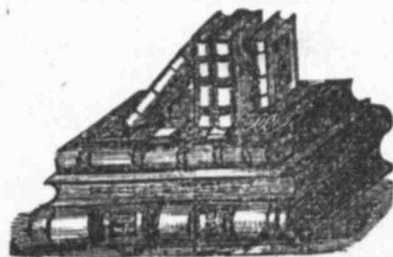

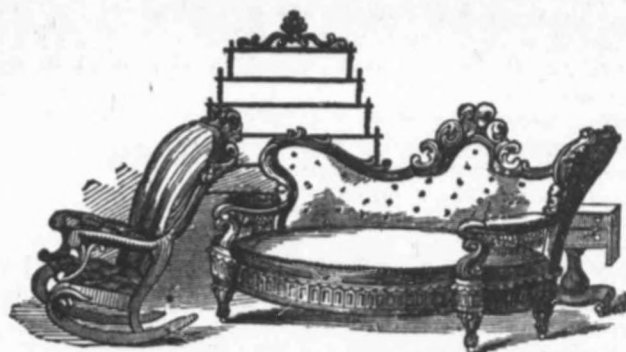

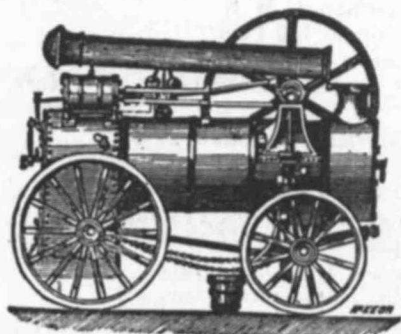

The Annual Vacation will commence about the first week in July, and Scholastic Duties will be resumed the first week of September. No Boarder is admitted for a shorter period than five months, nor Day Pupils or Half Boarders for less than ten weeks.
