An incorporated town, and the county seat of the counties of Lennox and Addington, situated on the Napanee River, from which it derives its name. Napanee, however, is a corruption of the Indian name, "Appanee." The Kingston road passes through the town: it is one of the best made roads in Canada. Kingston is distant 24 miles, Toronto 136, Bath 12, and the village of Newburgh 7 miles. The river flows through the village, and empties into the Bay of Quinté, affording a vast amount of water power, and is navigable up to the town for vessels drawing six feet of water. The first settlement made in the vicinity of Napanee was in the year 1782, by Thomas Wager; Mrs. Harns, with her three sons, Darius, Gilbert, and Thomas; William Sager; and Isaac Crowder, with his step-sons, Isaac, Jonas, Lambert, Aaron, and James Vanalstine. These parties took up land near the present site of the town, the whole section of country being, at that time, a wilderness—land, in many instances, selling at five dollars per lot. James J. Vanalstine was the first white child born in the settlement, in the year 1800.

The early settlers suffered great distress, in many instances, and experienced in reality the difficulties and trials of a pioneer life. At this time the nearest mill was Kingston Mills, twenty-seven miles off. There were no roads; and the only way of conveying the grain to mill was, either by carrying a bag on their backs, or by sleighs drawn by hand, carrying five bushels at a time.

Napanee was first laid out as a village plot, in 1832, by John Solomon Cartwright; and, until the completion of the Grand Trunk Railway line, presented no material evidence of growth or prosperity. On the completion of this line of railway (not only a great boon to Napanee,
