



It is so voiced as to have a tone like a full, rich alto voice; it is especially "human" in its tone. It is powerful as well as sweet, and when we heard it, we were in doubt whether we liked it best in Solo or with Full Organ. We regard this as a valuable addition to the Reed Organ.—*Rural New Yorker.*




