

TOWN OF DUNDAS.

AN incorporated Town in the Township of West Flamboro' and County of Wentworth, situated at the head of the Desjardins Canal, and on the Line of the Great Western Railway, five miles from Hamilton, 79 from London, 44 from Toronto, and 49 from Suspension Bridge. Mails daily, with Money Order Office. Dundas, from its position in the centre of a rich agricultural section of country, must continue to advance in population and wealth. It contains some fine Church edifices, a Town Hall and Market Building, and several good brick business blocks. Many of the private residences are equal to any found in the larger cities of Canada.

The pride of Dundas is its numerous manufacturing establishments in iron, cotton, woollen goods, paper, French burr mill stones, agricultural implements, leather, flour, &c. John Gartshore's large and extensive foundry and machine shops are situated on Hatt Street. About one hundred and fifty men are kept employed at this establishment in the manufacturing of steam engines of every description, mill machinery of all kinds, oil stills, tanks, car wheels and locomotive castings, portable mills, mill stones, water wheels, smut machines, &c. Some of the largest castings ever turned out in Canada, have been made at this foundry.

In the manufacture of agricultural implements, the establishment of Billington & Forsyth was commenced in 1855; they employ twenty-three men, and an engine of fifteen horse power. One hundred and fifty-eight reaping machines, fifteen separator threshing machines, a number of ploughs, cultivators, iron pumps, &c., were turned out during the year.

James Scott & Co., in the same branch of industry, employ thirty hands, an engine of sixteen horse power, and turn out agricultural implements of every description to the value of about thirty thousand dollars per annum. This firm has been established about three years.

On approaching the town by the Hamilton road, the first building of any interest that will be seen is the large cotton factory carried on by Wright & Son. The building is brick, three stories high, and

elegantly finished; furnished with machinery for the manufacture of cotton cloths, cotton yarn, and batting. At this factory from 90 to 100 hands get constant employment, and two engines of one hundred horse power are used in propelling the machinery. The engines were built at the establishment of John Gartshore, Dundas.

There are two flouring mills. The Dundas Mills, water power, established in 1833, are carried on by James Coleman, who employs ten hands in the mill, and is also engaged in the manufacture of staves, barrels, &c. The mills contain six run of stone, and has the capacity of manufacturing one thousand barrels per week. The Wentworth Mills, steam and water, Wilson & Bros., proprietors, were established in 1844. They contain four run of stone, and have the capacity of manufacturing six hundred barrels of flour per week.

The Dundas Morocco Factory and Tannery was started in 1860 by W. E. Parmenter, who employs twenty-five hands, and an engine of fifteen horse power, in the manufacturing of morocco, sole, calf, and upper leathers. The Dundas Tannery was established in 1850 by Thomas Howe, who employs ten hands, an engine of fifteen horse power, and turns out fifteen thousand manufactured hides per annum.

The Gore Paper Mills were established in 1834; the machinery is propelled by water power, and thirty-five hands are kept employed. Every description of book, news, and wrapping papers are made here.

Crossland & Brown's Steam Woollen Mill was established during the present year. Eighty hands are employed in this establishment, and an engine of fifty horse power used in propelling the machinery. This firm turns out about fifteen hundred yards of cloth per week.

W. H. Gibson employs about ten hands and an engine of eight horse power in the manufacture of machinists' tools, lathes, iron planing machines, and general machinists' work.

McKechnie & Bertram, manufacturers of machinists' and woodworkers' tools, employ five men, and use steam power to the extent of five horse.

In the manufacture of sashes and blinds, Thomas Sheldrick employs three men, and an engine of six horse power.

J. & W. Chegwin employ ten men in carriage and waggon building, and turn out about five thousand dollars worth per annum.

The only establishment in the manufacture of furniture is carried on by Ostwald & Co., who give employment to fifty men, and use

steam power to the extent of fifteen horse. They turn out manufactured ware to the value of thirty thousand dollars per annum.

An establishment for the manufacture of wire work was commenced in 1860 by Timothy Greening, who manufactures wire cloth of every description.

There is one brewery, established by Holt & Gray in 1840. They turn out about three thousand barrels of ale and porter per annum.

CHURCHES.

CHURCH OF ENGLAND, (St James) situated on Hatt street, is a plain and substantial stone edifice, and is capable of accommodating six hundred persons. Rev. F. L. Osler, M.A., Cam., rector of Ancaster and incumbent, Dundas.

KNOX CHURCH, (Presbyterian Church of Canada) was erected in 1847, of brick, at a cost of four thousand dollars, and is seated for four hundred persons.

ST. ANDREWS CHURCH OF SCOTLAND was erected in 1837, of stone, at a cost of about four thousand dollars, and will accommodate two hundred and fifty persons. Rev. Mr. Herald, pastor.

PARK STREET BAPTIST CHURCH was built in 1842, of brick. It cost \$1600, and will seat three hundred persons. Rev. W. A. Caldwell, minister.

MARKET STREET BAPTIST CHURCH was erected in 1858 at a cost of \$1200, and is seated for 100 persons. No settled pastor.

WESLEYAN METHODIST CHURCH, Cross street, corner Park, was built in 1855, of brick and cost \$12,000. It will accommodate five hundred persons.

ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH, erected in 1863, of brick, will cost when fully completed about ten thousand dollars. It will accommodate about one thousand persons.

SCHOOLS.

The Dundas Union Grammar and Common School building was erected in 1856, of brick. The average daily attendance is about 240 pupils. J. Joseph Flynn, principal.

The Roman Catholic Separate School edifice is on Sydenham street, and was established in 1858. The average attendance is about 100

pupils. James B. Looney, teacher male department, and Miss Margaret Sweeney, teacher of female department.

ALBERTON.—A post village, situated in the township of Ancaster, 14 miles from Hamilton, the county seat, and 55 miles from Toronto. It contains a general store, blacksmith shop, two shoe shops, and two steam saw mills in the vicinity. Population about 100.

ALDERSHOTT (*Waterdown Station*).—A post village and station on the Toronto branch of the Great Western Railway, in the township of East Flamboro, 4 miles from Hamilton, and 35 miles from Toronto. It contains an hotel, and a post office, with a daily mail. Large quantities of grain, flour, and lumber are shipped from here annually—population 50.

ANCASTER*.—A post village, situated in the north east portion of the township of the same name, 7 miles from Hamilton, and 3 miles from Dundas station, on the Great Western Railway. It was first settled by St. Jean Baptiste Rousseaux and James Wilson,

* A short sketch of the early settlement of the township of Ancaster, will be found by reference to another part of this work.

about 1797. The post office was established about 1822, and John Burwell appointed postmaster. In 1831 he was succeeded by James Chep who held the office until 1854, when the present official George B. Rousseaux was commissioned. Ancaster, for nearly twenty years was the only market west of York then, (now Toronto) and Niagara, for farmers living to the south, north and west to get their produce to, and get the necessaries required for their families, many of whom had to travel a hundred miles. Business in those days was done entirely upon the credit system. Mr. Rousseaux built a log grist mill, and a saw mill in the village shortly after his settlement. The stream passing through the village, though not large, furnishes excellent power, and is used in propelling the machinery of several factories and mill.

The Ancaster Knitting Factory, owned and carried on by J. G. Crane is propelled by water. The buildings and machinery cost about \$12,000, and was started in 1854. Mr. Crane employs about 60 hands, and turns out knitted work, under clothing and hosiery to the value of \$50,000 per annum.

Turner's knitting factory, where the same styles of goods are manufactured as at the Ancaster factory. The machinery is propelled by water, twenty hands are employed, and goods to the value of \$20,000 are turned out per annum.

The Ancaster foundry and machine shop was erected in 1849 of stone by H. & A. Egleston, who use a steam engine of 15 horse power. This firm manufactures every description of cotton and woollen machinery and agricultural implements. Many improvements have been made by Messrs. Egleston in the manufacture of carding machines, particularly their condensing machine, and nearly all the woollen factories and carding mills in Canada have been furnished by this firm. They are about erecting a new woollen factory of stone, three stories high, with a basement; the length to be fifty feet by thirty-four feet wide. It is intended to put two sets of machinery for cloth manufacturing and knitting purposes, which will be all of their own make.

The Ancaster flouring mills were erected in 1863, of stone, containing three run of stone, and having a capacity for manufacturing 100 barrels of flour per diem. The mills were erected by H. & A. Egleston, at a cost of \$10,000.

The Ancaster tannery, carried on by Jacob Gabel, was established in 1849—the building is stone. Manufactured leather to the value of \$5,000 per annum is turned out.

The village contains three churches, the Church of England, frame, was erected in 1827, and will accommodate 300 persons. Rev. F. L. Osler, rector.

The Presbyterian Church was built of frame in 1830, will seat about 200 persons, Rev. John Lees, minister.

The Wesleyan Methodist Church was erected about 1830, of frame, and will seat 200 persons—there is no resident pastor.

The sixth division court is held here, L. A. Gurnett, clerk, Arthur Crooks, bailiff.

Ancaster has an excellent school under the charge of Mr. Shire. The average attendance is about one hundred pupils.

The village contains three hotels, one of which, the Ancaster Hotel, is a fine and substantial stone building.
