INTRODUCTION.

THE Publishers in presenting to their patrons this the 1892 issue of the London City and Middlesex County Directory wish to say that every effort has been made to deliver the work as quickly as possible after the last name was taken, and it is with much pleasure they are able to say that within seven weeks from the day the canvass commenced the book was in the hands of the subscribers. They also wish to say that this is the only City Directory, published in Canada, where the publishers are required to attach the County, which means doubling the cost of the work; still there is no city of even half the size of London that does not appreciate the importance of a Directory and give it sufficient support to secure the publishers against loss. But in London, although eighteen months has elapsed since the last book was issued, the patronage is a long way behind that of previous years, and for the information of those who think there is a little fortune in this Directory we now state that the total amount of patronage given to the work here is \$300 short of meeting the expenses.

The result of the canvass shows a marked improvement in the City; the alphabetical portion of the book shows 15,635 names against 14,399 in last issue, or an increase of 1,236. The canvass also gives 50 less vacant houses. This must be very encouraging to the citizens, and as there seems to be an effort on foot to advertise and boom the City we trust that in the future it will not be forgotten that there is nothing that makes a greater impression on a stranger than to have the facility of finding a friend through the medium of a Directory.
