



## INTRODUCTION.

We give below in tabular view the number of individual names in the alphabetical directory, showing a total of 7,183, or an increase over last year of 548 names.

It is usual for directory publishers to estimate the population by multiplying the number of names in the directory by 3. This method of computation gives for Kingston a population of 21,549.

There are 761 individual names in the five suburban villages given in this book which by the same method gives a population of 2,283 for suburbs, or for city and suburbs 23,832.
