864, by Messrs Crossland & Brown; lately a Company was organized who are carrying on the works under the management of Mr. Thomas Brown. The mills contain fifteen double and two single looms, turn out about 3,500 yards weekly, 120 hands are employed,; 50 horse power steam and about the same water power.

An establishment for the manufacture of wire work was commenced in 1860, by Timothy Greening, who manufactures wire cloth of every description. Four hands are employed.

Archibald McKeand, Fire, Life and Accident Insurance Agent, 2 King Street, Hamilton. There is one brewery, established originally in 1840, now carried on by J. Thornton & Co., proprietors. They turn out about three thousand barrels of ale and porter per annum.

Drill Shed, arched roof, 183 by 80, situated on King, between Hatt and Market streets. Armory, &c., attached.

#### CHURCHES.

CHURCH OF ENGLAND (St. James), situated on Hatt street, is a plain and substantial stone edifice, and is capable of accommodating six hundred persons. Rev. F. L. Osler, M.A., Cam., rector of Ancaster and incumbent, Dundas.

KNOX CHURCH (Presbyterian Church of Canada), was erected in 1847, of brick, at a cost of four thousand dollars, lately enlarged, and will now seat seven hundred persons. Rev. John McCall.

St. Andrews (Church of Scotland), was erected in 1837, of stone, at a cost of about four thousand dollars, and will accommodate three hundred and fifty persons. Rev. Mr. Herald, pastor.

PARK STREET BAPTIST CHURCH AND SCHOOLHOUSE was built in 1866, of brick. It will seat 300 persons. Rev. John Bates, minister.

WESLEYAN METHODIST CHURCH, Cross street, corner Park, was built in 1855, of brick, and cost twelve thousand dollars. It will accommodate five hundred persons.

ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH, erected in 1863, of brick, will cost, when fully completed, about ten thousand dollars. It will accommodate about fifteen hundred persons. Rev. Mr. O'Reilly, priest.

#### Schools.

The Dundas Union Grammar and Common School building was erected in 1856, of brick. The average daily attendance is about 240 pupils. J. H. Hunter, principal; J. McLean, assistant.

The Roman Catholic Separate School edifice is on Sydenham street, and was established in 1858. The average attendance is about 100 pupils. James B. Looney, teacher of male department, and Miss Griffin, teacher of female department.

## ALDERSHOTT (Waterdown Station).

A post village and station on the Toronto branch of the Great West ern Railway, in the township of East Flamboro', 41 miles from Hamilton, and 35 miles from Toronto. It contains a hotel and a post officer with a daily mail. Large quantities of grain, flour, and lumber are shipped from here annually. Population 50.

#### ANCASTER.

A post village, situated in the north east portion of the township of the same name, 7 miles from Hamilton, and 3 miles from Dundas station, on the Great Western Railway. The village contains several manufacturing establishments.

#### CARD CLOTHING.

Has been manufactured in Ancaster since 1863 by Eyre Thuresson, Esq., and in establishing this, an entirely new business in this country, Mr. Thuresson had many difficulties to overcome, not the least of which was the procuring of suitable leather for card clothing purposes. He purchased the best leather manufactured in Canada, and after using hemlock tanned leather for four years, came to the conclusion that it was impossible to manufacture a first class card with such material, therefore, determined, although at considerable expense, to use no other than English oak tanned leather, which he is now using to advantage. Mr. Thuresson being the pioneer in this important branch of manufactures, is no doubt, desirous of furnishing to the trade an article that cannot be excelled. The selection of stock is made a matter of special importance, as the durability of the card depends entirely on its quality.

Mr. Thuresson has now at work thirty-eight machines, including Horse Card, Diamond point, Sheet, Fillet, and Doffer ring machines The last named machine possesses a new and attractive interest. Hitherto Doffer rings have been made with a § inch joint, then pricked and finished by hand, which was, at the best, a very inferior and unseemly finish. The ring is now pieced with a joint 17 inch long, and finished in the machine in a highly superior manner, the advantages of which will be self evident to those who use such articles. They are made of all widths with fractional variations.

Diamond point, or angular wire is now mostly used for Tumblers, Leader-ins, and Feeders. These articles are supplied in any quantity at short notice.

The Diamond point and the Doffer ring machines are the only two articles of the kind in British America. The power used is water, and twelve hands are constantly employed. One hundred and twenty-five sides of the best English oak tanned leather is used weekly.

The following points, per square foot, have been generally adopted by manufacturers for all ordinary carding purposes, and, unless otherwise ordered, will be filled accordingly :-

With the enlarged facilities now possessed, Mr. Thuresson manufactures all the varieties of cards required for cotton and woollen works, including sheets from 24 to 64 in the long; common filleting in any lengths ordered; diamond point, long, short, or medium cut fancy. Napier sheets of galvanized zinc, Doffer rings, Hand wool cards, Cleaners, &c.

The best English and American machines have been imported for making these cards, besides what are being made at Ancaster for future use; and the most competent workmen, which liberal payment can secure, are employed to attend them.

#### KNITTING MILLS.

The Ancaster Knitting Company was organized in 1866.—President, James Watson; Secretary, Arch. McKeand; Manager and Superintendent, J. G. Crane. The Company employ 110 hands, an engine of 45 horse power, and 10 horse water power additional. A very large quantity of knitted goods is here turned out annually.

The Wentworth Knitting Mills were established in April, 1867, by Adams & Hinton, who employ 30 hands, and use water power only. The buildings and machinery were erected by H. & A. Egleston, the former being 34 by 50 feet, three stories high. An additional set of machinery is about being added.

## WOOLLEN, COTTON MACHINERY AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS.

The Ancaster foundry and machine shop was erected in 1849 of stone, by H. & A. Egleston, who use a steam engine of 15 horse power. This firm manufactures every description of cotton and woollen machinery and agricultural implements. Many improvements have been made by Messrs. Egleston in the manufacture of carding machines, particularly their condensing machine, and nearly all the woollen factories and carding mills in Carada have been furnished by this firm. About 30 sets of carding and woollen machinery are turned out annually. They have lately erected a new woollen factory of stone, three stories high, with a basement; the length is fifty feet by thirty-four feet wide. It contains two sets of machinery for cloth manufacturing and knitting purposes, which is all of their own make.

#### FLOURING MILLS.

The Ancaster flouring mills were erected in 1863, of stone, containing three run of stone, and having a capacity for manufacturing 100 barrels of flour per diem. The mills were erected by H. & A. Egleston, at a cost of \$10,000.

#### LEATHER MANUFACTORY.

The Ancaster tannery, carried on by Jacob Gabel, was established in 1826—the building is stone. Manufactured leather to the value of \$5,000 per annum is turned out. Four hands are employed here.

#### THRESHING AND SEPARATING MACHINES.

The Ancaster Threshing and Separating manufactory, originally established in 1846, by Eyre Thuresson, Esq., is now carried on by Mr. W. H. Thuresson, who employs eight hands, and about 12 horse water power.

#### CHURCHES.

The village contains three churches, the Church of England, frame, was erected in 1827, and will accommodate 300 persons, Rev. F. L. Osler, rector; Rev. Mr. Ballard, curate.

The Presbyterian Church was built of frame in 1830, will seat about 200 persons, Rev. John Lees, minister.

Methodist Episcopal, Rev. Mr. Collamore, pastor.

The Wesleyan Methodist Church was erected about 1830, of frame, and will seat 200 persons—there is no resident pastor.

#### MISCELLANEOUS.

The sixth division court is held here, L. A. Gurnett, clerk, Arthur Crooks, bailiff.

Ancaster has an excellent school under the charge of Mr. Shire. The average attendance is about one hundred pupils.
